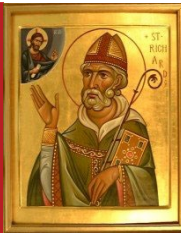

Your Deacon Daydreams

Fat Tuesday, Ash Wednesday & the Season of Lent is fast approaching. Let's focus on three hot button issues, "calories, cholesterol & concerns." However, let's start with "concerns." What are yours for making this the best Lent ever? This week's good news of the gospel from Mark, Jesus is approached again by someone seeking healing. "A leper came to Jesus and kneeling down begged him & said, "If you wish, you can make me clean." Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him, said to him, "I do will it. Be made clean." The leper's concern was his illness, but we are all ill in one way or another, aren't we? It might be physical, mental, emotional, financial, or most certainly spiritual sickness.

We are all sinners & we need to seek reconciliation with the Lord regularly which is available in the Sacrament of Reconciliation or Confession. If you haven't visited a priest for some time, Lent is the perfect opportunity to make up for that lost time. In fact, all Catholics are obligated to go to confession & receive Communion at least once a year during the Easter season. Like the leper, who asked to be made whole & healthy, we should approach the Lord to ask for our spiritual healing as well as for our other needs. Confession frees us from the slavery of sin. It's the best way to make this Lent powerful.

I also encourage you to visit Jesus in Adoration & also pray the Stations of the Cross with our parish. The schedules will be posted in the bulletin. Jesus asks us to take up our cross & follow Him. It's visible when you pray the stations as a parish family. Please come & bring your family as well. Also, consider enrolling on an app or your computer in dynamiccatholic.com, "Best Lent Ever" free series. Dynamic Catholic even has a feature that includes a video series for children called "Catholic Content for Kids." EWTN.com has a free series. Relevant radio is inviting us to participate in the "Lenten Lessons on the Mass." Also www.morningoffering.com has daily prayers, saint of the day, reflections & more. Both my wife & I have been checking out this link for a long time now. Also there is an app called. Hallow with meditations, the rosary & so many other powerful prayers. There are so many avenues to pray this Lent. And don't forget to pick up your rosary. God is just a prayer away. Ask Him for healing for you or for your loved one, or the world & don't forget the Poor Souls in Purgatory.

Finally, as a card carrying "Paczki Patrol" member, I urge you to watch the calories & cholesterol in those deep fried fruit or cream filled pastries Whenever my mom made them when we were kids, she never filled them, just sprinkled some sugar on them. We would nearly burn our tongues because we couldn't wait for them to cool. One south side bakery is offering everything in one except the kitchen sink! I saw a sign in another bakery offering low calorie confections. 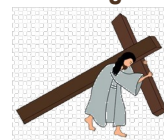

2024 Annual Catholic Appeal

This weekend we join parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Chicago in beginning the 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal. Many of you have received detailed information in the mail; others may complete the forms available in church. This Annual Appeal offers the opportunity to make a one-time donation or contribute throughout the year. You can make your gift to the Annual Catholic Appeal online at www.annualcatholicappeal.com, at Mass today, or you can choose to send in the response envelope from the Cardinal's letter you may have received earlier in January. The funds from this campaign, among other services, assist parishes & schools with financial need, cover costs for Archdiocesan ministries & formation, & contributes to the global Catholic Relief Fund. Each parish has a designated goal for the Appeal. This goal is based on the annual income of the parish. The goal for Saints Bruno & Richard is \$29,757. While that is a large figure, I hope everyone will consider what you can do to make this year's Appeal a success. That large number can be intimidating. Ignore it. My hope is that you will pray about what God is calling you to offer in a spirit of generosity, compassion & faith. Also, if we exceed our goal, we will get a rebate, which the parish can use as we wish. So please, give some prayerful consideration to what you can give to the Annual Catholic Appeal. Your gift will make a difference. Your generosity will be a blessing.

Dziś, we wszystkich parafiach Archidiecezji Chicago, odbywa się Doroczna Kwesta Katolicka (Annual Catholic Appeal 2024). Chociaż potrzeby parafii dalej powinny być naszym priorytetem, tym niemniej, na ile tylko Was stać, wesprzyjcie prośbę kardynała Cupicha. Jak wiecie, celem Apelu jest zebranie funduszy potrzebnych na realizację wielu programów i akcji prowadzonych przez Archidiecezję, dlatego to każdej parafii wyznacza się zebranie określonej kwoty pieniędzy. I tak, nasza parafia ma zabrać razem \$29,797. Suma ta może wydawać się niewyobrażalna, ale wiercie mi, wspólnymi siłami jesteśmy w stanie ją zebrać, a nawet przekroczyć, a wtedy ta nadwyżka zostanie zwrócone nam na potrzeby parafii. A jest ich sporo. Jeśli ktoś w Apelu nie brał jeszcze udziału, to przy wyjściu z kościoła wyłożone są specjalne koperty z kartą zobowiązań. Nasze deklaracje i ewentualne ofiary można złożyć dziś w kościele, albo wysłać je bezpośrednio do Archidiecezji. Swoje zobowiązania można regulować za pomocą gotówki, czeku lub karty kredytowej. Można również przekazać darowiznę on-line na stronie www.annualcatholicappeal.com.

Hoy, junto con todas las parroquias a través de la arquidiócesis de Chicago, comenzamos la Campaña Católica Anual 2024. Algunos de ustedes ya recibieron sus sobres de compromiso por correo. 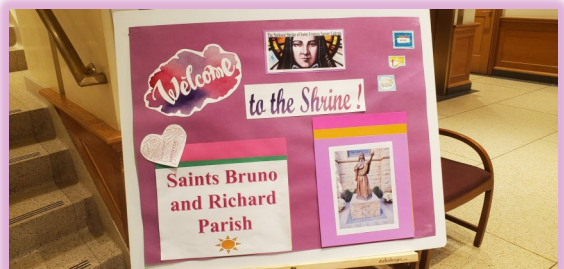
