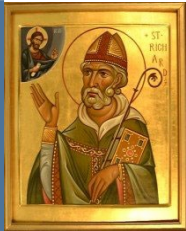

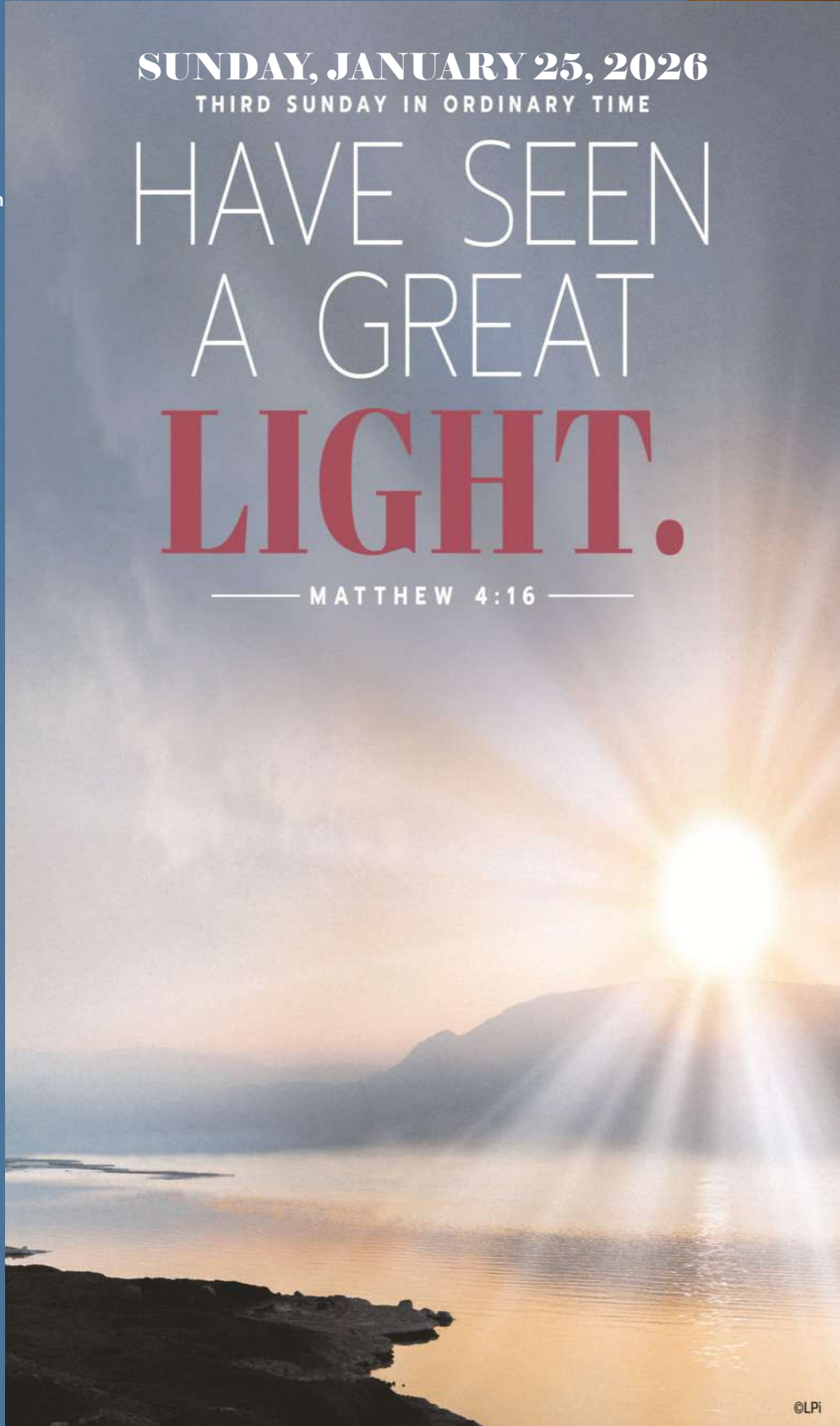

Dear Parishioners!

In our Gospel today, Jesus calls his disciples to come and follow him. As Jesus also calls out and asks us to follow him, we commemorate Word of God Sunday dedicated to the proclamation, study, and celebration of God's holy word. Jesus words call out to us today to a deeper commitment to our faith. May the word of God inspire us to enter our life of discipleship more deeply.

This Sunday we begin Catholic Schools week, recognizing the importance of Catholic education in our Archdiocese and in our Church. I want to thank in advance the many teachers, staff, and parents who make the mission of evangelization possible through Catholic education and who help form our children into joyful, missionary disciples.

On Tuesday, February 3rd, we have the feast of St. Blaise, the patron saint of protection of illnesses of the throat. Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie.

Dziś obchodzimy „Niedzielę Słowa Bożego”. Papież Franciszek ustanowił je świętem corocznym, aby przypomnieć nam o znaczeniu i wartości Pisma Świętego w życiu chrześcijanina. Zachęcam Wam dzisiaj do otwarcia Biblii i refleksji nad ulubionym fragmentem.

Dziś też rozpoczynają się obchody Tygodnia Szkół Katolickich, którego celem jest ukazanie znaczenia katolickiej edukacji, a także promocja szkół katolickich w USA.

A już niedługo, bo 3 lutego, przypada liturgiczne wspomnienie św. Błażeja, który jest patronem mówców, śpiewaków oraz wszystkich, którzy niejako zawodowo muszą dbać o swoje gardło i struny głosowe. Tradycją jest, że tego dnia udzielane jest specjalne błogosławieństwo gardła. Ponieważ w tym roku 3 lutego przypada we wtorek i nie każdy będzie mógł tego dnia być w kościele, dlatego też obrzęd błogosławieństwa gardła będzie miał miejsce na wszystkich Mszach w przyszłą niedzielę.

Wkrótce rozpocznie się Doroczna Kwesta Katolicka 2026 (tzw. Annual Catholic Appeal). Wielu z was otrzymało już list od ks. kardynała Cupicha z prośbą o podjęcie finansowego zobowiązania na rzecz dzieł prowadzonych przez Archidiecezję. Można na ten Apel odpowiedzieć już teraz, albo poczekać z tym do 15 lutego, kiedy uczynimy to razem w kościele. Jak wspominałem o tym tydzień temu, oprócz corocznej zbiórki na rzecz Apelu Katolickiego, w tym roku nasza parafia weźmie udział w jeszcze jednej akcji zatytułowanej „Generation to Generation Campaign.”. Ale o tym wkrótce.

Your Deacon Daydreams

Are you familiar with this saying? It's been on motivational signs hanging in offices & elsewhere including online. "Remember, whenever you are in a position to help someone, do it & be glad, because it's God answering someone's prayers through you!" It's an idea I believe everyone should consider. I also believe it's the driving theme of this weekend's gospel as Jesus begins His earthly ministry after his cousin John the Baptist was arrested. Jesus time to act started.

We hear in the gospel of Matthew, "As Jesus was walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon who is called Peter, & his brother Andrew, casting a net into the sea; they were fishermen. He said to them, "Come after me & I will make you fishers of men." At once they left their nets and followed him." As He walked further, "He also called James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John & they left their father & followed Him." The thing about all of us, we are all created with a free will. They easily could have said, Sorry, I don't have the time. Or check with us later, we have nets to mend. I have to discuss this first with my family before I can decide to join you, etc, etc. No, they dropped whatever they were doing, no questions asked & followed Jesus. Jesus' enthusiasm was so contagious. His zeal was something they craved also.

Would you do that? Lots of people have little trouble responding to flash mobs or protests, or political & sports events, street takeovers but what about God? People in Iran are even arrested & killed but they still show up, hoping for democracy. But what about God? Frequently, people will tell me that they don't know what to do with their spare time. Have you ever considered volunteering? My bride & I volunteer all the time. A large part of being a deacon is ministry to the poor & needy as well as teaching. I've been doing it long before I was ordained over 25 years ago. One of the benefits is called "a helper's high." That overwhelming feeling that what you are doing is good, & necessary. Plus the people you meet are amazing from all walks of life. Generous people of all ages from blue & white collar, from industry, medicine, education, trades, religious, you name it, with one common goal to answer God's call to serve.

There are so many places to help. Yes, money & time are precious commodities. Every church & non-profit is looking for help. I know right here in our parish, we always could use lectors, extraordinary Eucharistic ministers, religious ed teachers, particularly for the Special Religious ed program. We need altar servers as well as volunteers for the upcoming Lenten celebrations & 100 year anniversary plans. Ask anyone on our staff including myself where you can help out. Pray also for vocations, God is still calling, but people need to say "Yes" like Mary did. Can you imagine if she said no to the Angel Gabriel? She had a free will too. Your reward is great, plus your pension is out of this world. Remember what Cardinal George said, "You only take to heaven, what you gave away." See you in church?

How are parish campaign goals set?

Parish goals will be set at 130% of the parish's offertory income from the most recent available fiscal year. In line with Annual Catholic Appeal practice, a few parishes serving low-income communities will have goals of 100% of their latest fiscal year offertory. These parishes will be determined using known financial and demographic information of the parish community including U.S. Census data.

How will campaign funds be allocated?

Funds designated for the shared ministries of Generation to Generation will be allocated based on the percentages outlined in the campaign case statement. These funds will be directed to ministries as needs arise, regardless of whether the overall campaign goal has been met. Parishes will retain 50 cents of each dollar up to goal, 80 cents of each dollar after surpassing the goal in cash payments, and 100% of each dollar after surpassing 200% of the parish's goal in cash payments.

Jak ustalono cele kampanii w poszczególnych parafiach?

Cele jakie wyznaczono poszczególnym parafiom zostały ustalone na poziomie 130% dochodów z ofiar parafialnych z ostatniego roku podatkowego. W przypadku biedniejszych parafii, ten cel wyznaczono na poziomie 100% dochodów z ofiar z ostatniego roku podatkowego. Parafie te zostaną wybrane na podstawie danych z ostatniego spisu powszechnego.

Jak zostaną rozdysponowane środki zebrane w ramach kampanii?

Środki przeznaczone na różne programy duszpasterskie zostaną rozdysponowane równo po połowie (po 50 procent), niezależnie od tego, czy ogólny cel kampanii zostanie osiągnięty. To znaczy, że z każdego dolara parafia zatrzyma dla siebie 50 centów.

¿Cómo se establecen las metas de la campaña de la parroquia?

Las metas parroquiales se establecerán en el 130% de los ingresos por colectas de la parroquia correspondientes al último año fiscal disponible. De acuerdo con la práctica de la Campaña Católica Anual, algunas parroquias que atienden a comunidades de bajos ingresos tendrán metas equivalentes al 100% de sus ingresos por colectas del último año fiscal. Estas parroquias se determinarán utilizando la información financiera y demográfica disponible de la comunidad parroquial, incluyendo datos del censo de los Estados Unidos.

¿Cómo se asignarán los fondos de la campaña?

Los fondos destinados a los ministerios compartidos de Generación en Generación se asignarán según los porcentajes descritos en el documento informativo de la campaña. Estos fondos se destinarán a los ministerios según las necesidades que surjan, independientemente de si se ha alcanzado la meta general de la campaña. Las parroquias retendrán 50 centavos de cada dólar hasta alcanzar la meta, 80 centavos de cada dólar después de superar la meta en pagos en efectivo, y el 100% de cada dólar después de superar el 200% de la meta de la parroquia en pagos en efectivo.
