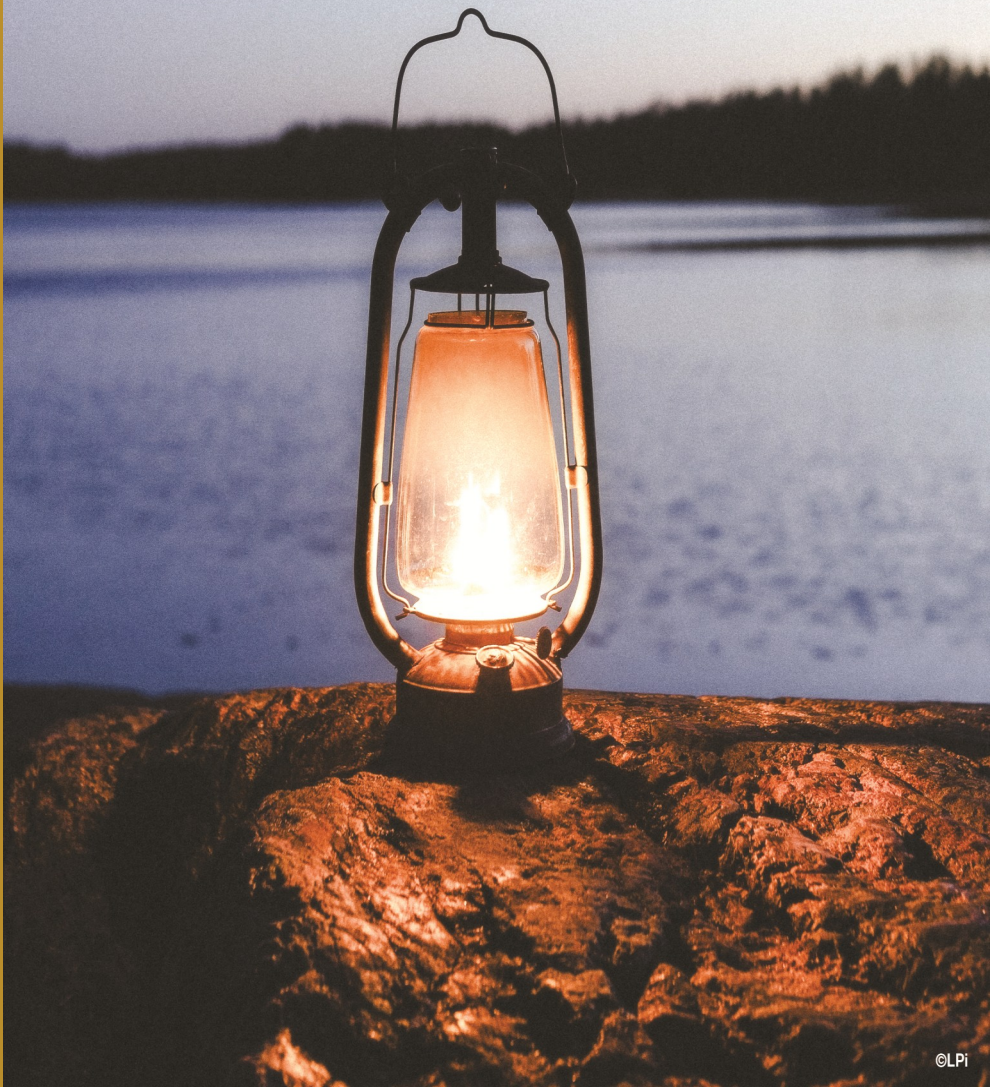

## *A few words from the Pastor*

Dear Parishioners!

This Wednesday, February 11<sup>th</sup>, is the World Day of the Sick. This day coincides with the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. We recall that it was at Lourdes, France, in 1858, when the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to Bernadette Soubirous and told Bernadette in her local French dialect that she, the Virgin Mary, was the Immaculate Conception. Eventually a church was built and pilgrims made their way to the holy site of the apparitions. Over the decades hundreds of visitors have been healed physically and thousands have been renewed spiritually. In commemoration of the World Day of the Sick, our Parish will offer the communal Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. All who are ill, in fragile health, or suffering from infirmity of age are welcome to celebrate and receive this sacrament. Complete schedule of all services in different languages can be found elsewhere in this bulletin.

Next weekend is Commitment Weekend for the Annual Catholic Appeal. As always, each parish is asked to participate in this Annual Appeal which helps generate funds for the Archdiocese and all the services it provides. If you received your pledge form in the mail, please complete it and mail it back to Archdiocese, or bring it to Mass next weekend. For those of you that did not receive a mailing from the Archdiocese, we have prepared additional brochures and envelopes, which can be found at the exit of the church. It is important to mark on the envelope that you are a Sts. Bruno & Richard parishioner so that our parish gets credit for your donation. Last year our parish goal was set \$29,780 (7% of normal operating income). All together we collected \$40,945 and Archdiocese paid us back \$11,165. Thank you to everyone who participated in the 2025 Appeal. Hopefully we can do our part this year to meet our goal (\$29,361) and help the larger Archdiocese meet our collective goal. Thank you in advance for your generosity.

## *Słowo od ks. Proboszcza*

Drodzy Parafianie.

W środę, 11 lutego, przypada wspomnienie Matki Bożej z Lourdes i Światowy Dzień Chorych. Ma on pobudzić naszą wrażliwość i zachęcić do modlitwy i aktywnej pomocy na rzecz osób chorych. Z okazji Dnia Chorego, w tym tygodniu będzie można przystąpić do wspólnotowego Sakramentu Namaszczenia Chorych. Zapraszam wszystkich chorych, o wątłym zdrowiu lub posuniętych w latach do skorzystania z tej okazji.

Już za tydzień, odbędzie się doroczna Kwesta Katolicka (Annual Catholic Appeal). Jesteśmy odpowiedzialni nie tylko za naszą parafię, ale za cały Kościół. Stanowimy wspólnotę ludzi wierzących, dlatego też apel o przeprowadzenie Kwesty kierowany jest do wszystkich katolików w Archidiecezji Chicago. Często chcielibyśmy pomóc innym, ale w pojedynkę nie jesteśmy w stanie zrobić tyle, ile możemy uczynić razem jako wspólnota Kościoła. Właśnie biorąc udział w Kweście Katolickiej możemy wnieść znaczący wkład w zaspokojenie wielu potrzeb o zasięgu tak lokalnym jaki i powszechnym. Im więcej ludzi odpowie na Apel, tym więcej rzeczy będzie można dokonać. W ubiegłym roku 118 Rodzin z naszej parafii ofiarowało razem \$40,945. Ponieważ cel jaki wyznaczyła nam Archidiecezja (\$29,780) został przekroczony, dlatego tę różnicę (\$11,165) otrzymaliśmy z powrotem. Ponieważ w tym roku Archidiecezja wyznaczyła nam podobną sumę do zebrania (\$29,361), dlatego mam nadzieję, że i tym razem damy radę. Wielu z was otrzymało list z Archidiecezji w tej sprawie. Jeśli ktoś w tej akcji jeszcze nie brał udziału, to przy wyjściu z kościoła wyłożone są specjalne broszury i koperty z kartą zobowiązań. Nasze deklaracje i ofiary złożymy w kościele w przyszłą niedzielę, ale można je wysyłać też bezpośrednio do Archidiecezji. Z góry dziękuję za Wasze ofiary

Este miércoles 11 de febrero es el Día Mundial del Enfermo. Este día coincide con la fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes. Recordamos que fue en Lourdes, Francia, en 1858, cuando la Santísima Virgen María se apareció a Bernadette Soubirous y le dijo, en su dialecto francés local, que ella, la Virgen María, era la Inmaculada Concepción. Posteriormente se construyó una iglesia y los peregrinos acudieron al lugar santo de las apariciones. A lo largo de las décadas, cientos de visitantes han sido sanados físicamente y miles han experimentado una renovación espiritual. En conmemoración del Día Mundial del Enfermo, nuestra parroquia ofrecerá el Sacramento comunitario de la Unción de los Enfermos. Todas las personas enfermas, con salud frágil o que padecen alguna dolencia propia de la edad, están invitadas a participar y recibir este sacramento. El horario completo de todos los servicios en diferentes idiomas se encuentra en este boletín.

El próximo domingo comenzamos la Campaña Católica Anual 2026. Como siempre, se pide a cada parroquia que participe en esta campaña anual, que ayuda a generar fondos para la Arquidiócesis y todos los servicios que brinda. Si recibió su formulario de compromiso por correo, por favor, complételo y envíelo por correo a la Arquidiócesis o tráigalo a Misa el próximo domingo. Para quienes no recibieron el envío de la Arquidiócesis, hemos preparado folletos y sobres adicionales, que se encuentran a la salida de la iglesia. Es importante que indique en el sobre que es feligrés de la parroquia de San Bruno y San Ricardo para que nuestra parroquia reciba el crédito por su donación. Welcome to February, which thankfully means springtime is coming as well as Ash Wednesday the start of Lent on Feb. 18<sup>th</sup>. However, don't forget about St Valentine's Day & Fat Tuesday/ Mardi Gras. Deacon Ed asked me how much do we think a dozen paczki is going to cost this year? What about a tasty box of chocolates or a bouquet of flowers for our sweethearts? The least expensive may be to make them homemade?? Nah. As for deciding what to do or give up for Lent, whatever happened to your New Year's resolutions? Gratefully, Lent is a chance for a do-over. It's also the perfect opportunity to reconcile with the Lord. Are you thinking about it yet? There's no time to waste. It will be here soon.

February in the church is dedicated to the Holy family. Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Feast of the Presentation of the child Jesus in the temple aka Candlemas; set the time when parents bring their child to dedicate him to God as well as their whole family. The Holy Family's life was not free from hardship, poverty, exile & uncertainty. Yet they remained steadfast in faith & love. In February, we are reminded that holiness begins at home, in the ordinary moments of daily life, when we choose love over selfishness, prayer over distraction & trust over fear. The Holy Family sets the example for all families to follow.

In all of our readings this 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary time, Jesus is teaching about being salt & light to the world. Psalm 112 "The just man is a light in darkness to the upright." John: "I am the light of the world, says the Lord; whoever follows me will have the light of life." Matthew: "Jesus said to his disciples: "You are the salt of the earth. But if salt loses its taste, with what can it be seasoned? It is no longer good for anything."

Salt was the preservative in ancient times & still used in modern times. But for those of us who are ordered by our docs to watch how much sodium we consume, it's not so easy to find tasty recipes. No living creature can live without salt. Farmers & ranchers even zoos provide salt licks for their animals. Icy roads & sidewalks are treated with salt for us to travel safely too. How would our movie popcorn taste without a shake or two? It is vital as necessary as light is to the world.

That's why Jesus calls us to be salt for the earth. When Jesus says that we are to be the salt of the earth, he means that we have the task here on earth to preserve & give flavor. We are to preserve the life of God's grace that Jesus has brought to the world. We are to give flavor to people's lives. Just as salt enhances the quality of food, we as salt can enhance the quality of others' lives. Life becomes tasty and full of flavor when it contains the salt of Jesus, Through Jesus' word, through his loving kindness & benevolence & through his mercy & forgiveness, we can add flavor to the lives of the people. Jesus needs disciples who will live out his Gospel values & bring these values to others pf his kindness, love & compassion. Jesus says that if salt loses its taste, "it is no longer good for anything but to be thrown out & trampled underfoot."

In a world mired in a lot of darkness, hurt, & pain, being also light might see like an impossible task. However, we must remember that we can be a light in the world only through Jesus, who is the true light & who instructed his disciples to go to all nations to bring his light to them. "A light for all to see." Is your light bright enough or is it only a shadow? See you in church?

**Why is an initial payment requested? Is it required?**

While not required, many donors are eager to begin fulfilling their pledges. In addition, an initial payment is a strong indication of a donor's commitment to completing a campaign pledge. Initial payment checks should be made payable to: Generation to Generation campaign.

**How should payments be made to fulfill a pledge?**

After the initial collection of pledge forms at the parish level, the Archdiocese will administer the pledge follow-up process. Donors will be given the option of making payments annually, quarterly or monthly for up to 5 years by check, credit/debit card, automated debit to checking account and securities. Checks should be made payable to: Generation to Generation campaign.

**Dlaczego wymagana jest wpłata początkowa? Czy jest ona obowiązkowa?**

Chociaż nie jest to obowiązkowe, wielu darczyńców chętnie zaczyna od niej realizację swoich zobowiązań. Ponadto, wpłata początkowa jest silnym wskaźnikiem zaangażowania darczyńcy w wypełnienie złożonej deklaracji w ramach kampanii. Czeki z wpłatą początkową należy wystawiać na „Generation to Generation campaign”.

**Jak należy dokonywać wpłat w celu wypełnienia zobowiązania?**

Po wstępnym zebraniu w parafii kart zobowiązań, Archidiecezja będzie zarządzać procesem realizacji zobowiązań. Darczyńcy będą mieli możliwość dokonywania wpłat rocznie, kwartalnie lub miesięcznie przez okres do 5 lat, za pomocą czeku, karty kredytowej/debetowej, lub automatycznego obciążenia konta bankowego. Czeki należy wystawiać na „Generation to Generation campaign”.

**¿Por qué se solicita un pago inicial? ¿Es obligatorio?**

Si bien no es obligatorio, muchos donantes están ansiosos por comenzar a cumplir sus promesas. Además, un pago inicial es un fuerte indicio del compromiso de un donante a cumplir una promesa a la campaña. Los cheques del pago inicial deben hacerse a nombre de: Generation to Generation.

**¿Como se deben realizar los pagos para cumplir un compromiso?**

Después de la recolección inicial de los formularios de compromiso a nivel parroquial, la arquidiócesis administrara el proceso de seguimiento del compromiso. A los donantes se les dará la opción de realizar los pagos anuales, trimestral, o mensualmente hasta por cinco años mediante cheque, tarjeta de crédito/debito, debito automático a una cuenta corriente y valores. Los cheques deben hacerse a nombre de: Generation to Generation.

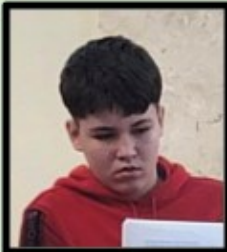
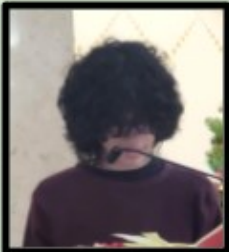

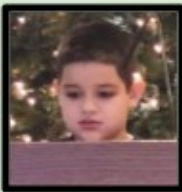

## Living in Joy: Highlights from Our Wonderful Catholic Schools Week

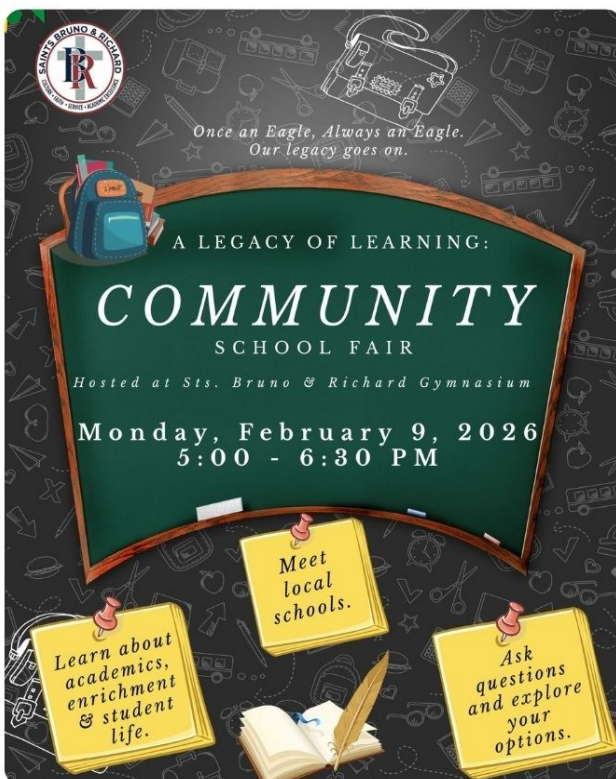
Catholic Schools Week was a beautiful reminder of the faith, service, and community that define our school. We are deeply grateful to everyone who helped make the week so meaningful.
