Dear Parishioners!

Last weekend we celebrated Seminary Sunday. Thank you for supporting seminarians and vocation to the priesthood through your prayers and donations for the Seminary in Mundelein.

Next Friday, September 29th, on the Feast of Sts. Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, together with the students from our School, we will celebrate a special Mass for all our local First Responders. Mass will take place at 8:00 AM, at St. Richard church. These men and women are our spouses, parents, children, aunts, uncles, and neighbors. Day in and day out they see their "labor" as protecting us. Sometimes we might take for granted the sacrifice and risk they take each and every time they put on their uniform or go to work. Next Friday we want to say thank you. Please join us.

As we approach October, let us remember that in October we especially focus upon two themes. First, traditionally October is the Month of the Holy Rosary. Second, it is also Respect Life Month. Being both, we are especially encouraged by the Church to pray the Rosary for respect for all human lives. If everyone and every family would at least pray one decade of the Rosary each day of October, this would be a wonderful way to participate in the Pro-Life cause, which has its foundation in prayer.

Drodzy Parafianie.

Tydzień temu przeżywaliśmy Niedzielę Seminaryjną. Bardzo dziękuję za modlitwę w intencji kleryków i o nowe powołania kapłańskie. Dziękuję także za ofiary na Seminarium Duchowne Archidiecezji Chicago w Mundelein.

Angels—messengers from God—appear frequently in Scripture, but only Michael, Gabriel and Raphael are named.

Michael appears in Daniel's vision as "the great prince" who defends Israel against its enemies; in the Book of Revelation, he leads God's armies to final victory over the forces of evil. Devotion to Michael is the oldest angelic devotion, rising in the East in the fourth century. The Church in the West began to observe a feast honoring Michael and the angels in the fifth century.

Gabriel also makes an appearance in Daniel's visions, announcing Michael's role in God's plan. His best-known appearance is an encounter with a young Jewish girl named Mary, who consents to bear the Messiah.

Raphael's activity is confined to the Old Testament story of Tobit. There he appears to guide Tobit's son Tobiah through a series of fantastic adventures which lead to a threefold happy ending: Tobiah's marriage to Sarah, the healing of Tobit's blindness, and the restoration of the family fortune.

YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS

Autumn has officially arrived, the calm before the storm before all you social butterflies start your shopping etc. I know people have been putting up their Halloween decorations & visiting pumpkin patches as well. But until then let's celebrate the many liturgical holidays upcoming of not only the Catholic faith of the feasts of the Archangels Michael, Gabriel & Raphael, St. Jerome, the Little Flower St Therese, Our Guardian Angels, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Faustina & one of our patrons St. Bruno. Sept 25th is the holiest days for our Jewish cousins, Yom Kippur, a day of atonement & repentance that follows Rosh Hashanah, aka the Jewish New Year.. For the Jews, it's the time of the year when God decides the fate of each person, so they are encouraged to make amends & ask forgiveness. In 1965, the opening game of the World Series occurred on this day & LA Dodger Hall of Famer, Sandy Koufax, a famous Jewish pitcher refused to play on this day. He observed his faith & gave homage to God. Would you do that if opening day was Easter?

The days are getting shorter & the nights longer, but there are still the same 24 hours in every day of the year. How much time do you spend with Jesus? God is our Father & loves us unconditionally not just when we are good. So shouldn't we consider spending more time learning about Him, reading Scripture, coming to mass, reconciling with Him in Confession, receiving Holy Communion, regularly attending mass & observing His greatest commandment, to love one another as He loves us? Are we praying everyday too, not just 1 x a week?

On this 25th Sunday of Ordinary Time, the gospel of Matthew relates the parable of the landowner of the vineyard who goes out to hire workers, all agreeing on the daily wage. He goes out four more times throughout the day, hiring more men. Some started early in the morning & others started at lunch, then mid-afternoon & later, yet they all received the same wage for their work. The evil one, Satan was there as well, injecting envy into the hearts of the ones who were hired first who began to grumble & complain, believing they were being treated unfairly. Like little kids who are punished with their siblings, yelling "That's not fair!" Envy & jealousy are not the healthiest of human emotions for our physical & spiritual well-being. Too many of us struggle with it & hold grudges as a result. It puts us into the proverbial "penalty box" when it comes to God too. At the end of our life, do we sometimes pat ourselves on the back, believing that we deserve to be part of the "Haves" & turn our backs to the "have-nots?" How will that play out with God in determining our final judgment? He said:" Thus, the last will be first, and the first will be last." I often wonder, will there be Seasons in Heaven or always a perfect 72 degrees? See you in church?

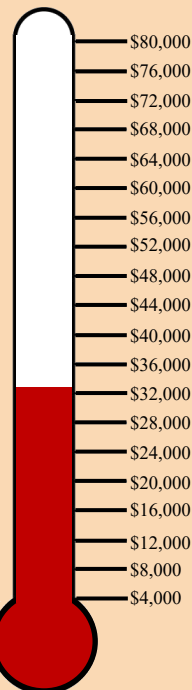
