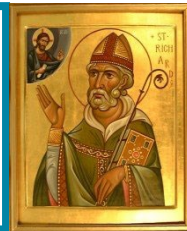

Dear Parishioners!

I hope everyone enjoyed a joyous Thanksgiving Day in the company of family. This Sunday, as we end the Liturgical Year, we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. When we think of a king, we think of someone who lords it over his people. But Christ is not like that. He came to serve, not to be served. The one thing He wants from us is that we imitate Him. Let us look at ourselves today, at our everyday lives and ask what is our goal. Material things take up a big portion of our time and lives, how much time do we devote to the matters of God which are everlasting? Drodzy Parafianie.

Mam nadzieję, że Święto Dziękczynienia było udane i spędziliście mile czas w gronie najbliższych i znajomych. A dziś obchodzimy Uroczystość Chrystusa Króla. Wszyscy znacie słowa hymnu „Króluj nam Chryste, zawsze i wszędzie,” ale czy zastanawialiście się kiedykolwiek nad tym, co one tak naprawdę znaczą? Co to znaczy, że Jezus ma królować w naszym życiu? Czy to tylko puste słowa, które śpiewamy tak po prostu z przyzwyczajenia, z tradycji? Ile miejsca w naszym życiu zajmują sprawy materialne, krótkie i przemijające, a ile miejsca zajmują sprawy Boże, wieczne i nieprzemijające? Pomyślmy trochę nad tym i jeśli trzeba, podejmiemy konkretne postanowienia na nadchodzący czas Adwentu.

Już niedługo, 12 grudnia, obchodzić będziemy Uroczystość Matki Bożej z Guadalupe. Wspólnota Latynoska, moimi ustami, zaprasza wszystkich do udziału w Nowennie do Matki Bożej z Guadalupe, która będzie mieć miejsce w obu naszych kościołach, codziennie, przez 9 kolejnych dni, od przyszłej niedzieli 3 grudnia. Nowenna będzie obejmowała Różaniec i Mszę św. Choć modlitwy będą po hiszpańsku, to jednak wszyscy są mile widziani. Dokładny plan Nowenny podany jest w dzisiejszym biuletynie.

YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS

This weekend is the Solemnity of Christ the King which marks the end of the church's liturgical Year A. Our new year B starts with the first Sunday of Advent, the prelude to Christmas. Sometimes when I am proclaiming the gospel on this Sunday, I will slam the Book of Gospels loudly, waking up all the distracted people in church. Not only the closing of the book is important, but the message of this gospel is eternally soul-saving or not, depending on how seriously people respond. However, we should all consider the warning that is given by Jesus to all of us, because none of us are going to get through life without a judgment day. Just like the song, "Soon & Very Soon, We are Going to Meet the King."

I like to think of it as a room with two chairs, one for you & the other for Christ, our King. That time will mark the end of our earthly life & the beginning of eternal life. Christ died to open the gates of heaven. Our eternal salvation awaits us but it also can be denied because of our choices. This is a critical moment that should be taken seriously, so I pray always for people who say they have left the church because they are mad for one reason or another. Jesus tells us repeatedly in so many ways, that He sits on the right hand of God the Father, to judge the living & dead. Are you willing to meet Him as a stranger or as a friend? Jesus tells us that our decisions in life do matter. We have responsibility & this parable warns us to accept it. Some think that all people will be eternally reconciled with God, that God's love will over-power any human resistance. Wishful thinking in the light of today's Gospel when He separates the sheep from the goats! God's love is not forced on us, then we cannot be sure that some will not resist that love after a lifetime of rejecting God's offer of love either. The Scriptures teach that it is not His desire that anyone should perish. Today's Gospel makes clear that our daily decisions have lasting consequences. Experience has shown us that our decisions in this life both unite & separate us from each another all the time. The sum total of our decisions effectively unites or separates us from God as well, only that choice is eternal. When Jesus walked on this earth, He gave us two commandments. We hear that His judgment will be based on the extent of our love of God & love of neighbor spelled out in today's Gospel. So are we treating the least as we would ourselves? Or are we slamming a door on their needs, resenting their presence in our cities or families as intruders or annoyances instead? Jesus said, whatsoever you do for the least of my brothers, that you do unto me.

Hope you had a blessed Thanksgiving but are not already stressing out about the holiday prep ahead. The spirit of Thanksgiving needs to remain with us all year through. And for those of us who gobbled up those shopping bags & returned them filled for the poor, God's blessings for your generosity. They loaded up the bed of my pickup truck 2x, as they were delivered to the good Sisters who staff our Catholic charities food pantries. The needy are with us all year, so if you can please continue to fill our food boxes all year, thank you in advance. Our next project is the Christmas Giving Tree. Please take an ornament from the tree & help support this important effort as well. The cost of living is rising for all of us! The church may be tax exempt by not inflation exempt. The need is growing every year. All good things come from God, please share it with those who can't help themselves. See you in church?

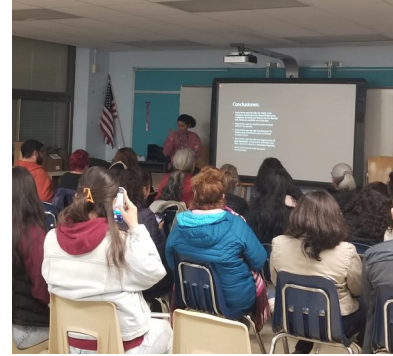
Querida comunidad de fe:
