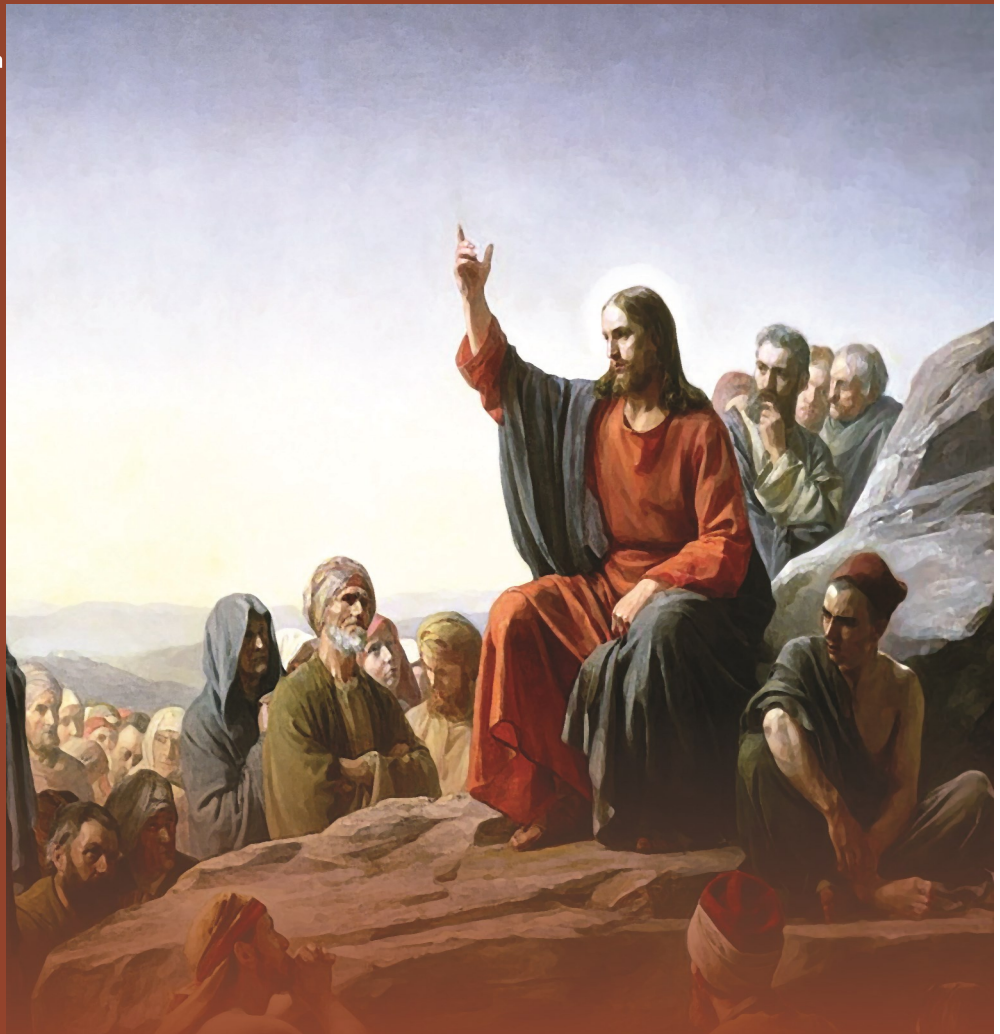

Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie.

Bardzo dziękuję za wasze deklaracje i pierwsze ofiary pieniężne na Doroczną Kwestę Katolicką (*Annual Catholic Appeal 2024*) złożone w ubiegłą niedzielę. Cieszę się, że jesteście oddani nie tylko naszej parafii, ale że rozumiecie też potrzeby całej Archidiecezji. Przypomnę, w tym roku Archidiecezja wyznaczyła naszej połączonej parafii zebranie \$29,757. Suma ta nie jest mała, ale wiercie mi, wspólnymi siłami jesteśmy w stanie ją zebrać, a nawet przekroczyć. Jeżeli kogoś nie było w naszym kościele w ubiegłą niedzielę to nie jest jeszcze za późno, aby się włączyć w tę akcję. Stosowne koperty z formularzem, który należy wypełnić, wyłożone są przy wyjściu z kościoła. Wypełnione deklaracje – z ofiarą lub bez – można wysyłać bezpośrednio na adres Archidiecezji Chicago, albo też składać na tacę lub w kancelarii parafialnej. Ważne jest jednak, aby w deklaracji wyraźnie zaznaczyć, że jesteście z parafii Sts. Bruno & Richard w Chicago.

Jeszcze tak niedawno świętowaliśmy Boże Narodzenie a już od 4 dni mamy Wielki Post. Uczynmy wszystko co w naszej mocy, aby dobrze wykorzystać ten czas i jak najlepiej przygotować się do Świąt Zmartwychwstania Pańskiego. Tym bardziej, że nadejdą one szybciej, niż nam się wydaje. Niech będzie w tych dniach w naszym życiu więcej modlitwy, więcej umartwienia i więcej dobrych uczynków. Pomocą w tym niech będą tradycyjne Wielkopostne nabożeństwa Drogi Krzyżowej i Gorzkich Żali. Już na początku Wielkiego Postu postanówmy sobie też, że nie upłynie on bez spowiedzi. W dobie kryzysu mamy też więcej możliwości niż kiedykolwiek do składania jałmużny. Na przykład: „Akcja Miska Ryżu” na głodujących w krajach misyjnych, żywność, jaką ofiarujemy biednym z naszej parafii, czy rozmaite zbiórki na dobroczynne cele - to tylko niektóre formy naszej jałmużny. We wszystkie piątki Wielkiego Postu zapraszamy też na postne posiłki (*Lenten Dinners*) do sali pod kościołem św. Ryszarda.

Your Deacon Daydreams

One day last week, the expressway was crowded with rush hour traffic. So I decided to get off & make my way back through the hood. While I was stopped at a red light, I started to think about Lent. And mysteriously, God placed an old terra cotta building next to me that once housed an old business, named "Chocolate Temptation." Maybe you have seen it as well on S. Halsted St. Last Wednesday, was the start of Lent & maybe some of us have given up sweets like chocolate. Giving up anything like bad habits or treats or starting a good habit is hard.

By this time, probably those New Year's resolutions have become a lost memory & now we are expected to do some serious reflection, & restart. After all, isn't that what Lent is all about. Jesus began his ministry by going out into the desert for forty days. And like all human beings, Jesus was tempted by the devil. As we hear in the gospel of Mark: "The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert & he remained there for forty days, tempted by Satan but ministered to by the angels." Know this, temptation is not a sin but giving in to it, definitely is. It is definitely a crutch in our moral life. That's why when Jesus taught us to pray, He included, "lead us not into temptation." The greatest of all saints were tempted as well by the devil. If you are frequently bombarded by temptation, then the evil one is still seeking out your soul. However, those who have succumbed to evil are already in his clutches & that truly is sad.

If you are not already familiar with a famous novel by C.S.Lewis, this might be good for Lenten reading. It is also been made into a play. It's called "Screwtape Letters." & it consists of 31 letters written by a devil named Screwtape to his young devil nephew, Wormwood. In these letters, he instructs his nephew how to secure the soul of a human being which he refers to as "the patient." The book teaches the young devil how to tempt the "patient" to move from God & embrace sin. However when you are reading this novel, keep a copy of the Catholic catechism nearby. It will help you "debunk" Screwtape by selecting a passage from the book & carefully finding the ways to defeat the devil in the Catechism. For example, "Sin is an offense against reason, truth, & right conscience; it is a failure of genuine love for God & neighbor caused by a perverse attachment to certain goods (CC1849)." "The aim of catechesis is to seek what is above, not what is below (Col 3:1-3)." "Our human will can only carry us so far by our own merits." We cannot forget who gave us our soul, God, for the sole purpose of directing our very being to Worship Him & receive His love. The moral law is the work of God's instruction for our lives. It is His fatherly instruction that guides us to take care of our souls. It prescribes for man the ways, rules of conduct that lead to the promised beatitude; it proscribes the ways of evil which turn him away from God & His love (CC1950)."

One thing is for sure, It is in the moral law where true freedom lies in every action we commit.. And when "we embrace Christ who is the end of the law, that everyone who has faith may be justified (Rom 10:4)." Our greatest weapon against sin is reconciliation, the Eucharist & prayer. There is no short-cut. Temptation is everywhere unfortunately. Instead focus on the cross & Jesus' Resurrection. Ask your guardian angel to help you too. See you in church both @ mass & the Stations?

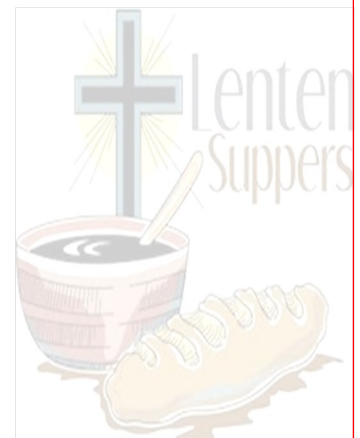

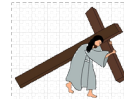

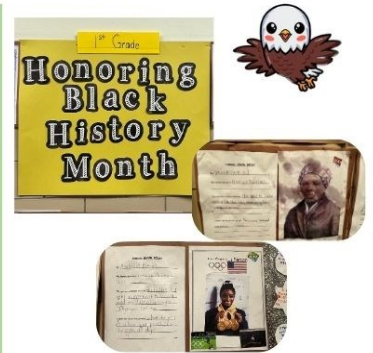
