It certainly has been a good and busy summer here in our parish. As you may have noticed, we have completely renovated St. Richard church parking lot this summer. The pictures in today's bulletin show the progression from the beginning to the end of capital renovation of the parking lot. The renovation was completed for a total cost of \$81,312, so \$8,688 less than we expected. A part of the parking lot project has been paid for in parts by offerings given to the "To Teach Who Christ is" campaign (\$20,000) and Parish Building Fund (\$7,920). And donations from parishioners of \$3,027, but it's not enough. That's why we count on you. Thank you very much to all those who have already made a donation. If you would like to make a gift to this project, you may use the special (orange) envelopes provided for this purpose at the exits of St. Richard church. Thank you for your generosity. A special thanks to our Operations Director Monica Rodriguez & Deacon Larry Chyba who were instrumental in making this project a success.

This Monday, along with others across America, we remember the events of September 11th on the 22nd Anniversary of this tragic event. We remember the victims and the first responders, who lost their lives, as well as their relatives and friends left behind. May we all come to understand that violence is always the problem and never the solution. This is true for both individuals and nations.

Mam nadzieję, że mieliście udany Labor Day weekend spędzony w gronie rodziny i przyjaciół. Labor Day w Ameryce to nieoficjalny koniec lata. Wielu z Was jest już po urloпах i wróciliście już do swoich codziennych zajęć. Rozpoczynając wakacje robiliście sobie pewne plany. Ciekawe co z tych postanowień udało się zrealizować. Gdy idzie o parafię to my tu nie próżnowaliśmy. Jak widzicie, wykorzystaliśmy czas wakacji na kompletny remont parkingu przy kościele św. Ryszarda. W dzisiejszym biuletynie parafialnym zamieściliśmy kilka zdjęć z postępu prac od początku aż do końca remontu. Całkowity koszt remontu wyniósł \$81,312, czyli o \$8,688 mniej, niż początkowo zakładaliśmy. Parking został częściowo opłacony z datków przekazanych na rzecz kampanii "To Teach Who Christ Is" (\$20,000) i Funduszu Remontowego (\$7,920). Bardzo dziękuję za pierwsze ofiary parafian (\$3,027) i liczę na pozostałych. Do tego celu można użyć specjalnie oznakowane kopertki, które wyłożone są przy wyjściu z kościoła św. Ryszarda. Już dziś dziękuję za wszystkie ofiary. Specjalne podziękowania należą się naszej Operation Director Monice Rodriguez i Diakonowi Larry'emu Chyba, którzy odegrali kluczową rolę w powodzeniu tego projektu.

Jutro, 11 września, przypada 22-a rocznica zamachu terrorystycznego na bliźniacze wieże World Trade Center w Nowym Jorku, w którym zginęło prawie 3 tysiące ludzi (w tym także Polacy). YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS



“If today you hear His voice, harden not your hearts.” Psalm 95. This is the refrain from this weekend's good news. This made me have two ideas. One, do we listen to the voice of God calling us? Do you realize that He is trying to get our attention? He is speaking to us in order to help us because He loves us. But are we like that teenager who hears their parents calling them but we choose not to listen & respond because we don't want to do what is expected? Are we afraid that what he expects is something that is not what we want to hear. What is in our life that hardens our hearts? I'm not a doctor, however most of us know that if at your last checkup the dr recommended medication, a change in diet or adding exercise would slow down or prevent your arteries to harden, we start worrying. Physically we might be able to improve our health if we heed those warnings but spiritually are we willing to make alterations in the way we live? “If today you hear His voice, harden not your hearts.” Sin is what blocks the sound of God's voice & grace. God still speaks today, but we must follow Him to recognize His voice. There are so many voices vying for our attention, especially with the increased use of technology, social media & relativism in our culture. Yet God's voice must be the voice we heed. Jesus is our Good Shepherd: the shepherd opens the gate for his sheep & the sheep listen to his voice. Some will permanently harden their hearts, but even believers can harden their hearts for a period of time. When people ignore who God is & what He has done. When people hold onto sin, their hearts harden. When people allow circumstances to cloud their thinking & let their feelings dictate their actions, their hearts harden. It is God's Word & frequent reception of the sacraments of Reconciliation & the Eucharist that keeps our hearts soft & pure: “For the body & blood, soul & divinity of Jesus is alive & active. His words are sharper than any double-edged sword. So follow my prescription for a healthier heart :Be willing to make the time to come to mass & confession so that you can clearly hear His voice, despite your busy life. Do whatever it takes so that you may one day have eternal life with Him in heaven.

This week we commemorate that tragic day in our nation's history, Sept 11, 2001. May we never forget the victims & their families as well as all the servicemen & women who lost their lives & continue to fight each day protecting this nation from terror. Eternal rest unto them O Lord, May they rest in peace . Amen.

Speaking of history, now that school has resumed, I recommend asking your children at dinnertime, when everyone is gathered together, what they are learning in school. Don't just glance at the title of their books, open them & see for yourselves. Particularly what they are learning about their faith & morals. And if you have questions or concerns that something is missing or disturbing or you think might be a great value for them to learn about, make an appointment with their teachers. The more involved you are in their education especially in their faith, the more likely your children will “hear your voice too.” See you in church?

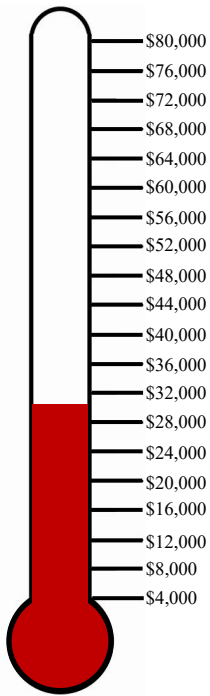
