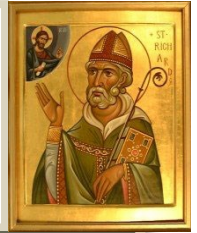

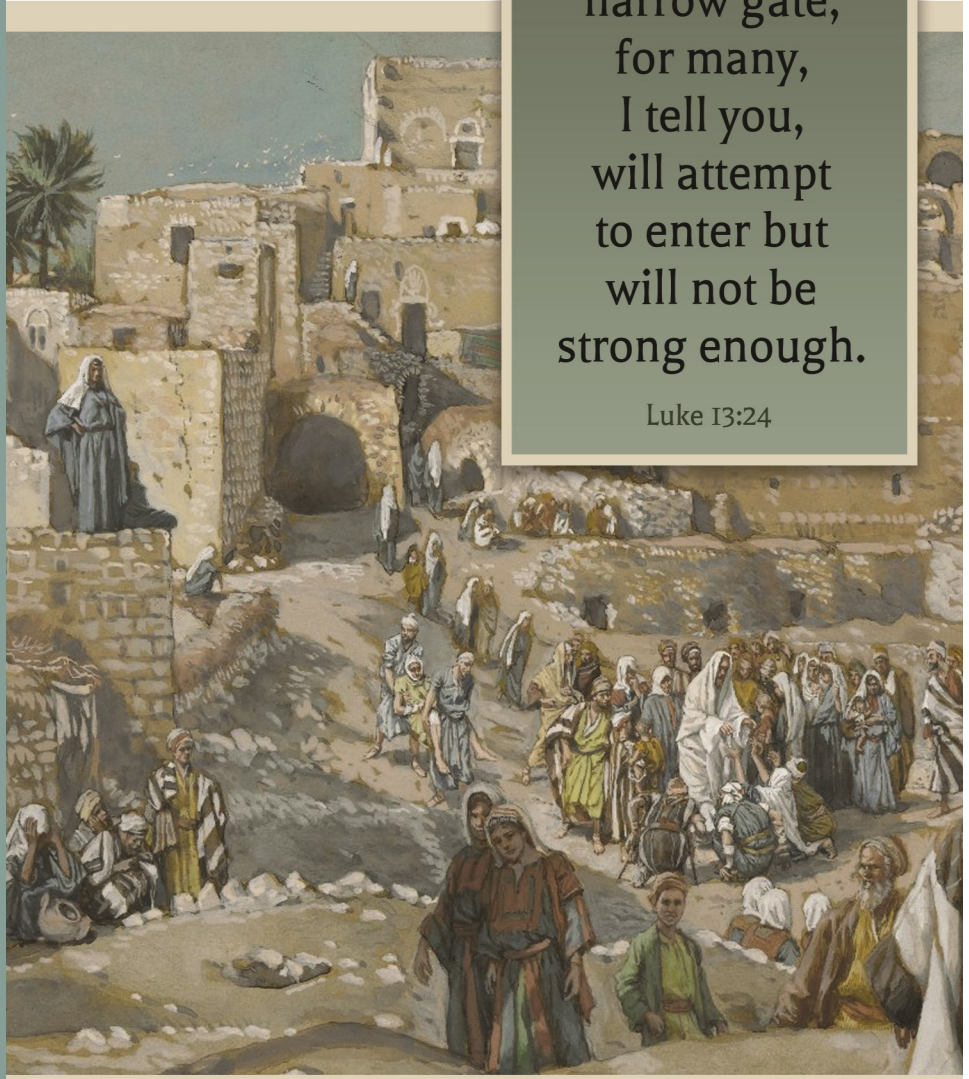

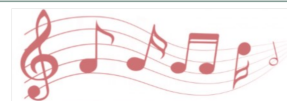

The Stained Glass Windows of St. Richard Church - #5

Window #5, the last of five west wall **Windows of Praise**, is our focus for this week. Inspiration for this window comes from verses 11 – 12 & 13 of **Psalm 148 (All Creation Summoned to Praise)** which calls for praise to come from **Verse 11 - You kings of the earth and all peoples, Princes and all who govern on earth. 12. Young men and women too, old and young alike. 13. Let them all praise the Lord's name, for His name alone is exalted, majestic above earth and heaven.**



Upper Panel

Two angels blowing Hebrew ram type horns known as a "Shofar" that are today still in use in various Jewish ceremonies, and the Greek letters for Alpha and Omega.

The Coming of Christ: The Alpha and the Omega. Jesus is the beginning and the end. He is the Alpha and Omega. Angels are blowing trumpets to glorify and praise the coming of Christ, our Almighty God. The saints and Apostles of Jesus are enthroned around Him. "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End." "I am The Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright Morning Star."

Main Panel

Apostles and Saints, each have their arms outstretched, singing hymns of praise around the throne of God while two angels each play a lyre, a small U-shaped harp. We also see the Lamb of God, symbol of Jesus, in the middle left. Then in the lower right section, a green branching plant having seven chevron style forms, six right and one left, each representing a Columbine flower bloom, symbols of the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit. In the left transom panel a square identifies Ralph Smith as the window artist/designer, and Jaeger Studios as the hand-crafters.

The Stained Glass Committee is happy to report the receipt of another \$500 donation for one of the 10 remaining Commemorative nameplates; so this brings us to only nine now available. The plates will be 1" high x 4" wide and will be placed into a special memorial wall to be mounted on the east wall in the main church lobby. For esthetics the Stained Glass memorial will look very similar to the overall church memorial wall located on the west side of the main church lobby. Once again, this is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to remember a loved one, an entire family, friends, etc. Please call our office at 773-585-1221 and request that a Committee member contact you for any questions.

Our Committee unfortunately does have one bit of disappointing news to report, in that the company working on the memorial wall has suffered the loss of two employees – one quit, and the other unexpectedly passed away. Since they are a small business operation, meeting our celebratory date will not be possible. However, Fr. Andrew and our team did not want to postpone the Mass again, so we're working on a temporary poster board memorial to acknowledge the wishes of all of our donors. Once the final wall is received - anticipated to now be late October - people will be notified and free to view the wall at their leisure.

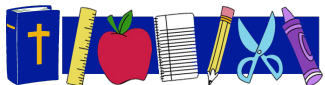
Virtus Training Available at St. Richard

YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS



I don't know about you, but I hate to paint. However, it's a necessity if you own your own home. Either I can hire a professional or do-it-myself. It depends on how much discipline I have, because the process needs to be meticulous otherwise I can slop everything up. If you stop to think about it, anything we want to accomplish in life requires discipline. In fact, "discipline" is the key point in our 2nd reading from Hebrews this weekend: "Endure your trials as discipline...all discipline seems a cause not for joy but for pain, yet later it brings the peaceful fruits of righteousness." The root word of discipline is "disciple." Isn't that what Jesus has asked us to be, his disciples?! Jesus reminds us in the gospel of Luke "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many I tell you, will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough." This is powerful. We all want to go to heaven but it takes "discipline" in following Jesus by picking up our cross. For if we don't "Follow the way, the truth & the light" which is Jesus...as the gospel continues, "there will be wailing & grinding of teeth." At our final judgment, there will be no do-overs available. We only have it while we still have breath. Don't waste a moment!

Once again, it's that time of year when the school bells are ringing & children (maybe it's parents) are singing especially since so many were doing it remotely at home due to the pandemic. However, friends of ours are posting on facebook that they are moving their sons & daughters into college dorms. Something my wife struggled with as she wept all the way home afterward. If you are student, I can't say enough about the power of prayer being a big help in adjusting to this next chapter. And parents, starting the day with morning prayer is one of those "core" practices that's great to make a habit with your kids. Praying with them immediately before school & specifically for the school day is another. When you pray for God's blessing for their school day, you're equipping them with something far more important than a #2 pencil or a textbook! If you're the sort of family that is rushing around most mornings, be sure to make your prayer-before-school habit simple, so it can be done on the fly. Keep it simple by blessing one another as you go out the door, or offer a simple one-line prayer: "May God bless you & keep you, all the day long." Alternatively, simply say a one-line prayer with your hand on their heads: "Lord, bless these kids at school today; send your angels to keep them safe, & give them the grace to do their best in their work & being a witness to your love for all people. Amen, It works for college aged kids too! We did it.

If you are a graduate of the "school of hard knocks," pray to the Holy Spirit for the grace to know how to make this world a better place. See you in church?
