YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS



On this 28th Sunday of Ordinary time, Jesus told the parable of the Wedding Feast. He said: "Many are invited, but few are chosen." The ultimate wedding feast is the Kingdom of Heaven, are we prepared or are we refusing to go? Are we properly dressed in our wedding garment to celebrate with the King or are we wearing rags? Well, today's sermon is about being properly dressed. But it's not about what you wear to church or work or school. It's about being clothed in the righteousness of God. And what I hope you'll get out it is this: While God is perfectly willing to clothe us in the garments of Christ, it's up to us put them on and wear them faithfully to the glory of God. I am privileged to baptize & one of the things that is done is we give the newly baptized a white bib, saying, "You have put on Christ, in you are a new creation." Translated, we are now a child of God, we are expected to live our lives reflecting Him in all ways, by word, deed & thought. Are you doing that each day? Keeping our soul in grace, keeping it sinless prepared to attend that Heavenly banquet one day? Either way, the message is the same: Whatever your excuse, the kingdom must go on. God is at work reconciling the world to Himself & if we're too busy or, for whatever reason, unwilling to follow God, He will choose others to do his bidding like in the parable.. To be a disciple of Jesus Christ is to make Him your first priority, to offer the first fruits of our time, talent, gifts and service... not whatever's left over after everything else is done, or you just are not interested in reconciling your life to God.

Annually, the deacons hold a St. Francis day dinner the 1st Sunday of Oct. There were over 300 people this year including Bishop Birmingham, a 51 yr old auxiliary bishop of our diocese. His family had close ties to the late Fr. Ernie Ciemenga of St. Bruno & I got the chance to talk to him while I waited for my wife to get the car. I knew his family cared for Fr. Ernie's dog while he was alive. And we shared a laugh when he told me that his family inherited the German shepherd when Fr. Ernie died. I was so happy to meet him in person. Next morning, a fellow deacon called me to say that Bishop Birmingham died in his sleep. "Like a thief in the night." The banguet is ready, are we?

If you are not thinking about your eternal destiny, your tomorrow might be sooner than you think? What's keeping you from doing it right now? Say a rosary, go to confession, come to mass, the heavenly feast, here on earth. It's the perfect time, don't delay. Don't get lost in the attractions & distractions of the world only to find out the doors to the Kingdom have been closed to you. Make good choices to protect life from the womb to the tomb. Help those less fortunate by filling our food donation boxes at the entrance of our parish. Pray for the dearly departed & for our families who have fallen away to reconcile with the church as well. Live each day reflecting our Lord clothed in the garment of salvation which we all received at baptism. Have you accepted the invitation, or have you been persistently refusing the Holy Spirit when He tugs at your heart? Are you dining with the King, or are you caught up in the cares of life? Are you ready for the King to come, or will He find you unprepared? Don't wait. Come to the feast." Many are called, but few are chosen." See you in church?
