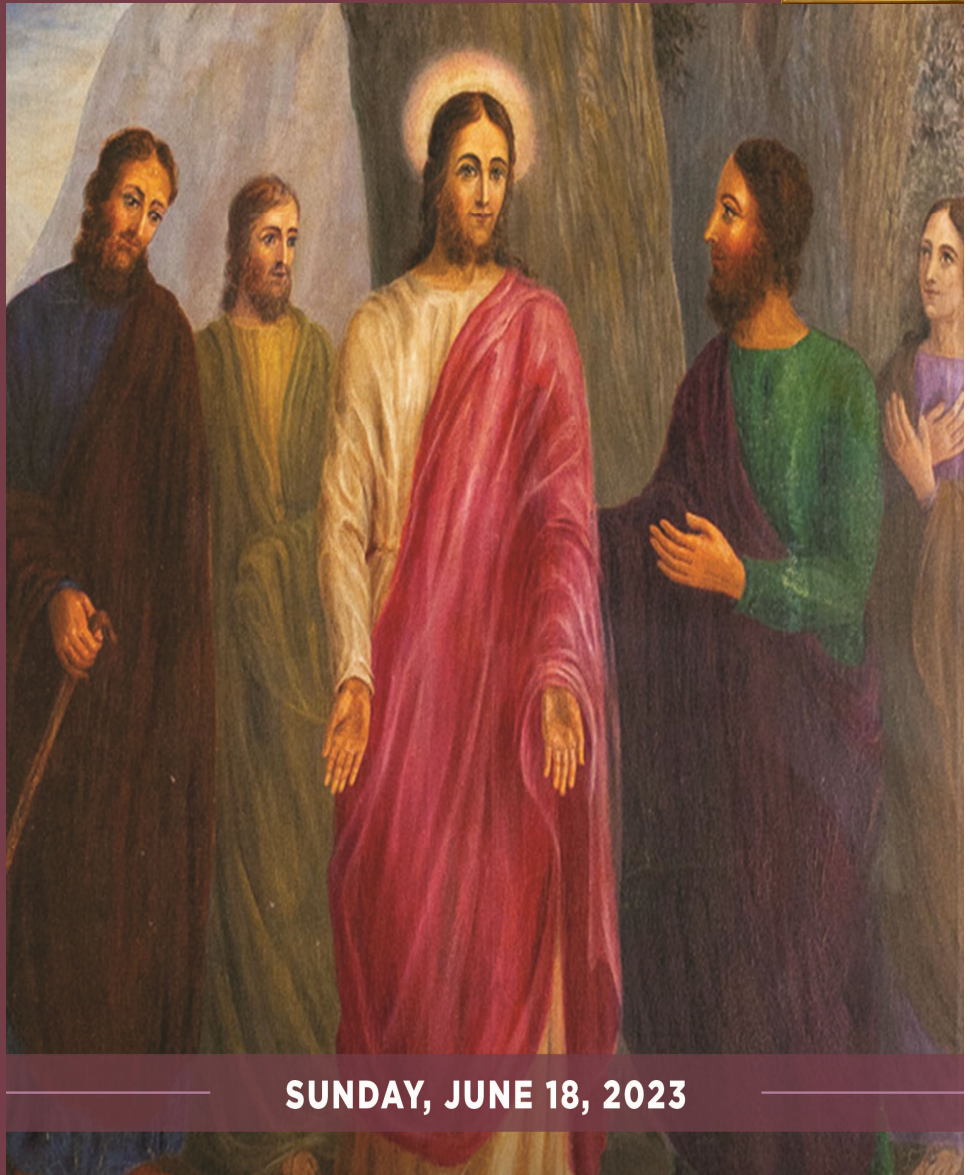

YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS



I am nearly 70 yrs old & I have never seen so many Help Wanted Signs. I also have realized that many businesses have limited their working hours since they cannot find staff either. People on social media are trying to recruit help for all kinds of needs too. For small employers who have invested their life savings in a dream but cannot find people to work for them has to be difficult & heart-wrenching too. Then I read this weekend's good news of the gospel from Matthew, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few;"

It is clearly evident that it has greatly affected us as people of faith too. Only five priests were ordained this year for the diocese. Look around you at the empty pews but a park close by is filled with people watching or playing sports. Or at a recent concert venue that people were willing to invest a fortune for 3 hrs of entertainment. So many Churches are consolidating or closing because people are placing their investment in material things ahead of food for their soul. There are so many errors in our time that masquerade as wisdom & balance, but there is no such thing if they are not rooted in God.

Yet even 2000 yrs ago when things looked bleak, Jesus sent out twelve disciples instructing them "As you go, make this proclamation: 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.' One of the false notions called Universalism is that belief that most if not all people are going to be saved in the end but this is directly contrary to our Lord's own words. Pick up your cross & follow me. God knows us intimately. He is love & wants of us to be happy with Him one day in heaven. That's why we must be foot soldiers for Christ. Share your relationship with God with someone you love or care about. Spread his good news with others!

Happy Father's Day to my fellow dads. Let us praise those fathers who have striven to balance the demands of work, marriage & children with an honest awareness of both joy & sacrifice. Let us praise those fathers who, lacking a good model for a father, have worked to become a worthy & virtuous father.

Let us praise those fathers who, by their own account, were not always there for their children, but who continue to offer those children, now grown, their love & support. As well, let us pray for those fathers who have been wounded by words & actions of their children. Let us praise those fathers who, despite marital discord, have remained in their children's lives. Let us praise those fathers whose children are adopted, & whose love and support has nurtured a thriving life. Let us praise those fathers who, as stepfathers, freely choose the obligation of fatherhood & earned their step children's love & respect. Let us praise those men who are about to become fathers; may they openly delight in their children. And let us praise those fathers who have died, but live on in our memory & whose love continues to nurture us.

Let us praise those fathers who have lost a child to death, & continue to hold the child in their heart. Let us praise those men who have no children, but cherish the next generation as if they were their own God's blessings also to all grandfathers & god-fathers also. Your work is never complete. Pray also for our fathers who are waiting in Purgatory to share with our Heavenly Father all the joys they so deserve. Amen. See you in church?

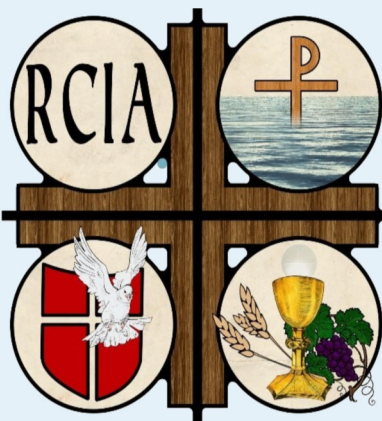
