

A few words from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners.

We have almost completed the Easter season and are now preparing for four major feast days, all coming on the two last Sundays of May and the two first Sundays of June: Ascension, Pentecost, Trinity Sunday and The Body and Blood of Christ. In the past, the Ascension of Our Lord traditionally was celebrated on Thursday, the 40th day of his resurrection. But due to the importance of the feast, and not many people coming when it was during the week (Thursday) to celebrate the Holyday of the Ascension of the Lord, American bishops asked the Holy Father several years back already, and were granted the privilege to move this feast to the following Sunday. That's why it is celebrated today instead of last Thursday. Today's feast is a feast that encourages us to believe that Christ is not far from us, as we most of the time think, but very close to us. Let us take special interest in teaching the children and encourage them to come with us each Sunday to church. It is our responsibility, a privilege given to us by Christ, to make disciples of all nations and this includes our children and grandchildren. I know it is not easy these days to convince these little ones to be with us but Christ assures us, "*He is with us always until the end of time.*" Let us continue doing the good things we do always.

The school year is coming to the end, we look forward to the next one and we remind you about ongoing registration for Sts. Bruno & Richard School. Once again congratulations to the children from School and Religious Education Formation, who recently made their First Holy Communion and received the Sacrament of Confirmation. Please pray for them, their parents and families. And please, pray also for our eighth grade students as they prepare to move on to their high schools. It is an exciting time for them, but also a bit scary. We know God will continue to bless them.

And finally, I am pleased to introduce to you, by way of this article, the newest member of our parish family and parish staff. Her name is Ely Segura, and she is our Director of Lifelong Formation. This position is relatively new and an integral part of the Renew My Church process. Ely's most important role is to organize our Religious Education program for our Parish. Ely's larger role is to assure that the ministers within all of our ministries have the appropriate formation to be successful in their service to our Parish. Thank you for joining me in welcoming her to our Parish. Ely succeeds Ms. Kathleen Kerwin to whom we owe many thanks for fruitfully serving in this volunteered role since September 2021.

Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie!

Dzisiaj przypada Wniebowstąpienie Pańskie. Właściwie to Święto Wniebowstąpienia powinno być obchodzone w ostatni czwartek (40 dni po Zmartwychwstaniu), jednak ze względów praktycznych, choćby dlatego, by umożliwić wszystkim udział we Mszy św., dlatego biskupi amerykańscy przenieśli tę uroczystość na tę niedzielę. Po wypełnieniu swego posłannictwa na ziemi, czyli po dokonaniu dzieła odkupienia, Chrystus wrócił do Ojca. Choć jako człowiek jest teraz naszym oczom niewidoczny, nie znaczy to wcale, że jest w ogóle nieobecny. Jego istnienie można dostrzec oczyma wiary. Kościół uczy nas, że Chrystus jest obecny w Słowie Bożym, w sakramentach świętych i we wspólnocie wierzących. A więc cały czas jest blisko nas. Pamiętajmy o tym, zwłaszcza gdy przekazujemy wiarę naszym dzieciom. To obowiązek, jaki Jezus zlecił nam przed swoim Wniebowstąpieniem, aby „*iść i nauczać wszystkie narody*”. To polecenie dotyczy także naszych dzieci i wnuków. Ja wiem, że w dzisiejszych czasach coraz trudniej przychodzi nam przekonać ich, by razem z nami się modlili i szli do kościoła. Ale Jezus zapewnia nas, że „*jest z nami, aż do skończenia świata*”. Róbmy więc swoje, nie patrząc na współczesne mody i trendy.

Raz jeszcze gratuluję dzieciom i młodzieży naszej parafii i Szkoły, którzy w ostatnim czasie przystąpili do Pierwszej Komunii św. i przyjęli Sakrament Bierzmowania. Módlcie się za nich, za ich rodziców i bliskich. Proszę też o modlitwę w intencji absolwentów, którzy 2 czerwca otrzymają dyplomy ukończenia nauki w naszej Szkole. Przy okazji przypominam, że trwają już zapisy do Szkoły na przyszły rok.

I na koniec, chciałbym oficjalnie ogłosić, że nasza parafia ma wreszcie Dyrektora do spraw Formacji Religijnej, a jest nią Ely Segura. Stanowisko to jest stosunkowo nowe i stanowi integralną część procesu Renew My Church. Nowa Dyrektor będzie odpowiedzialna przede wszystkim za katechizację przy naszej parafii, ale także za formację religijną dla wszystkich grup wiekowych. Przy okazji bardzo dziękuję Kathy Kerwin, która przez ostatnie 2 lata z wielkim poświęceniem koordynowała nasz Program Katechetyczny.

Was Jesus going to return one day the same way He left via the clouds? Nobody likes dark clouds which announce storms & stress. No one likes to think about end times but it's a fact that God created the clouds. He also created rainbows, the mark of His covenant with mankind. It is His promise that He not leave us orphans. He sent us an Advocate, the Holy Spirit.

2000 years ago, Jerusalem was in crisis not unlike how the world is in crisis today. But as our Psalm today says, we should remember, "For King of all the earth is God. Those sessions changed the course of my story. Since then, I decided that I wanted to be like that catechist and passionately communicate my own path of faith so that others can experience in their lives the wonders that God reveals to us and that he makes complete in the redemptive work of his son Jesus Christ.

It is truly an honor for me to walk with you in this community of faith, where I have received a warm welcome. I want to learn from you and lovingly share what I have learned. May the joy of the Gospel bring us ever closer to our heavenly Father who makes us brothers and sisters.
