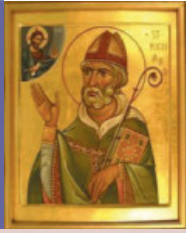

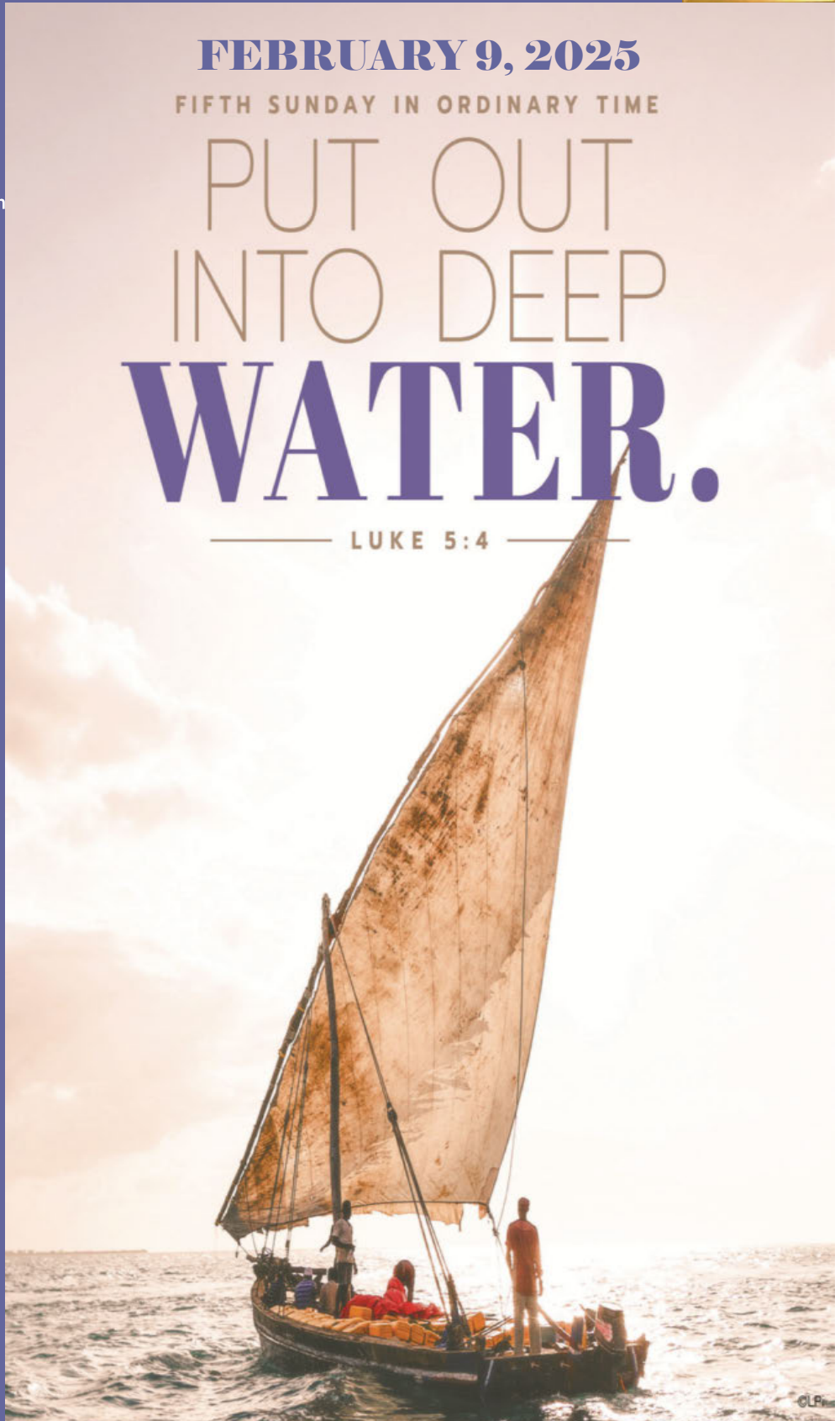

A few words from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners!

This Tuesday, February 11th, is the World Day of the Sick. This day coincides with the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. We recall that it was at Lourdes, France, in 1858, when the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to Bernadette Soubirous and told Bernadette in her local French dialect that she, the Virgin Mary, was the Immaculate Conception. Eventually a church was built and pilgrims made their way to the holy site of the apparitions. Over the decades hundreds of visitors have been healed physically and thousands have been renewed spiritually. In commemoration of the World Day of the Sick, our Parish will offer the communal Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. All who are ill, in fragile health, or suffering from infirmity of age are welcome to celebrate and receive this sacrament. Complete schedule of all services in different languages can be found elsewhere in this bulletin.

This Friday, February 14th, we celebrate the feast day of St. Cyril and his brother Methodius. But more commonly we associate February 14th with the feast of St. Valentine, a Roman priest who was martyred by Emperor Claudius II "for supporting couples wishing to get married." Valentine's Day is traditionally a time when people seek to demonstrate in a tangible way their love and affection to those who are dear to them, particularly sweethearts, spouses, etc... It is done by giving special roses, cards, other appropriate gifts, or by simply being "extra nice" on one way or another. Love however must be viewed as an ongoing involvement. It is a commitment "to have and to hold...and to cherish till death," especially for those who are married. May the love that is associated with St. Valentine come into your hearts this week in a special way!

Namaszczenie chorych nie jest tylko dla tych, którzy znajdują się w ostatecznym niebezpieczeństwie utraty życia, ale dla wszystkich chorych.

No i nie zapomnijcie, że w piątek jest Valentine's Day. Życzę Wam, aby miłość jaka jest treścią tego dnia zagościła również i w Waszych sercach.

Este martes 11 de febrero es la Jornada Mundial del Enfermo. Este día coincide con la Fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes. En el año 1858 en Lourdes, Francia, la Virgen María se le apareció a Bernadette Soubirous varias veces y le dijo que ella era la Inmaculada Concepción. La Virgen María le encargó a Bernadette que se construyera una capilla. Ahora el Santuario de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes es visitado todo el año por peregrinos. A lo largo de las décadas, cientos de visitantes se han curado físicamente y miles se han renovado espiritualmente. En conmemoración de la jornada mundial del enfermo, nuestra parroquia ofrecerá el sacramento comunitario de la Unción de los Enfermos. Todos los que están enfermos, con una salud frágil o personas de edad avanzada, están invitados a celebrar y recibir este sacramento. El horario completo de todos los servicios en diferentes idiomas se puede encontrar en este boletín.

Este viernes 14 de febrero celebramos la fiesta de San Cirilo y su hermano San Metodio. Pero más comúnmente asociamos el 14 de febrero con la fiesta de San Valentín, un sacerdote romano que fue martirizado por el emperador Claudio II "por apoyar a las parejas que deseaban casarse". El día de San Valentín es tradicionalmente un momento en que las personas buscamos demostrar de manera tangible su amor y afecto por aquellos que son queridos, particularmente novios, esposos, etc. Lo hacen regalando rosas, tarjetas, otros regalos apropiados o simplemente siendo "extra amables" de una manera u otra. Sin embargo, el amor debe verse como una participación continua. Especialmente para las parejas que declararon su compromiso con los votos matrimoniales. ¡Que el amor que se asocia con San Valentín llegue a sus corazones esta semana de una manera especial!

Your Deacon Daydreams

Today, on the 5th Sunday of Ordinary Time, we hear Jesus challenging the apostles to do something that they wouldn't ordinarily try. Usually if we listen intently to the gospel, we are challenged also. Maybe it's to do something to help ourselves or make the world a better place. Most of all, we are asked if we are keeping our feet firmly planted on the road to salvation? In today's good news from Luke, Jesus saw the apostles struggling to catch fish. Jesus said to Simon: "Put out into deep water & lower your nets for a catch." Simon said in reply, "Master, we have worked hard all night & have caught nothing, but at your command I will lower the nets." When they had done this, they caught a great number of fish & their nets were tearing.

I have to admit, I am not a fisherman, but my bro-in-law in NW Wisc. is, so I gave him a call for a bit of research. He told me that smart fishermen will take advantage of "fish finders" aka electronic devices that will send off signals when aimed in the lake. It helps locate where the fish are while giving the depth of the water too. That's where he will drop his baited line to get the fastest & best results. Surely, 2000 yrs. ago this was not heard of but they had something even better, Jesus.

Sometimes, we might keep trying to do something but without success. No matter how hard we try we just can't get the job done. We are ready to give up but something nudges us to do it one more time, figure whatever happens, happens, & we succeed. Perhaps we have been trying too hard to do it by ourselves & to do it our way. We try to use what God has given us to accomplish good but when we fail, we feel like we aren't good enough. When Simon realizes Jesus comes from God, he fell at the knees of Jesus & asked him to depart, believing he was not worthy to be with Jesus. In the 2nd reading, Paul realizes that, because of his past persecution of the Jews, he is not fit to be called an apostle. He realizes that it by God's grace that he has become an apostle. And in the 1st reading, Isaiah feels unclean & unworthy. Alone he would be unworthy but God sends forth a seraphim who touches the ember from the altar to Isaiah's lip & his sin is purged. Isaiah then cries out "Here I am Lord!"

What task have we felt called to? What task have we fallen short of completing? When we reach the point of giving up, we let go of our way & in doing so, open ourselves to God. Sometimes God asks big things & sometimes it's simple things. Sometimes God just wants us to stand up for what is good or take your spouse's advice to pray on it before you give up. Can you imagine what life would be like if the greatest inventors gave up too early either. From time to time we are presented with failure, which raises questions about ourselves & questions about God. If God is so good, we are asked, why is there such terrible suffering in our world? Why did God allow the Holocaust? Or ISIS to exist? Why does God allow babies to die? And then we are told: "I can't imagine a God that would allow evil & pain to afflict innocent people." But why, we need to ask, should God be limited by our puny little human imaginations & standards? The problem is with us, not with God. Life does not depend only upon you or me. And you may think that you are a failure & will never make a difference in the world. The only way to face life is with the belief that "with God all things are possible," & then live our lives while faithfully asking Him to aid us. Happy Valentine's Day to all. Show your love by reaching out to someone in need. You will be happier for it. See you in church?
