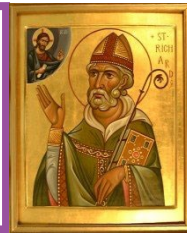

Dear Parishioners!

Today we mark the Second Sunday of Lent. The scriptures readings and Mass prayers of these early weeks of the season invite us to seriously respond to the call to conversion of heart that we have heard on Ash Wednesday and to continue in our efforts to enter into the season as best as we can. We are called to turn away from our sinfulness and to turn toward God. The traditional Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are held up before us as excellent ways of living the season. We have many spiritual opportunities available here at St. Bruno and St. Richard to go deeper in our personal faith in Jesus during the 40 days of Lent. Our parish bulletin gives a listing of those opportunities, and I strongly encourage all to take advantage of the spiritual practices. Since Lent involves alms giving, I encourage also your participation in the Rice Bowl collection to help hungry, especially the children. There are still some rice bowls at the exit of the church. Fill them with your spare change and return them on the last Sunday of Lent. Since all Fridays of Lent we must abstain from eating meat, I invite you for the Lenten Dinners. Every Friday has a different menu. You can take it to go or eat in the St. Richard church hall.

We still continue with the Archdiocese of Chicago Annual Catholic Appeal 2024. Most of you already completed pledge forms received from the Archdiocese in the mail. Thank you very much for your financial support and the gift of constant prayers in the intention of the Annual Catholic Appeal. I trust that just like in the past, we will meet our designated goal and perhaps go over. For parishioners and guests who did not get a chance to submit their commitment, extra pledge envelopes are available at the exit of the church. Please know, we need you not only in good times but also in the times of need. Do not remain anonymous in your faith, hope, love, trust, and sacrifice! Please, try to identify yourself with our small but beautiful and vibrant parish! Take courage!

Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie.

To już Druga Niedziela Wielkiego Postu. Dzisiejsza Ewangelia mówi nam o Przemienieniu Pana Jezusa na górze Tabor. Przyjmijmy to wydarzenie jak zaproszenie do przemiany naszego życia przez dobre przeżycie Wielkiego Postu. Kościół na różne sposoby pragnie nam pomóc, abyśmy ten szczególny czas przeżyli z jak największym pożytkiem dla naszego życia doczesnego i wiecznego. Czyni to zwłaszcza przez głoszenie słowa Bożego, sprawowanie sakramentu pokuty i organizowanie specjalnych nabożeństw, takich jak Droga Krzyżowa czy Gorzkie Żale. Jako że we wszystkie piątki Wielkiego Postu zobowiązani jesteśmy do powstrzymania się od jedzenia mięsa, dlatego zapraszam wszystkich do sali pod kościołem św. Ryszarda na postne posiłki (tak zwane *Lenten Dinner*). Co w ten piątek będzie można zjeść podane jest w innym miejscu tego biuletynu. W czasie Wielkiego Postu uczestniczymy też w akcji „Miska Ryżu”, której celem jest pomoc głodującym na świecie, a zwłaszcza dzieciom. Przy wyjściu z kościoła są wyłożone specjalne papierowe skarbonki, które wystarczy wypełnić drobnymi centami (mogą być i większe nominały) i przynieść do końca Wielkiego Postu.

I już na koniec przypominam, że jesteśmy w trakcie trwania Dorocznej Kwesty Katolickiej (*Annual Catholic Appeal 2024*). Wielu z Was złożyło już swoje finansowe zobowiązanie. Niech Bóg Wam za to wynagrodzi. Ufam, że podobnie jak w latach poprzednich tak i w tym roku, nie tylko osiągniemy wyznaczony cel, ale go przekroczymy. Pod warunkiem oczywiście, że wszyscy zaangażują się w tę akcję. Także ci, którzy choć nie są zapisani do naszej parafii, ale korzystają z naszej posługi duszpasterskiej. Nie bądźcie anonimowi w swojej wierze i ofiarności. Spróbujcie choć raz utożsamić się z naszą niedużą w prawdzie, ale jeszcze żywą parafią. Odwagi!

Your Deacon Daydreams

Lent is in full swing but occasionally I like to look in the rear view mirror like last Ash Wednesday. Literally thousands of people came to worship & receive ashes at both sites. It was a blessing to see them there. However, my prayer is that they will return sooner than Palm Sunday. It's up to us the faithful, to invite everyone back because it's all our jobs as the baptized to spread the love of God to others especially those we care about. Some people asked to take some ashes home for those who are infirmed. Don't forget to call the parish office if they are seeking a priest or Eucharistic minister to visit them as well.

But I have two questions for all us to ponder on in the meantime. 1. Does God test us? 2. Will we ever see the Transfigured Lord in all His glory? First of all, remember Christ is the Good Teacher & like a good teacher, He tests His students on occasion. We read about it in Genesis in many instances. He tested Adam & Eve's obedience in the Garden of Eden & they failed Him. But in today's 1st reading also from Genesis 22, "God put Abraham to the test. He called to him, "Abraham!" "Here I am!" he replied. Then God said : "Take your son Isaac, your only one, whom you love, & go to the land of Moriah. There you shall offer him up as a holocaust on a height that I will point out to you." Whoa! That's an unbelievable challenge! And more difficult than not eating from an apple tree! Yet, Abraham loved & trusted in the divine providence of the Lord & obeyed. God recognized that & spared Isaac And the Lord said : "because you acted as you did in not withholding from me your beloved son, I will bless you abundantly" And God kept His promise.

It makes me wonder how merciful God is, that He sent His only Son to die on the cross to redeem us because He loves us so much even though we are unworthy. Maybe you are being tested right now. Ask the Holy Spirit & your guardian angel to guide you. Life is a learning experience & very difficult at times, but faith is a gift freely given to us. We are all tested sometimes by God but also sometimes tempted by the devil. Don't try to do it alone, pray without ceasing. Say the morning offering & every action, thought & suffering will be a prayer. Try it!

Secondly, will we see God transfigured? I sure hope so. Psalm 116 gives me hope. "Precious in the eyes of the LORD is the death of his faithful ones.. I will walk before the Lord, in the land of the living." It's true that some of us will meet Him face-to-face sooner rather than later, so it's always so important to be prepared, because death comes like a thief in the night. We have been told that when we die, we will leave all our earthly possessions behind; but our good deeds go before us. So consider giving alms, especially this Lent to the poor & needy. Take home a Rice Bowl collection container. One of my buddies calls it his "cuss" box. When he blurts out a "bad" word, He plunks in some change. Others give up that expensive morning coffee & put in what they might spend in the box. Another parishioner is filling the food donation crates & another is volunteering. I am sure you have a whole list of ideas that you can do to make this the best Lent ever, so on that day when we meet Christ, we can respond, we believe that you are the Risen Lord, & we listened! See you in church & at the Stations of the Cross?

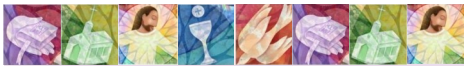

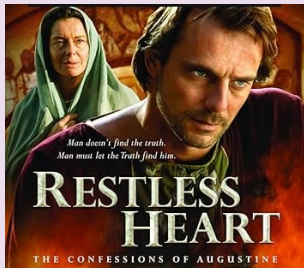

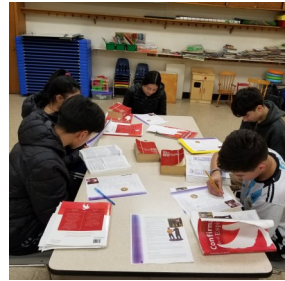
Movie club: Restless Heart
