A few words from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners!

Welcome everyone on this second Sunday of October. By tradition, the Catholic Church dedicated each month of the year to certain devotion. The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary, one of the best known of all Catholic devotions. In the various proved apparitions of Our Lady, such as Lourdes, Fatima or Guadalupe, Our Lady has urged the praying of the Rosary for especially the conversion of sinners and for peace. While, strictly speaking, we are not obliged to pray the Rosary but to not practice the devotion of praying the Rosary is to miss out on the promises that Our Lady has made to those who faithfully pray the Rosary. That's why I encourage everyone to pray the rosary together in the church, or at home with your families, or if this is not possible, try to pray the rosary individually.

Last month we observed the 98th anniversary of the establishment of St. Bruno Parish and today we celebrate the feast day of its patron saint. His appointed feast day was October 6th, but the Church says, that parishes can celebrate their patron Saint's feast on the Sunday closest to their feast, so we are celebrating it today. Parishes, like Christians, are most often named after a saint, and from this saint receive not only heavenly protection, but a certain character, even personality. The patron of each parish shapes the spiritual life of that parish. As parishioners of Saints Bruno & Richard Parish we approach each day under their patronage. We cry out to them for protection, intercession and thanksgiving.

And last but not least, you may have noticed our Ushers counting participants at our Masses. This count will continue for the entire month in the famous Archdiocesan "October Count." Let us see what this October 2023 brings.

Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie.

Trwa październik, miesiąc poświęcony Matce Boskiej Różańcowej, kiedy to każdy katolik powinien wziąć do ręki różaniec i za Jej wstawiennictwem modlić się na nim polecając Bogu intencje swojego serca. Jak Chrystus nauczył nas modlitwy Pańskiej „Ojcze nasz”, tak Maryja nauczyła nas modlić się słowami różańca. Niestety, ale modlitwa różańcowa, niegdyś tak powszechnie odmawiana, w dzisiejszych czasach nie znajduje już takiego zrozumienia. Tymczasem ci, którzy nadal ją odmawiają, mogą zaświadczenie, jak wiele łask doznali za jej pośrednictwem. Poglębia ona zrozumienie podstawowych tajemnic wiary przez rozważanie życia Chrystusa, uczy cierpliwości i wytrwałości w modlitwie i ułatwia nam skupienie się przed Bogiem, obejmując nasze myśli, nasze usta i nasze ręce. Dziękujmy Bogu i Maryi, że dali nam tak prosty i skuteczny środek pozwalający doświadczyć ich miłości.

W ubiegłym miesiącu przypadła 98-a rocznica powstania parafii św. Brunona, a dziś obchodzimy święto patronalne kościoła - św. Brunona. Właściwie to wspomnienie św. Brunona przypada 6 października, ale przepisy liturgiczne zezwalają na to, aby odpust przenosić na najbliższą niedzielę. Dzięki temu większa ilość wiernych może bliżej poznać Patrona swego kościoła, a przez to uczyć się od niego jak należy naśladować Chrystusa w codziennym życiu. Patron kościoła czy parafii pełni rolę opiekuna, który wstawia się przed Bogiem za tymi, którzy zostali powierzeni jego opiece. Patron jest więc nie tylko wzorem do naśladowania, ale także pewnego rodzaju pośrednikiem między Bogiem i ludźmi. Niech więc wstawiennictwo św. Brunona i św. Ryszarda wspiera nas w naszej życiowej wędrówce.

W październiku także, we wszystkich kościołach Archidiecezji Chicago odbywa się tradycyjne liczenie wiernych uczestniczących w niedzielnych Mszach. O wynikach tegorocznego liczenia podzielię się z Wami w listopadzie. Sam jestem ciekaw co przyniesie tegoroczne liczenie.

YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS

Ask any concerned parent, what do you worry about the most? The majority will agree that they worry about their children. We worry when they are little & we worry about them when they are grown & on their own as well. How many of us stayed up late waiting for our teens to come home safely? How many have knelt at their bedsides when they were sick? How many of us wept when we dropped them off at college for the 1st, 2nd, 10th time? How many of us prayed when our kids were struggling with addictions, missed opportunities & poor choices.

On this 27th Sunday of Ordinary time, we hear two things in the good news. First, in Phillipians, "Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer & petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God. Then the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts & minds in Christ Jesus." Secondly, we hear Jesus relate the parable of the landowner of the vineyard & his wicked tenants who kill both the servants of the landowner & finally the landowner's own son when they come to collect his share of the harvest. Jesus said to high priests, "Did you never read in the Scriptures: The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; by the Lord has this been done, & it is wonderful in our eyes? Therefore, I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken away from you & be given to a people that will produce its fruit." When the landowner sent his Son, the landowner is God the Father & Jesus is His son. We all know that Jesus was crucified & rejected but we also know the great news, He rose & conquered death, opening the gates of Heaven for all who believe. Hopefully, that is everyone reading this message & more.

Imagine how God loves all of His creation & how He at times is rejected & His followers are mistreated even martyred in abortion today 2000 years later. I read this recently, "A cloud of gnats may put as much poison into a man with their many stings as will a snake with its one bite. And if we are not to get help from God by telling Him about little things, there will be very little of our lives that we shall tell Him about at all." My suggestion, especially during this month of respect life & the rosary, is to bring our concerns to God every day. As St. Padre Pio said, 'Pray, hope & don't worry.'

Finally, another true angel story, told by a retired FBI agent on 9/11. Lillie Leonardi said she saw legions of angels guarding the Pennsylvania site where United Airlines Flight 93 crashed. When she arrived at the site just three hours after the crash, she was struck by numerous elements. She was so startled, she kept it to herself out of fear that her co-workers would think she lost her mind. "I started seeing shimmery lights...and it was kind of misty & that's when I first saw angels there, I just saw angels on the crash site,' I didn't tell anyone in fear my superiors would say that I had lost my mind. They were dressed as if they were in warrior garb like a Roman centurion, she said. There were so many of them, you couldn't see their faces. She continued to see flickers of light, each angel guarding the crash site. Her hope in sharing her story is that people would know that God was present on that fateful day. Thank you God for sending your angels to light & guard, to rule & guide us every day of our lives. See you in church?


