Dear Parishioners.

It's hard to believe, but it's already May – the loveliest month of the year, and so the month fittingly dedicated to our Blessed Mother. We can honor her among others by praying the Rosary or the Litany of Loreto. When we honor Mary, we honor also all our mothers whose love and dedication we can sometimes take for granted. Next Sunday, May 14, is Mother's Day. If you would like to remember your Mother, Stepmother, Grandmother, Aunt or anyone who is "mother" to you, with a spiritual gift - a special Mass intention - please pick up a Mother's Day Mass Intention envelope which can be found at the exit of the church. Your "special person" will be remembered during a Novena of Masses. Please complete the information on the envelope and place it in the collection basket with your offering when you come to Mass. At the end of all the Masses, there will be a special blessing for all the mothers. There will be also a second collection next Sunday for the Catholic Charities of Chicago Archdiocese which run a number of programs for women and children.

This Wednesday, May 10, is the last day of our Religious Education for this school year. I would like to thank our CCD coordinator Kathy Kerwin and her team of catechists and volunteers for their dedicated efforts this past year.

This Saturday, May 13, we will have the second of our two Saturday Masses for the celebration of First Holy Communion for our children. Please continue to pray for the children from our School as they share in the Eucharistic Banquet and receive the Lord's Body in Holy Communion for the first time.

I want to thank everyone for their attention to and support of the Annual Catholic Appeal 2023. The parish is currently \$30,740 toward our goal of \$31,812 through the generosity of 82 donors. Remember that every dollar over our goal amount will be rebated directly to the parish.

Drodzy Parafianie!

Rozpoczął się maj. To jeden z miesięcy tradycyjnie poświęconych Matce Bożej. Niech będzie on dla nas zachętą do ożywienia naszej przyjaźni z Maryją. Wychwalajmy Ją odmawiając litanię loretańską i rozważając tajemnice Różańca świętego, ale także naśladowmy Jej święte życie, aby Maryja stała się naszą pośredniczką przed tronem swojego Syna.

W przyszłą niedzielę 14 maja, obchodzony będzie w Ameryce Dzień Matki. Tego dnia w naszych modlitwach w sposób szczególny będziemy pamiętać o naszych Mamach, tak tych żyjących jak i zmarłych. Przy wyjściu z kościoła wyłożone są specjalne kopertki, na których można wpisać imię swojej Mamy. Z ofiar składanych do tych kopert, przez 9 kolejnych dni, będzie także odprawiona Nowenna Mszy świętych w ich intencji. Druga składka w przyszłą niedzielę, będzie przeznaczona na Catholic Charities - katolicką organizację charytatywną, która prowadzi wiele programów dla kobiet i dzieci.

Przy okazji bardzo dziękuję za kolejne ofiary na Apel Katolicki. W chwili, gdy piszę te słowa zebraliśmy już w deklaracjach \$30,740 i to tylko od 82 Rodzin. Wynika z tego, że tegoroczny cel został już prawie osiągnięty. To bardzo dobra wiadomość.

Wielkimi krokami zbliżamy się do końca kolejnego roku katechetycznego w naszej parafii. W tę środę będą ostatnie lekcje religii, a w sobotę druga grupa dzieci, tym razem z naszej Szkoły, przystąpi do Pierwszej Komunii świętej. YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS

Today's first reading from the Acts of the Apostles on this 5th Sunday of Easter is an amazing coincidence for me. Twenty-three years ago on this day, I was ordained by the late Cardinal George with my classmates. We were known as the "baker's dozen" thirteen men. The reading today is about the formation of the diaconate. I clearly recall lying prostrate on the floor of Holy Name Cathedral surrounded by my dear friends, with arms extended above our heads, as the whole church sang the litany of the saints. It was a humbling moment for me. The call that had haunted me for years, no longer was nagging because I finally fully accepted God's call to be ordained into His work on earth. I am so truly blessed to be able to serve God & the people of God, His church. It's sad for me to be part of the many wakes & funerals I have participated in but it's necessary for all of us to remember God in the good times & the difficult moments. So deacons are there to comfort & welcome people all the way home. Gratefully, I have also been there to baptize & witness marriages, visit the homebound & hospitalized & bless baskets, homes, pets & lots of meals as well. I have been able to preach & teach & deliver food & clothing to those who are in need too. Being a deacon is so vital to me, but even more important for the needs of the church. Other's in the diaconate visit those in prison, at truck stops, the homeless, write books serve as drs, police officers, laborers & so much more. Maybe there are men among us, who are hearing that call but need some encouragement to answer. Maybe there are women who feel their spouses have that call & need their support to become deacons. There is always a great need, as Jesus is recorded in Luke 10:2. He told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few." Pray to the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field to become deacons & priests. All priests are deacons, one of the steps of ordination. If you know or are someone who wants to learn more about becoming a deacon, please talk to me, the priests or Deacons Ed or Sal. God needs you.

May is the month dedicated to the veneration of our Blessed Mother. Those April Showers brought forth the flowers that we lay at her feet when we create those May altars of our childhood. It's also a time at the newly renamed Shrine of Our Lady of Champion in WI near Green Bay's, "Walk to Mary." It's the only approved Marian Apparition Shrine in the US when in 1859 she appeared to Adele Brise. Perhaps, you can consider a trip out to this beautiful place that is only a few hours away. The "Walk to Mary" is a 21 mile walk. Why do they walk? Well on the webpage it says, "We walk to her because she calls us. We walk because life is a journey of discovery & revelation, not a destination. Along the way, we tire, toil & triumph. We empty ourselves out, making room for the Holy Spirit to expand within us. When we arrive, tired & exhausted, we encounter the Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help (now known as Our Lady of Champion) as a refreshing oasis along life's journey, offering respite for all who are weary & thirsty" My mobility issues make that impossible, but that doesn't mean I can't say a rosary today as I do every day with my wife. Go to Mary, she opens many doors for all of her adopted children. See you in church?

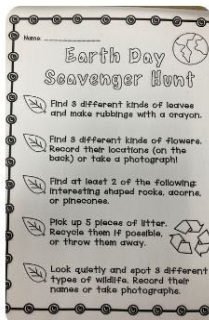

Why do we do that?

Catholic Life Explained

Question:

Do children need to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation before their First Communion?

Answer:

For centuries the Catholic Church has taught that a person needs to be in a state of grace (free from mortal sins) in order to worthily receive the Eucharist. To that end, Catholics should make an effort to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation any time they recognize the need for the sacrament (and in keeping with the precept of the Church that asks that we celebrate this sacrament at least once each year).

In the case of children preparing for their First Communion, the Code of Canon Law is very clear that they should also celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation before receiving the Eucharist for the first time: "It is the responsibility, in the first place, of parents and those who take the place of parents as well as of the pastor to see that children who have reached the use of reason are correctly prepared and are nourished by the divine food as early as possible, preceded by sacramental confession" (Canon 914).

While some might question the significance of the Sacrament of Reconciliation — especially in the case of children who might not fully understand the reality of sin or the meaning of the sacrament itself — a child's "First Confession" can be a wonderful time for families to reflect together on the quality of their relationships, how they put their faith into practice, and, when it is possible, to celebrate the sacrament as a family. In the end, the celebration of these two sacraments marks important moments in the spiritual journeys of children and we hope their "First Confession" and "First Communion" help instill in them a love of the sacraments of the Church.
