

## A few words from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners!

On Monday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, all dioceses in the United States are called to observe a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. January 22<sup>nd</sup> is the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Roe v. Wade, the Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion throughout our nation. Since then, over 60 million lives have been lost. That's more than the size of Italy's population. On June 24, 2022, the Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization decision overturned Roe v. Wade. While God, in His mercy, ended the nearly fifty-year nationwide regime of abortion on demand, right now, state and federal laws, in many instances, are still hostile to preborn children. So, great prayer and advocacy is very needed.

Today also, we are in the middle of the week of Prayer for Christian Unity. To many people this might seem like a simple task, just pray a little and everything will come together. Well, if it were that simple, believe me, by now it would have happened.

Next Sunday, we begin the celebration of Catholic Schools week in the Archdiocese. The 9:00 am. Mass at St. Richard church will be attended by many of our school children. After the Mass, there will be an Open House at both campuses for those who would like to check out the school and see what programs the school offers children. We encourage anyone with school age children to come and see the School. By the way, congratulations to over 40 students from our School who received the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time on Thursday.

## Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie!

Dziś, w niedzielę 22 stycznia, przypada 50-a rocznica niechłubnej decyzji Sądu Najwyższego Stanów Zjednoczonych, który zalegalizował aborcję. Od tego czasu zginęło ponad 60 milionów ludzi. 24 czerwca 2022 wyrok ten został wprawdzie uchylony, jednak ostateczne decyzje pozostawiono poszczególnym stanom, które w wielu wypadkach nadal są wrogo nastawione do nienarodzonych dzieci. Stąd też biskupi amerykańscy apelują, aby poniedziałek, 23 stycznia, był dniem modlitwy i pokuty dla wszystkich katolików. Dlatego i ja zachęcam, aby tak właśnie go przeżyć i w ten sposób pokazać swoje poparcie dla życia.

Cały czas trwa też Tydzień Modlitw o Jedność Chrześcijan. Wielu myśli, że zbudowanie jedności między wyznawcami Chrystusa jest bardzo łatwe. Wystarczy się pomodlić w tej intencji i problem będzie rozwiązany. Gdyby to było takie proste, to możecie mi wierzyć, już dawno byłaby „jedna owczarnia i jeden pasterz.” Obyśmy w rozpoczętym 2023 roku zrobili konkretny krok na drodze do jedności. Warto może zacząć od własnej rodziny i własnej parafii.

I na koniec zaproszenie na Tydzień Szkół Katolickich, którego celem jest ukazanie znaczenia katolickiej edukacji, a także promocja szkół katolickich. Z tej okazji, w przyszłą niedzielę, 29 stycznia, po Mszy o 9:00 w kościele św. Ryszarda, zapraszamy na zwiedzanie obu naszych szkół, czyli tak zwany Open House.

Todas las diócesis de EE.UU. están llamadas a observar el Día de oración por la protección legal de los niños no nacidos el lunes 23 de enero. El 22 de enero se cumplen 50 años desde que la Corte Suprema de los Estados Unidos legalizó el aborto. Desde entonces más de 60 millones de vidas se han perdido. El 24 de junio de 2022, la decisión de Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization anuló Roe v. Wade. Mientras Dios, en Su misericordia, puso fin al régimen nacional de aborto a pedido de casi cincuenta años, en este momento, las leyes estatales y federales, en muchos casos, todavía son adversos a los niños no nacidos. Por lo tanto, se necesita mucho la oración y el apoyo.

Hoy también marca la mitad de la Semana de Oración para la Unidad Cristiana. A muchos esto parece ser algo simple, solo con oración y todo vendrá a formarse. Pero, si esto fuera así de simple, créanme, ya habría sucedido.

El próximo domingo comenzamos la celebración de la semana de escuelas católicas de la arquidiócesis. Despues de la Misa de 9am, habrá una casa abierta de la escuela para los que gusten conocer ambos campus e informarse que programas se les ofrece a los estudiantes. Los animamos a que vengan.

Felicitaciones a los niños de la escuela que recibieron el Sacramento de Primera Reconciliación el pasado jueves.

## YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS

On Saturday 1/14, I was excited to be at the first ever Joint Symposium on the Diaconate & the Eucharistic Revival with the deacons, priests & bishops of the Joliet diocese. Cardinal Cupich gave the opening address. The US Catholic church kicked off this 3 yr campaign on the Feast of Corpus Christi in June 2022. You may ask why do we need one? Straight from the website of [www.eucharisticrevival.org](http://www.eucharisticrevival.org) are these words:" Scandal, division, disease, doubt. The Church has withheld each of these throughout our very human history. But today we confront all of them, all at once. Our response in this moment is pivotal. In the midst of these roaring waves, Jesus is present, reminding us that he is more powerful than the storm. He desires to heal, renew, & unify the Church & the world. How will he do it? By uniting us once again around the source & summit of our faith in the celebration of the Eucharist. The National Eucharistic Revival is the joyful, expectant, grassroots response of the entire Catholic Church in the U.S. to this divine invitation."

And boy, do we need it right here in our home parish & unfortunately, we are not unique. Very recently, one of our God Squad members was watering the poinsettias that have been gracing our church & she found something near the pot that was a shock! It definitely was placed there by someone who either knowingly or unknowingly desecrated a consecrated host. She immediately consumed Jesus & reported it. Makes you stop & wonder, if the person who came up for the reception of the Eucharist, did they understand the sacrilege they committed & their sin of excommunication until they confess their action? Or did they even care or believe it was Jesus? Let's pray for them. They need our prayers of conversion of heart for sure. Did that person believe that a Host is only a symbol or a wafer & not the true person of Jesus Christ? I know people say they believe in God, but do they believe in the Eucharist? That's why the bishops have asked us to get involved in this revival. Each one of us offends God every day, & our sins add to the suffering of the crucified Christ. Deliberate desecration of the Eucharist is a grave sin, but the celebration of the Eucharist-- every day, in every parish church is incalculably more important. Adoration of the Eucharist is just as important.

On this 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary time, we hear in the gospel of Matthew, how Jesus went out & gathered the disciples, one by one to make them fishers of men. By our baptism, we are His adopted children as well. And if we are to be true followers & His disciples on Earth right now, we need to spread the gospel by setting good examples to our families, friends & neighbors about the True Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. Did you know in the past century, there has been an uptick in numbers of Eucharistic miracles too? They are still being studied & explored for validity, but if you ask me, I believe Jesus wants us to come back to him. As He said: "Repent, for the kingdom of God is at hand." Faith is a gift, it's not automatic. Like anything, it needs to be fed, nurtured & practiced. The Bread of Life, Bread from Heaven, Viaticum, bread for the dying are all Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. I need a Savior & I believe we all need one. We can't go it alone. Ask & pray the Holy Spirit, to give you the wisdom & the gift of fear of the Lord. See you in church?


