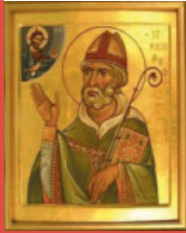

### *A few words from the Pastor*

Dear Parishioners!

We congratulate 41 young people from our School and Religious Formation Program who received the Sacrament of Confirmation this past month.

A month and a half ago, we were given the opportunity to participate in the 2025 Annual Catholic Appeal of the Archdiocese of Chicago. I am happy to report that first pledges have been tabulated and our parishioners have already reached and even slightly exceeded our goal. So far, we have received pledges of \$32,950 from 91 donors toward our goal of \$29,780. Thank you to all who have responded to the 2025 Annual Catholic Appeal thus far.

Today we observe the Fifth Sunday of Lent and our Lenten journey is almost over. Next weekend we celebrate Palm Sunday, the beginning of Holy Week, the most sacred week of our Catholic faith. Today also we celebrate the feast day of one of our patron saints - Saint Richard of Chichester, an English saint who took his title from the diocese of which he was bishop during the first half of the 13<sup>th</sup> century. His appointed feast day is April 3<sup>rd</sup>, but the Church says, that parishes can celebrate their patron Saint's feast on the Sunday closest to their feast. So, we are celebrating it today. His wisdom, and devotion to God continue to inspire us all. May we follow his example of patience, humility, and love in all that we do.

### *Słowo od ks. Proboszcza*

Drodzy Parafianie,

To już 5-a Niedziela Wielkiego Postu. Jeszcze tylko dwa tygodnie pozostały nam do Świąt Zmartwychwstania Pańskiego. Jednak nie dajmy się zwieść. To jeszcze nie koniec Wielkiego Postu. Za tydzień, w Niedzielę Palmową, rozpoczyna się Wielki Tydzień. Mam nadzieję, że nie zapomnicie o udziale w liturgii Wielkiego Tygodnia.

Półtora miesiąca temu, mieliśmy okazję uczestniczyć w Dorocznej Kweście Katolickiej. Po podliczeniu pierwszych zobowiązań okazało się, że cel wyznaczony nam przez Archidiecezję (\$29,718) został osiągnięty, a nawet trochę przekroczony (\$32,950). Bardzo dziękuję 91 Rodzinom, które tak ofiarnie odpowiedziały na apel Kardynała i wsparły dzieła prowadzone przez Archidiecezję. Czekamy na następnych.

A dziś jeszcze obchodzimy święto patronalne kościoła św. Ryszarda. Właściwie to jego wspomnienie przypada 3 kwietnia, ale przepisy liturgiczne zezwalają na to, aby odpust przenosić na najbliższą niedzielę. Dzięki temu większa ilość wiernych może bliżej poznać Patrona swego kościoła, a przez to uczyć się od niego jak należy naśladować Chrystusa w codziennym życiu. Patron kościoła czy parafii jest nie tylko wzorem do naśladowania, ale także pewnego rodzaju pośrednikiem między Bogiem i ludźmi. Niech więc wstawiennictwo św. Ryszarda wspiera nas w naszej życiowej wędrówce.

## Your Deacon Daydreams

You may or may not have noticed that during Lent we have something called Scrutiny Sundays. At some parishes but not all, where there are adults/teens who are preparing to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, & Confirmation on Holy Saturday, they will celebrate the Scrutinies. The Scrutiny Sundays are celebrated on the third, fourth, & fifth weeks of the Lenten season. This is considered a period of purification & enlightenment for the elect. There are prayers of exorcism which are intended to help purify the elect from sin & sinful desires. The overall prayers & laying on of hands are to help the elect be enlightened by the Word & the grace of God. The basic structure which takes place immediately following the homily includes: the elect (with sponsors) are invited forward. The priest will invite the parish to silently pray for the elect & also orally as Intercessions are recited. Then there may be a prayer of exorcism with the Laying on of hands on the elect with more prayers said before they are dismissed. The Gospels & readings during mass may be different than what is regularly scheduled for the usually Lenten schedule & they are in our regular missalette. Why am I teaching you this? Two reasons, we have candidates this year at our parish after some years of none & secondly, I am going to talk about the Scrutiny Gospel on the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday today.

Today we hear the Lazarus Story. Which Lazarus story is your favorite? Lazarus the beggar at the gate or Lazarus, the brother of Martha & Mary & Jesus' friend? Lazarus the beggar made it the Promised Land & was received into the bosom of Abraham. The other Lazarus who is in today's Scrutiny gospel, was Jesus' cherished friend, whom Jesus visited often, dined, socialized, played games with, preached & healed too. Sadly, on this occasion Jesus was away, on His mission when word came to Him that His friend has died. "When Jesus arrived, he found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days. And many of the Jews had come to Martha & Mary to comfort them about their brother. When Martha heard that Jesus was coming she went to meet him; but Mary sat at home. Martha said to Jesus, 'Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died. But even now I know that whatever you ask of God, He will give you whatever you ask.' Jesus said to her, 'Your brother will rise, he is only asleep.'" Jesus then called Lazarus by name, & he rose from the dead. Not like a comic book superhero, ripping open his cape either, Jesus did it with just a LOUD CALL. Our God is an Awesome God!

Long before Jesus walked on Earth, the prophet Ezekiel spoke these words in the Old Testament. "Thus says the Lord GOD: O my people, I will open your graves & have you rise from them." Have you noticed that when God promises, He keeps His promises not just to Lazarus & some, but ALL OF US! Good news for all us someday, Jesus is going to call us out of our tombs & we will live forever. We will be given a new body but our immortal soul stays the same. Thumbs up to heaven or thumbs down. That's between us & God's mercy. Don't reject His promise or wait until another day to reconcile. We don't know the time or the hour. Repent this Lent. See you in church?
