

The month of October traditionally has been designated by the Church as the month of the Holy Rosary due to the reason that the Feast of the Holy Rosary is celebrated on October 7th each year. In the various approved apparitions of our Lady, such as at Lourdes and Fatima, our Lady has urged the praying of the Rosary for especially the conversion of sinners and for peace.

Kathy Kerwin has been very involved in the parish especially at St. Richard. She has been in the Parish Pastoral Council and ministered as a Coordinator of Religious Education. Congratulations to Kathy Kerwin and thank you for all you do at Sts. Bruno & Richard Parish.

And finally, you can also find elsewhere in this bulletin the announcement about the Blessing of Animals on this Saturday, October 7th. People love to bring their pets and it's always very heart-warming to see all the animals, to see how their owners and others interact with them, and to remember that animals are integral parts of God's creation that we must reverence and appreciate. Just a reminder! This is a blessing, not an exorcism. We can bless your pets, but we can't make your pets behave.

Today's gospel from Matthew, Jesus tells the parable of the man with two sons being given a task to do. It touches on an easy way of getting out of obligations like chores or anything else. It's called "lip service"...agree to do it but just ignore doing it. Just like if I owned a restaurant & posted a sign in my window, "Free food, tomorrow." It would be false advertising, procrastination, out right lying. Tomorrow never comes if the sign doesn't have a specific date. It may lure people back but they won't get a free meal. Stringing someone along, holding out in telling the truth, is not the way to do things honestly. Either way, it always bring consequences. That sometimes happens with unscrupulous contractors who promise a job, take a deposit & the work is never done. The customer is cheated.

Jesus said a man asked: "Son, go out & work in the vineyard today.' He said in reply, 'I will not but afterwards changed his mind & went. The man came to the other son & gave the same order. He said in reply, 'Yes, sir, 'but did not go. Which of the two did his father's will?" They answered, "The first." Jesus said to them, "Amen, I say to you, tax collectors & prostitutes are entering the kingdom of God before you." Why, because they repented & did God's will. Lip service is not good, especially if you are lying to God. That's morally wrong & a sin. Enough said.

Hello October, the month of the rosary. When was the last time you said one, especially as a family? The family rosary broadcasts every day on 950 AM Relevant Radio @7 PM. The late Pope Benedict said, he only did a decade a day because there was so much to meditate on with each mystery. It is our greatest weapon after the Mass against evil. It is also Fire Prevention month. Time to change the batteries in our smoke/CO2 detectors. The life you save may be your own. October also is Respect Life month. Roe v.Wade may be overturned federally but there is still legal abortion in many states especially in Illinois. And euthanasia globally is growing. Pray for the protection of all life, from the womb to the tomb.

Finally, it's time for hopefully the 1st of many guardian angel stories from our parishioners. This one happened years ago. A young women & her 3 companions were on Rt 83 when she swerved to avoid debris causing her vehicle to flip on its roof & slide. Gratefully, their seatbelts & probably her guardian angel saved them from serious injury. She said, "When we all got out of the car, the 4 of us were standing together shaking. This man came up to us, hugged me said, "I'm Father...from the church 3 blocks away. I heard the accident & wanted to let you know that you'll be ok". He turned me to face my friend & then none of us saw where he went. When I described him to my mom later, she said "I believe he's your guardian angel, because when you were 3 yrs old, your aunt accidentally closed the locked car door onto your hand & we couldn't get it opened. This man suddenly came up to the car, opening the door, freeing your hand, placing your hand into his mouth, & you immediately stopped crying. Your hand was fine! PS, when her car was righted by the tow company, etched visibly on the hood, were the letters, J.E.S..& half of the letter U! I believe in angels. God is good. All the time! See you in church?



"This is my body": A call to Eucharistic Revival

In 2019 Pew Research published that around 70% of Catholics in this country believe in the Eucharist as a symbol, but not as the real presence of Jesus Christ. Therefore, the Church in the US started, in 2021, a movement called "National Eucharistic Revival".
