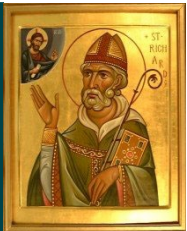

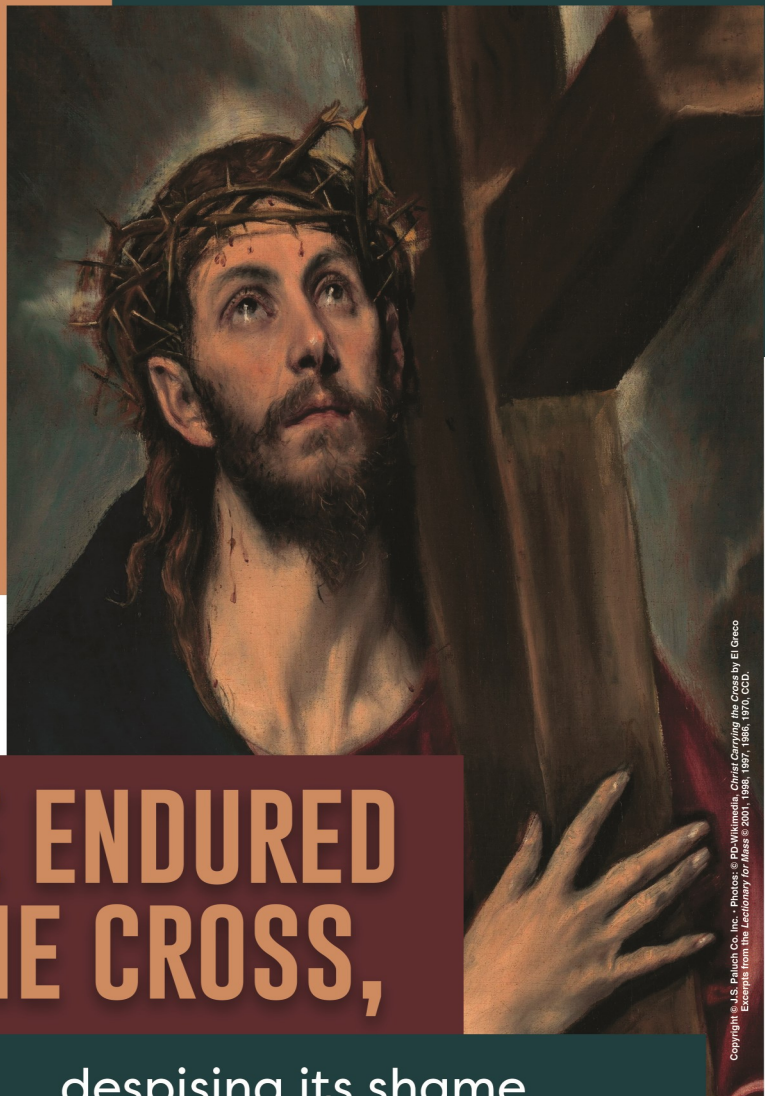

The Stained Glass Windows of St. Richard Church - #4

For this week we focus on window number four of the five west **Windows of Praise**. The imagery of this window comes from Verse 10 of **Psalm 148 (All Creation Summoned To Praise)** that calls on all beasts, animals and flying creatures to praise God and reads *“You animals wild and tame, you creatures that crawl and fly”*.



Then God said, “Let the water teem with an abundance of living creatures, and on the earth let birds fly beneath the dome of the sky. And so, it happened: God created the great sea monsters and all kinds of swimming creatures with which the water teems, and kinds of winged birds. God saw how good it was and God blessed them, saying, “Be fertile, multiply, and fill the water of the seas; and let the birds multiply on the earth... Let the earth bring all kinds of living creatures...”
GN 1:20-36

Upper Panel

Creation theme of praise continues with the Heavens, clouds and three birds of the sky.

Main Panel

Central figures (left) of a goose, hen, and five fish, depict land and sea creatures. At bottom, signifying the beasts of the planet, a lion spans both the left and right panels and segues to a scene of an ox, and a deer drinking water.

Flowing bands of water represented by different shades of light and pale blue glass, throughout the Main Panels signify the “River of Life”. This water of life theme will be repeated in other windows.

Due to vacations and days off, this bulletin article is being written substantially ahead of time to ensure making the printing due date. So we will not have an absolute count of the remaining number of Commemorative nameplates available for a donation of \$500. As of last week’s bulletin we had only 10 plates remaining. And considering that in these days the installation of any new stained glass in any church is a rarity, those of you still contemplating a donation might not want to delay to take advantage of such an exceptional life-time opportunity. Mission Cooperative Sunday (August 13/14)

The Society of African Missions, a.k.a. SMA Fathers, is a missionary congregation founded in 1856 in France by Bishop Melchior de Marion Brésillac. It has over 900 priests from all over the world, among which a good number coming from the United States. Its main mission is to work with the people of Africa and the people of African origin. The congregation went initially along the coast of west Africa and Egypt. Now the SMA missionaries are in 17 countries throughout the continent of Africa. Missionaries from the Americas, Europe, Africa, and Asia respond to the Call of Jesus "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all Nations."



The SMA missionaries today are still engaged in primary evangelization, i.e., they go to places where the Word of God has not reached yet, as in some areas in Africa where there are no roads and basic needs like water, food, and education are lacking. Jesus not only proclaimed the Good News of God's Kingdom, He also fed the hungry. Aside from bringing people the Good News, the missionaries in these areas provide basic amenities like water, education, and health as well, especially to war-torn countries, like the Central African Republic, Democratic Republic of Congo, Liberia, Sierra Leone, where SMA missionaries are working to alleviate the suffering of many.

As a missionary society, peace and justice is a priority too. Thus, the SMA missionaries also work with refugees in areas of conflicts, like in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. They educate people to aim for peace, justice, and reconciliation.



Aside from Christianity, there are many different religions in Africa. As part of living together, interreligious dialogue is crucial. In Nigeria, for example, the SMA missionaries are actively engaged in interreligious dialogue with the Muslims, African traditional religious groups, as well as with Christians of other denominations.

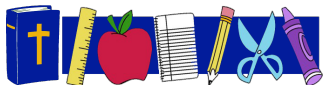
Virtus Training Available at St. Richard

YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS



With all the family barbecues going on during these warm summer months, I really miss the old-fashioned charcoal grills. Walking by anyone's yard, you could witness the big flare-ups as the man-of-the-grill would toss in a match leaping backwards as the flames reached for the sky. The bigger the fire, the more excited the cook appeared to like it.

In today's gospel from Luke, "Jesus said to his disciples, "I have come to set the earth on fire, & how I wish it were already blazing!" And the fire Jesus is referring too, is in the next lines" "There is a baptism with which I must be baptized, & how great is my anguish until it is accomplished! You think that I have come to establish peace on the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division." He is talking about the flame of faith which is given to us at each & every baptism. We are baptized by water & the Holy Spirit. A candle is passed to us by our godparents lit from the Paschal candle which is the light of Christ. It can only be dimmed by us when we commit sin. But the burning embers can remain there just waiting to be stoked again into a burning flame. The more we get to know Jesus Christ, the brighter the fire will be.

Do we have the knowledge to pass our faith along to others? Our children need that knowledge so don't wait to enroll them in our Catholic school or the religious education program. If you want to help keep the flame alive, consider volunteering as a catechist too. You can talk to me & I will connect you to the proper people in charge. Or you can contact the parish rectory or school. There is surely a covid pandemic in our world today, but an even bigger one exists in our spiritual life across the nation & world. People just either have forgotten what they learned as kids, or have not nurtured their faith, or have even gotten lazy or have bought into the secular culture of moral relativism. Jesus is longing to be part of your life to relight the flame of faith.

I always get uncomfortable with this gospel, when it divides father against son, mother against daughter etc. But it is happening. So many grandparents are worried about their grandkids who have not been baptized. Parents struggling to get their teens to go to church. Fr. Andrew posted that at both parish sites, only 4 weddings took place last year because people aren't getting married but are living together instead. That divides them from being able to be in communion with the church as well. Well our parish family suffers when your family suffers. Jesus & His Mother Mary long to have you near. I really believe that is why there is so much crises nowadays. We were created to have a relationship with Jesus, & to set our hearts ablaze. So ask yourself, do you have a friend in Jesus? If not, Jesus still loves you. Think about it. See you in church?

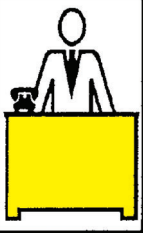
