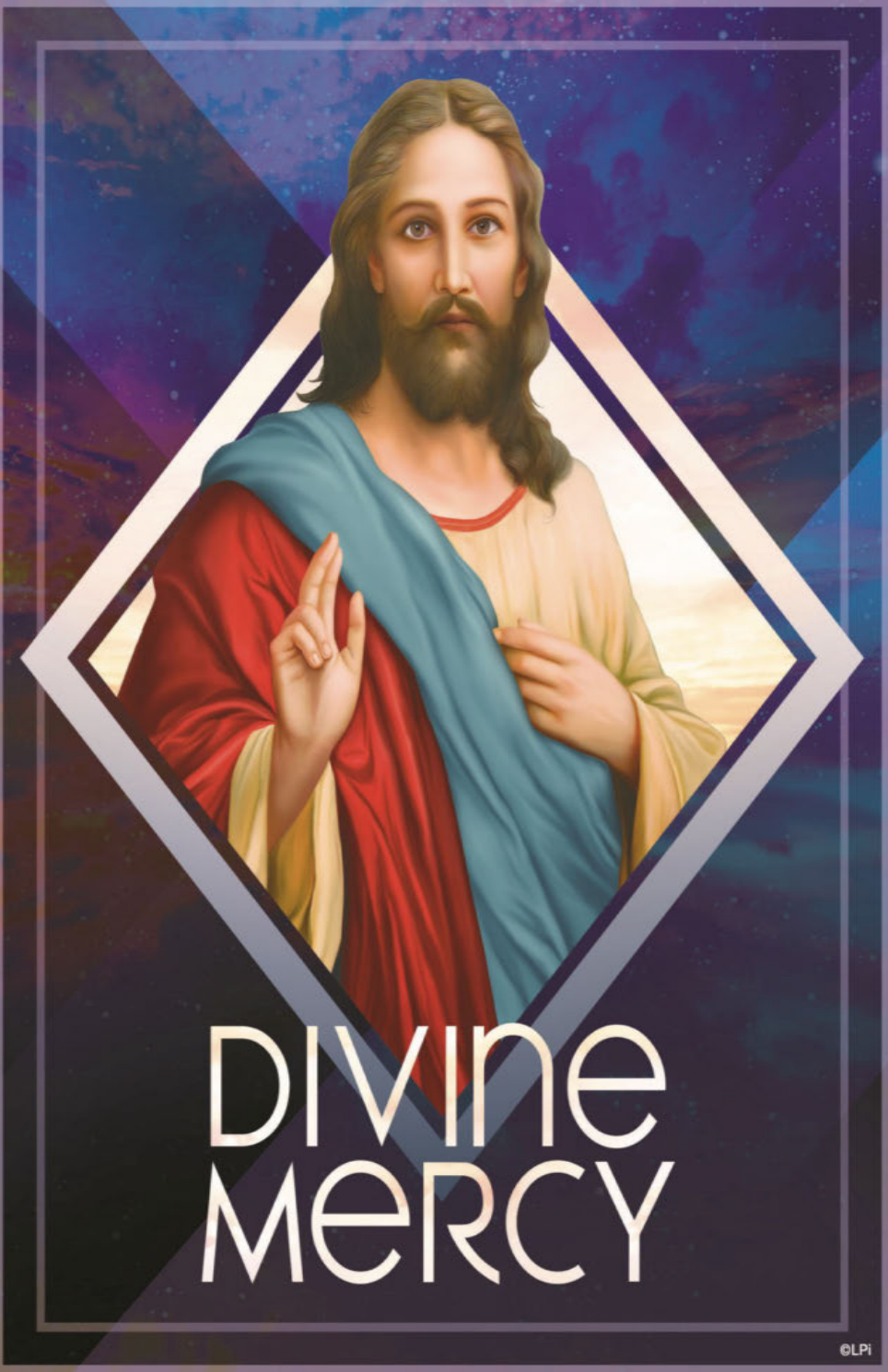

Dear Parishioners!

I hope you had a great and wonderful Easter and the unique experience of the Holy Week liturgy, which for all reasons is spiritually empowering and elevating. It was so good to see so many people crowding our two churches at different services. I would like to express my thanks and appreciation for all those who helped to make our Holy Week and Easter liturgies so beautiful and meaningful. From the music and liturgy to the floral decorations everything was well done. In fact, many parishioners and guests offered positive comments about their worship experience as they were leaving our churches. Thanks also to all who contributed for the Easter Gift and flowers. Thank you for all that you do.

Two months ago, we were given the opportunity to participate in the 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal of the Archdiocese of Chicago. I am happy to report that first pledges have been tabulated and our parishioners have already reached and even slightly exceeded our goal. So far, we have received pledges of \$30,223 from 74 donors toward our goal of \$29,718. Thank you to all who have responded to the 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal thus far.

We congratulate 63 young people from our School and Religious Education Program who received the Sacrament of Confirmation this past month. We have proudly printed their names in today's bulletin.

Today is the Second Sunday of Easter, also called Divine Mercy Sunday. This feast was established by Saint John Paul II who never stopped speaking about the mercy of Jesus. The message of Divine Mercy is simple: trust completely in the benevolent mercy of Jesus. Repent and ask for His mercy and it will be granted to you. Then pass it forward. Be merciful to others; forgive them as Jesus forgives you.

Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie!

Mam nadzieję, że mieliście udane i radosne święta Wielkanocne. Cieszę się, że tak wielu z Was wzięło udział w ceremoniach Triduum Paschalnego i Wielkanocy. Za tym wszystkim kryła się praca wielu ludzi, którzy z ogromnym poświęceniem pracowali, aby nasze dwa kościoły pięknie wyglądały, ceremonie wypadły godnie, a przez to chwała Boża się pomnożyła. „Bóg Zapłać!” im za to. Bardzo dziękuję też wszystkim, którzy złożyli ofiary na kościół i na kwiaty. Ufam, że Pan Jezus widział Wasz trud i poświęcenie i On sam najlepiej wam wynagrodzi.

2 miesiące temu, mieliśmy okazję uczestniczyć w Dorocznej Kwieście Katolickiej. Po podliczeniu pierwszych zobowiązań okazało się, że cel wyznaczony nam przez Archidiecezję (\$29,718) został osiągnięty, a nawet trochę przekroczony (\$30,223). W tych dniach otrzymałem list od ks. Kardynała Cupicha, w którym osobiście dziękuje Wam za to, że tak ofiarnie odpowiedzieliście na jego prośbę i wsparliście dzieła prowadzone przez Archidiecezję.

A dziś, w pierwszą niedzielę po Wielkanocy obchodzimy Niedzielę Miłosierdzia Bożego. Pan Jezus wybrał prostą, skromną, wiejską dziewczynę, Helenę Kowalską, znaną dziś jako święta Siostra Faustyna, aby za jej pośrednictwem przekazać całemu światu orędzie swojego wielkiego Miłosierdzia. W jednym ze swoich objawień, Pan Jezus nakazał Siostrze Faustynie, aby to widzenie utrwaliła na obrazie z podpisem „Jezu ufam Tobie”. Pan Jezus przekazał przez nią, że aby otrzymać łaski od Jego Miłosierdzia, należy być w stanie łaski uświęcającej, przystąpić do spowiedzi, przyjąć komunię św., uczcić obraz Bożego Miłosierdzia, samemu świadczyć uczynki miłosierdzia i mieć pełną ufność w Jego miłosierdziu. Jeśli ktoś był wcześniej do Spowiedzi i w międzyczasie nie popełnił grzechu ciężkiego, wystarczy, że wzbudzi tylko głęboki żal za grzechy powszednie. Pan Jezus pouczył także św. Faustynę jak odmawiać Koronkę do Bożego Miłosierdzia.

Niech Zmartwychwstały i Miłosierny Jezus obficie Wam wszystkim błogosławi!

Your Deacon Daydreams

I hope everyone had a blessed & enjoyable Holy Week & Easter Sunday. Easter is not over by any stretch. It lasts fifty days & we are just beginning the 2nd Sunday of Easter. My prayer is for the spirit of Easter to last until Ash Wednesday 2025! Everything is possible with God. God is good, all the time! Perhaps, you still can detect the incense lingering in church, or maybe the garlic & aromas from the blessing of the baskets on Holy Saturday too. Hopefully, you took home a bottle of Holy water last week; however if you haven't, it's never too late; just bring one from home. I still use my mom's seventy year old pink bleach plastic container to hold ours at home. Some people use theirs every day. We bless ourselves each time we enter & leave church, reminding us of our own baptism. During the Easter season, we renew our baptismal promises & once again we are sprinkled with Holy Water. Whenever we use Holy water in our homes, it is a sign that we are asking to be protected by the graces of this wonderful sacramental. It wards off the powers of evil that surround us all the time. Who doesn't need God's divine mercy & protection?!

Question? Are you a coupon clipper, or have a coupon app on your smartphone? In the old days, we could count on the Sunday newspapers to be filled with them. Would you like to have one of the "get out of jail free" cards in your wallet, when you are traffic stopped? Or hope to get the proverbial do-over, like in golf, that "mulligan" when your first shot wasn't the best? I know most of do, & God knows that as well, so He gave us His "Divine Mercy."

The Resurrection of Jesus was the most important event in the history of the world. When the Lord appeared in the 'Upper Room' to the apostles pointing out His wounds, it was to demonstrate He was the Crucified Christ, & to show He had resurrected from the dead. The final proof that He was God. He then bestowed on the apostles the power to forgive sins, which was in effect Divine Mercy coming into the world. In today's gospel of John 20 "Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them & said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, & whose sins you retain are retained." It was the beginning of the Church on earth.

In 1931, He appeared as the same image in another room, the cell of a young nun, St. Faustina, again showing His wounds, emphasizing the power of those wounds as rays from a font of reconciliation & renewal, rays of love & mercy. His victory on the Cross, His resurrection, coming into to a very sinful world once again. He asked her to teach the world again of why He died on the Cross to give sinners another chance of obtaining God's Divine Mercy, & pardon their sins if they returned to living by God's commandments. He was also reminding man that His death on the Cross, Divine Mercy was for all mankind (And there are other sheep I have that are not of this fold, these I have to lead as well. They too will hear My voice, & then there will be one flock & one Shepherd. John 10:11 – 18). In the beginning He said "I have not come to call the righteous, but to call sinners to repentance". (Luke 5:32) For the same reason, His message of Divine Mercy is a warning to mankind to exercise their conscience, come back to God & live by the Commandments. Peace & mercy begins with each one of us. How are you doing? See you in church?

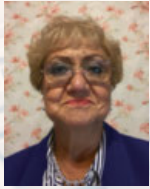
