A few words from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners.

Today is the Solemnity of Pentecost, the day on which the Apostles received the Holy Spirit. At our Confirmation we too received the Holy Spirit and His gifts were given to us, not just for our own happiness, but for the good of everyone. As we consider the gifts of the Holy Spirit, which do I need most at this time in my life? Wisdom? Understanding? Counsel? Fortitude? Knowledge? Piety? Fear of the Lord?

Every year on this Sunday and Weekend, we celebrate Memorial Day. Though many people look at this holiday as the beginning of the summer season, we should remember the true and only reason we celebrate Memorial Day – to thank and recognize all the men and women who fought for all the freedoms we have. Our veterans – living and dead – gave their lives so we could be blessed in this wonderful country that we have. Memorial Day is a day to “remember” our war dead in prayer. We also pray this weekend for all who currently serve in the military, especially those from our parish or connected to any of our parishioners as family and friends. We will remember them in prayer on Monday, May 29, at 9:00 am. in St. Richard church, and this will be the only Mass celebrated this day in our parish. Memorial Day Masses will also be celebrated at 10:30 am at all of the Archdiocese of Chicago’s major cemeteries.

The school year is coming to the end. I look forward to the next one and remind you about ongoing registration to our School. Recently, I was informed by the Office of Catholic Schools of the Archdiocese of Chicago that our current school structure (two locations) will remain in place for the next School Year 2023-24 with a review in 2024. As you know, Mrs. Marea Jensen will be stepping away from the position of the Principal of our School at the end of the current school year. While we continue to enjoy her leadership, we have begun the search for a new principal. A search committee has been formed and is working with the Office of Catholic Schools to find the best candidate. Please pray for this process and the committee’s work.

Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie!

Dziś obchodzimy uroczystość Zesłania Ducha Świętego. Liturgia tego święta ukazuje nam różne dary związane z obecnością Ducha Świętego w naszym życiu. Każdy, kto otrzymał sakrament Bierzmowania, jest ubogacony siedmioma darami Ducha Świętego: darem Mądrości, Rozumu, Rady, Męstwa, Umiejętności, Pobożności i Bojaźni Bożej. Niech Duch Święty umacnia każdego z nas abyśmy swą wiarę mężnie wyznawali, bronili jej i według niej żyli.

Jutro, w poniedziałek 29 maja, obchodzić będziemy w Ameryce „Memorial Day”, czyli Dzień Pamięci. Jest to święto państwowe, którego celem jest oddanie czci tym, którzy oddali swoje życie w obronie Stanów Zjednoczonych. Jest to dobra okazja by pomodlić się też za tych, którzy aktualnie pełnią służbę wojskową. Uczynimy to w kościele św. Ryszarda, na Mszy o 9:00 rano. Będzie to jedyna Msza św. tego dnia w naszej parafii, ale zachęcam do udziału we Mszach, jakie w poniedziałek 29 maja będą odprawiane na wszystkich katolickich cmentarzach Archidiecezji Chicago. Wszystkie Msze rozpoczną się o tej samej porze, a mianowicie o 10:30 rano.

Cały czas trwają zapisy do naszej Szkoły na kolejny rok szkolny. W tych dniach otrzymałem potwierdzenie z Archidiecezji, że także i w przyszłym roku szkolnym zajęcia będą prowadzone w obu budynkach. Jak wiecie, pani Marea Jensen z końcem bieżącego roku szkolnego ustąpi ze stanowiska dyrektora Szkoły. Rozpoczęliśmy już poszukiwania nowego dyrektora. Powołaliśmy komisję rekrutacyjną, która współpracuje z Biurem Szkół Katolickich w celu znalezienia najlepszego kandydata.

Fruits of Holy Communion

Question: What are the "fruits" of holy Communion?

Answer:

The Eucharist, like all sacraments, offers its own unique grace. We receive a special share in God's life that helps us in our faith journey. We are given all we need to sustain and nurture our relationship with God. The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. Everything we are and everything we hope to become is found in this sacrament. It is essential to the life of the church, to each member of the church. Without it, there is no church. The Eucharist is the center of our spiritual life and has enormous effects on our growth, our holiness, and our way of life. The fruits of holy Communion are the benefits one receives from the sacrament. These fruits of holy Communion are discussed in the catechism in the article on the Eucharist. The primary benefit is union with Christ. We become one with him sacramentally, just as we hope to become one with him for eternity. The Eucharist also separates us from sin, both past and future. It forgives the venial sins of the past and, by the love we receive, protects us from mortal sin in the future. The church community is also unified and strengthened by the Eucharist. It unites us to the poor and offers the pledge of eternal life.
