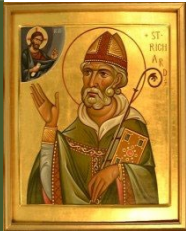

Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie.

To już ostatnie dni lata. W sobotę, 23 września, zacznie się kalendarzowa jesień. Jeszcze trochę i z drzew zaczną opadać liście. Mamy już za sobą pierwszy miesiąc nauki w naszej Szkole. Tydzień temu rozpoczęliśmy także kolejny rok katechetyczny. Tak się składa, że właśnie dziś obchodzona jest w Kościele tak zwana Niedziela Katechetyczna. Myślę, że jest to dobra okazja, aby podziękować wszystkim katechetom, którzy z upoważnienia Kościoła, przekazują naszym dzieciom i młodzieży podstawy chrześcijańskiej wiary. Bardzo im za to dziękujemy.

Dzisiaj również mamy coroczną zbiórkę na Seminarium w Mundelein. Aby zostać księdzem, potrzeba wielu lat formacji osobistej, duchowej i akademickiej. Nasze wsparcie finansowe pomaga zapewnić środki potrzebne do tego. „Bóg Zapłać” za Wasze ofiary na ten cel.

Wrzesień to także miesiąc, w którym wiele grup parafialnych, po wakacyjnej przerwie, wznawia swoją działalność. Tak jak Rada Finansowa doradza w sprawach finansowych i materialnych, tak Rada Duszpasterska doradza mi w sprawach duszpasterskich. Najbliższe posiedzenie Rady Duszpasterskiej odbędzie się w ten wtorek, 19 września. YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS



On this 24th Sunday of Ordinary Time, we hear these words from the book of Sirach: "Wrath & anger are hateful things, yet the sinner hugs them tight." And the Psalm response is "The Lord is kind & merciful, slow to anger & rich in compassion." That's why when Peter asked Jesus, in the gospel of Matthew: "'Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?' Jesus replied, 'I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times.'" It is critical for all of us to take this message to heart. There is so much hatred, road rage & violence all around us. Forgiveness is not a top priority or for some even a possibility. People are suing others, even family members anytime for anything. "To err is human, to forgive divine" is the old saying from as far back as the 18th century. But Jesus said it more than 2000 years before then & the Old Testament even longer than that. It doesn't mean Catholics are doormats, it means that Christians follow Jesus' instructions instead.

My question: How do you feel when you say that you hate someone? Now how do you feel when you say you love someone? Are you capable of turning the other cheek to someone who has injured you or someone you love? Do you have to have the last word in all arguments? Do you believe, only your way is the acceptable way of doing something or are you open to compromise or forgiveness? Are you open to real discussion & exchange of ideas or is your heart closed to any other ideas. Forgiveness is a free gift of God, bought by Christ at the cross. It is also a command: "as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive" (Colossians 3:13). Today's gospel is a tough one for some of us to swallow. God keeps His promise & Jesus explained it to us in his parable of the master with his servant, "I forgave you your entire debt because you begged me to. Should you not have had pity on your fellow servant, as I had pity on you?" Then in anger his master handed him over to the torturers until he should pay back the whole debt. So will my heavenly Father do to you, unless each of you forgives your brother from your heart." Having hate is a festering wound that cannot heal unless we forgive the one who may have caused us injury. Remember this amazing advice of Jesus..."I give you a new commandment; love one another as I have loved you."

Nearly every week, Steve Vatch, our 9AM organist shares the Rockford diocese news publication with my bride & me. One article caught my eye & I want to share it with you. At the end of Sept. is the Feast of the Archangels, SS Michael, Raphael & Gabriel. Oct 1st marks the Feast of our Guardian Angels. The publication is asking its readers to submit stories about how their Guardian Angels have interceded in their lives & they will share it with all of us. I want to extend that same invitation to you. Personally, I say the Guardian Angel prayer regularly, asking my angel to light & guard, rule & guide me every day. Prayer is vital for all intervention so it's good to pray for our angel's intercession too. St. Jon Bosco left us some excellent advice about our Guardian Angels back in the 1840s. He truly walked the walk in entrusting his care to his angel He taught his students how Blessed Joan of the Cross had been privileged to see her guardian angel. Wouldn't it be great to see our's! Please consider telling me your angel story & I will share it for all to read. See you in church?

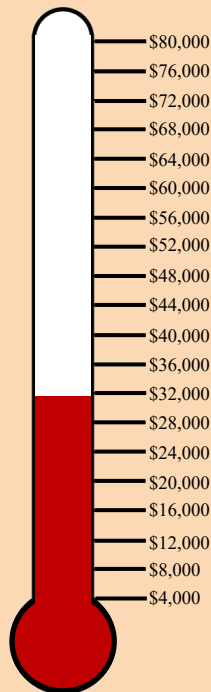
