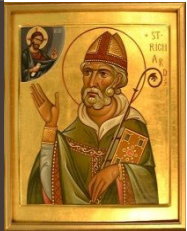

The Christmas Season has officially ended and we are now in Ordinary Time lasting until February 18th, Ash Wednesday. Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie.

Chociaż śpiewamy jeszcze kolędy, to oficjalnie zakończył się już okres Bożego Narodzenia i rozpoczął się tak zwany Okres Zwykły roku kościelnego, który potrwa do 18 lutego, czyli do Środy Popielcowej. Okres Zwykły nie oznacza, że nic niezwykłego w tym czasie się nie wydarzy. Może Bóg będzie chciał wkroczyć w nasze życie już nie tak uroczyście i świątecznie, ale właśnie prosto i zwyczajnie.

Dziś, niedzielę 18 stycznia, rozpoczyna się Tydzień Modlitw o Jedność Chrześcijan. Wielu myśli, że zbudowanie jedności między wyznawcami Chrystusa jest bardzo łatwe, że wystarczy się pomodlić w tej intencji i problem będzie rozwiązany. Gdyby to było takie proste, to już dawno byłaby „jedna owczarnia i jeden pasterz.” Obyśmy w rozpoczętym właśnie 2026 roku zrobili konkretny krok na drodze do jedności. Warto może zacząć od własnej Rodziny i własnej parafii.

A jutro, w poniedziałek 19 stycznia, będzie obchodzone w Stanach Zjednoczonych święto państwowe: Martin Luther King Day. Podobnie jak wszystkie urzędy, szkoły i banki tak i nasze biuro parafialne będzie tego dnia zamknięte.

Już niedługo rozpocznie się Doroczny Apel Katolicki (tzw. Annual Catholic Appeal). Wielu z was otrzymało już list od ks. kardynała Cupicha z prośbą o podjęcie finansowego zobowiązania na rzecz dzieł prowadzonych przez Archidiecezję. Można na ten Apel odpowiedzieć już teraz, albo poczekać z tym do 15 lutego, kiedy uczynimy to razem w kościele. Oprócz corocznej zbiórki na rzecz Apelu Katolickiego, w tym roku nasza parafia weźmie udział w jeszcze jednej akcji zatytułowanej „Generation to Generation Campaign.”. Więcej informacji wkrótce.

La temporada navideña ha terminado oficialmente y ahora nos encontramos en el Tiempo Ordinario, que continua hasta el 18 de febrero, Miércoles de Ceniza. El fin de las fiestas y el comienzo del Tiempo Ordinario no significa que dejen de ocurrir cosas importantes en nuestras vidas. Your Deacon Daydreams

"Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will." Psalm 40 from today's readings. Whenever I am preparing my bulletin article, I read & re-read the selections several times over for each Sunday. Then I stew on them to see what message God is sending me. The words that stick out in all of them are "to do your will, LORD." Doing God's will is our marching orders for sure as soldiers of Christ. It starts with our Baptism, fulfilled further in all the other sacraments leading up to our final judgment. But the greater question, what is God's will for me? How do I discern it? How do I know if it's His will or mine? Am I willing to let go & let God? What do I do next? What if I think I am making a mistake? And those questions are not just reserved for the young people just starting out either. It seems to happen to most of us throughout our life.

In the 1st reading from Isaiah, "the LORD said to me: You are my servant, Israel, through whom I show my glory & I am made glorious in the sight of the LORD, & my God is now my strength!" "In the written scroll it is prescribed for me, to do your will, O my God, is my delight, & your law is within my heart!" Ps40 To do God's will is the central theme for me this weekend. Over & over it is repeated. As in the 2nd Reading from St. Paul to the Corinthians "Paul, called to be an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, & Sosthenes our brother." God's will is all-knowing, loving & perfect. Can we discern God's will? St. Paul taught us that we can. "For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually pray for you to be filled with all the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom & understanding that the Spirit gives." In other words, through combined prayer of all baptized Christians for each other, & through our own prayer to the Holy Spirit, we can come to do God's will. That's why we belong to a Church, a unified body, with God as the vine & we are his branches.

People frequently will tell me they are spiritual but not religious. They say I pray at home alone or out in nature somewhere & that's enough for them. Is that God's will or their own? Not so long ago, I read an article online [How to Discern God's Will](#) from Word On Fire ministry headed by Bishop Robert Barron. He said: it's a huge question & there are so many ways to get at it. Think of Saint Ignatius of Loyola's spiritual exercises that we should start 1st to determine our status, our state, & our vocation in life? Broadly speaking, what God wants for you is the path of greatest love. God is love. He sent His only Son to save us because He loves us. Love is the whole point of the spiritual life. He suggests reading about the lives of our saints, like St. John of the Cross, St. Therese the little flower or Reginald Garrigou-Lagrangé or any of these great spiritual masters & they'll say it all finally comes down to the cultivation of love. So what is love? Love is willing the good for another, it's not a sentiment or a feeling either. Sentiments & feelings have their role but don't let them distract you. Simply saying, "I don't feel right about this" or "This doesn't feel like the right path," is too superficial. To love is an act of the will, willing the good of the other. So what makes that love more prominent in your life? What makes it easier in your life to love? What path will open up the greatest capacity for love? Daily prayer, reading the bible, doing acts of charity, seeking out a spiritual counselor, even sharing with others about your faith, like we do with Henry Saturnus bi-monthly ministry, joining organizations surrounded by godly people & praying the rosary with our prayer group. The list of ideas are endless. Just ask the saints. The secret is not do it alone, but together as a family of God's children which we all belong to by our baptism. That's what God wants us to do, to love as He loves. For more good tips, go to Word on Fire to read the full article. See you in church?

How will parishes participate?

Parishes will conduct their own Generation to Generation campaigns, supported by a member of the campaign team and relying on the following five principles to reach their targets: Prayer, Personal visits, Proportional giving, Phase-by-phase approach, Pledged gifts.

Is the Annual Catholic Appeal taking place during the campaign?

Yes, the Annual Catholic Appeal will continue to be conducted annually. Generation to Generation is a capital campaign to meet the future needs of the Archdiocese, while the Annual Catholic Appeal helps fund the ongoing ministry of the Archdiocese of Chicago each year. The campaign office will work with parishes to educate parishioners on the difference between Generation to Generation and the Annual Catholic Appeal.

Jak parafie będą uczestniczyć?

Parafie przeprowadzą własne kampanie „Generation to Generation”, przy wsparciu przedstawiciela Archidiecezji i opierając się na następujących 5 zasadach, mających zapewnić osiągnięcie wyznaczonego celu: Modlitwa, Osobiste spotkania, Proporcjonalne ofiary, Podejście etapowe, Zadeklarowane darowizny.

Czy w trakcie kampanii będzie prowadzona coroczna zbiórka na Apel Katolicki?

Tak, coroczna zbiórka na Apel Katolicki (Annual Catholic Appeal) będzie nadal prowadzona co roku. Kampania „Generation to Generation” to akcja mająca na celu zaspokojenie przyszłych potrzeb Archidiecezji, podczas gdy coroczny Annual Catholic Appeal pomaga finansować co roku bieżące programy i potrzeby Archidiecezji Chicago. Biuro kampanii będzie współpracować z parafiami, aby wyjaśnić parafianom różnicę między kampanią „Generation to Generation” a coroczną zbiórką na Apel Katolicki.

¿Cómo participarán las parroquias?

Las parroquias llevarán a cabo sus propias campañas de Generación a Generación, con el apoyo de un miembro del equipo de la campaña y basándose en los siguientes cinco principios para alcanzar sus objetivos: Oración, Visitas personales, Donaciones proporcionales, Enfoque por fases, Donaciones comprometidas.

¿Se realizará la Campaña Católica Anual durante la campaña de Generación a Generación?

Sí, la Campaña Católica Anual continuará realizándose anualmente. Generación a Generación es una campaña de recaudación de fondos para cubrir las necesidades futuras de la Arquidiócesis, mientras que la Campaña Católica Anual ayuda a financiar el ministerio continuo de la Arquidiócesis de Chicago cada año. La oficina de la campaña trabajará con las parroquias para informar a los feligreses sobre la diferencia entre Generación a Generación y la Campaña Católica Anual.
