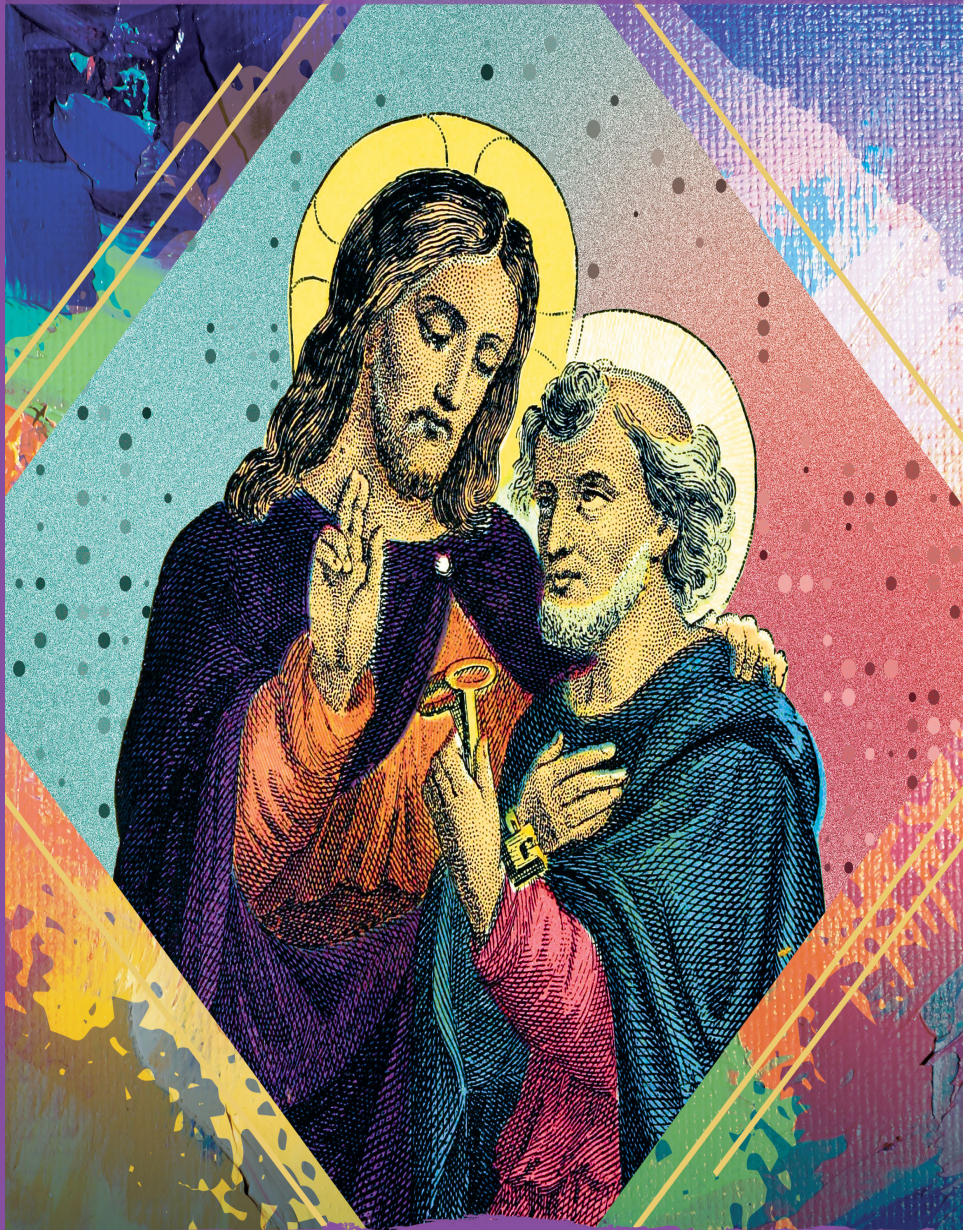

Please note that if you miss the registration your child will have to wait another year to get in. Before you say, "*Father is so mean*", please remember that registration has been open since June for religious education classes. Three months is long enough to make a decision.

This weekend's second collection is for the Catholic League for Religious Assistance to Poland. By helping the Church in Poland we are paying off a debt of gratitude which we incur every year. Polish priests work not only in Polish parishes, but also in many English and Spanish-speaking parishes.

Isn't it nice to walk across the parking lot and not fall into a pothole? As I have already mentioned last week, cost for the project is approximately \$90,000 (parking and sidewalk replacement). Next weekend we celebrate Labor Day. This always was the official end to summer. Really it is a chance to relax and give thanks for the gift of work that God has given each of us. Work bestows dignity and we pray that all who seek employment are able to find work.

Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie!

Przed nami ostatnie dni sierpnia. Uczniowie naszej Szkoły rozpoczęli we wtorek swoje zajęcia. W tym tygodniu mija termin zapisów na katechizację. A w piątek mamy już 1 września. To szczególna data w historii Polski, ponieważ tego dnia przypada kolejna rocznica wybuchu II wojny światowej. Choć było to 84 lata temu, nie zapominajmy o tych, którzy broniąc naszej Ojczyzny polegli w jej obronie, na tyłu frontach świata, w niewoli, czy w obozach koncentracyjnych. I pamiętajmy też o Ukrainie, która od półtora roku prowadzi nierówną walkę z rosyjskim agresorem.

Dzisiejsza druga składka przeznaczona jest na tak zwaną Ligę Katolicką dla Religijnej Pomocy Kościołowi w Polsce. Wspomagając Kościół w Polsce spłacamy dług wdzięczności, jaki zaciągamy każdego roku. To właśnie dzięki życzliwości polskich biskupów w Chicago pracuje wielu kapłanów i studiowało wielu kleryków z Polski. Polscy księża pracują nie tylko w polonijnych parafiach, ale również w wielu parafiach amerykańskich.

Skoro jestem przy temacie ofiarności, chciałbym bardzo gorąco podziękować tym, którzy już przekazali datek na remont parkingu przy kościele św. Ryszarda. Jak wielu z Was zdążyło już to zauważyć, parking jest już gotowy. Koszt naprawy wyniesie około 90 000 USD (parking i wymiana chodnika przed kościołem). Cały czas czekamy na ostateczne wyliczenia. Jeśli ktoś chciałby przekazać donację na ten cel, będę bardzo wdzięczny. Każda ofiara będzie mile widziana.

Za tydzień, obchodzić będziemy Labor Day weekend. Dla wielu jest to oczywiście szlachetne święto doceniające wkład robotników i pracowników w dobro wspólne jakim jest Ojczyzna, ale dla innych jest to trochę smutne święto, bo to nieoficjalny koniec lata w Stanach Zjednoczonych. A to oznacza, że znowu trzeba będzie zabrać się do pracy.

YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS

More than 20 years ago, a new TV show was introduced called the "Game of Thrones" which has grown to be very popular almost cult-like.. I can't say that I have watched it myself but it was based on a series of books by George R.R. Martin who set the fictional story in medieval Europe. It is a fantasy with less emphasis on magic & sorcery & more on battles & political intrigue. He said "the true horrors of human history derive not from orcs & Dark Lords, but from ourselves" A common theme in the fantasy is the battle between good & evil, which Martin says does not mirror the real world yet he explores the relationship between good & evil through the questions of redemption & character change.

Today on this 21st Sunday in Ordinary time, we hear in the gospel of Matthew, Jesus asking his disciples, "Who is the Son of God?" They replied, "Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter said in reply, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus said to him in reply, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah. For flesh & blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father, so I say to you, you are Peter, & upon this rock I will build my church, & the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. This is no Game of Thrones either. This is Jesus' beginning of the Papacy with the passing of the keys to His Servant Peter. All popes since have retained this position of Vicar of Christ as a result. The history of the Papacy is an interesting one. Peter was martyred for his faith as were many of the first popes, yet it still succeeded despite persecution. Not all popes are canonized saints either. 80 known to date, roughly 30% only, starting with St. Peter, traditionally regarded as the first leader of the church after Christ's death. 52 of the first 55 popes became saints during Catholicism's first 500 years. In the last 1,000 years, just seven popes have been made saints, including the two most recent St. JP II & St. Pope John 23rd. in 2014. Not all popes were perfect either that's humanity..

Recently at the World Youth celebration in Lisbon Portugal, 1.5 million young Catholics joined together to hear Pope Francis' homily at mass. Were they there to witness the Pope only as an international celebrity or were they there to be witnesses of our Catholic faith? Whatever the reason, he needs our help to spread the message of our faith. By our baptism & confirmation we hear the words at the end of every mass to "Go forth, the mass is ended." It doesn't mean, time to leave everyone, rather "the liturgy in which the mystery of salvation is accomplished concludes with the sending forth (mission) of the faithful, so that they may fulfill God's will in their daily lives" (CCC 1332). How are you doing in that department? Do you feel confident enough in your faith to share the faith with your family, friends or co-workers or are willing to stand up when your faith is challenged? We have so many ways to learn about our faith today with Catholic Relevant Radio 950AM or EWTN TV. Or just google it online & lots of very valuable websites like www.catholic.com. Faith needs nurturing otherwise it becomes cold or isolated. Just a reminder, only those who are housebound due to illness or disability are exempt from attending Sunday mass. We all need to be "On fire" for Christ thru receiving Holy Communion. See you in church?

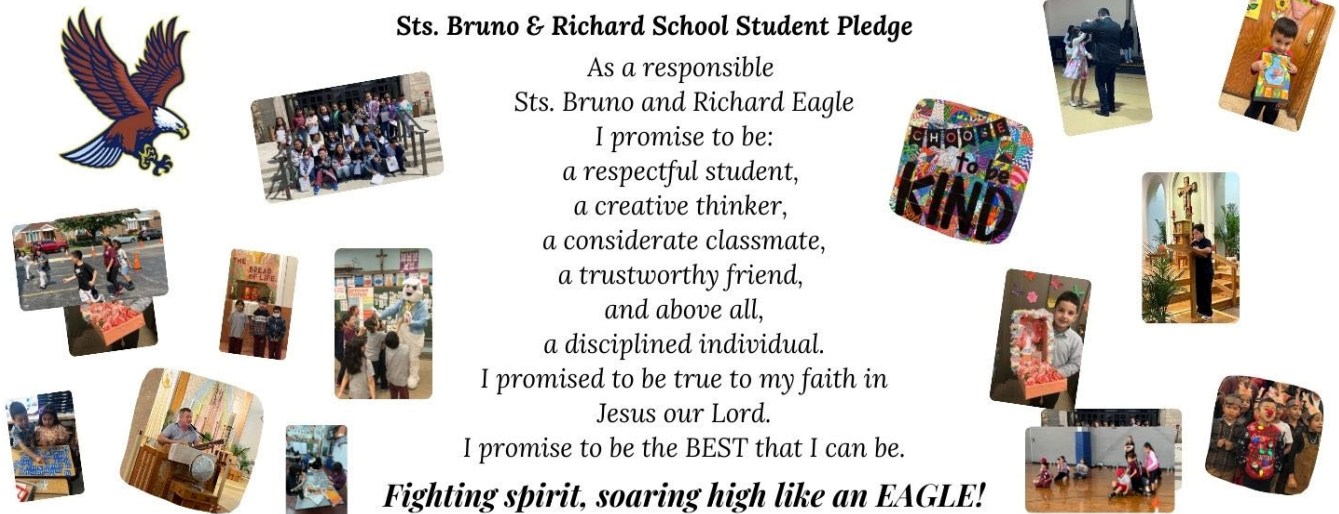
