

A few words from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners!

This week, we once again celebrate Catholic School's week across the country. Today, at the 9:00 am. Mass at St. Richard church, we will highlight Catholic Schools Week by having our students participate in the liturgy. After Mass, the school will hold an Open House, so that prospective students and parents can see the school, meet some of our parents, teachers, and students, and get information on registration. If you presently have children enrolled in Religious Education classes we would also like to have you come and see if our school might also be an option. Everyone is welcome.

On Friday, February 2nd, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord - the day on which Jesus was presented in the Temple 40 days after his birth, in accordance with Jewish law. This day has also become commonly known as "Candlemas Day," the day on which candles are blessed. And on Saturday, February 3rd, is the memorial of St. Blaise - a favorite saint in the Church for those seeking intercession for illnesses of the throat. The Church blesses throats on the Feast of St. Blaise because of the story handed down through the centuries that he cured a small boy from choking to death on a fishbone. This blessing is not just for those with illnesses of the throat, but is for all of the faithful, and the blessing asks St. Blaise to intercede on our behalf and protect us from all illnesses of the mind, body, and soul. In our both churches, a general blessing will be done after all Masses on the weekend of February 3 & 4.

Drodzy Parafianie.

Dziś rozpoczyna się corocny Tydzień Szkół Katolickich, którego celem jest ukazanie znaczenia katolickiej edukacji, a także promocja szkół katolickich. Z tej okazji, po Mszy o 9:00 w kościele św. Ryszarda, odbędzie się tak zwany Open House, czyli możliwość zwiedzenia naszej Szkoły i zapoznania się z warunkami nauczania oraz programem przez nią oferowanym.

A w piątek, 2 lutego, przypada Uroczystość Ofiarowania Pańskiego. W Polsce, znana jest ona bardziej pod nazwą święta Matki Boskiej Gromnicznej. Świece, które tego dnia błogosławimy, przypominają nam, że to sam Chrystus jest naszą światłością, szczególnie w chwilach próby i zagrożeń. Dlatego ta tradycja każe nam zapalać je między innymi w czasie burzy i w godzinie czyjejś śmierci. 2 lutego, Msze św. po polsku zostaną odprawione o 10:00 rano w kościele św. Brunona i o 6:00 wieczorem, w kościele św. Ryszarda. Natomiast w sobotę, 3 lutego, przypada wspomnienie św. Błażeja - patrona mówców, śpiewaków oraz wszystkich, którzy niejako zawodowo muszą dbać o swoje gardło i struny głosowe. Tradycją już jest, że tego dnia udzielane jest specjalne błogosławieństwo gardła. Ponieważ w tym roku 3 lutego przypada w sobotę i nie każdy będzie mógł tego dnia być w kościele, dlatego też obrzęd błogosławieństwa gardła będzie miał miejsce w przyszłą niedzielę, 4 lutego.

SAINT BLAISE

Saint Blaise was the bishop of Sebastea and a doctor. The first known record of the saint's life comes from the medical writings of Aëtius Amidenus, where he is recorded as helping with patients suffering from objects stuck in their throat. Many of the miraculous aspects of St. Blaise's life are written of 400 years after his martyrdom in the "Acts of St. Blaise." Saint Blaise is believed to begin as a healer then, eventually, became a "physician of souls." He then retired to a cave, where he remained in prayer. People often turned to Saint Blaise for healing miracles. In 316, the governor of Cappadocia and of Lesser Armenia, Agricola, arrested then-bishop Blaise for being a Christian. On their way to the jail, a woman set her only son, who was chocking to death on a fish bone, at his feet. Blaise cured the child, and though Agricola was amazed, he could not get Blaise to renounce his faith. Therefore, Agricola beat Blaise with a stick and tore at his flesh with iron combs before beheading him.
