

LOVE GOD

What does it mean to love God with all our heart, being, strength, and mind? We turn our hearts to God in prayer,

quiet moments of reflection, and participation in the Mass and sacraments. Our whole being may turn to the Lord in trust in the midst of troubled times or when we need courage. We find strength to live as Christ's people, even when faced with the questions, doubts, and derision of others. We may turn to the Lord with our mind as we prayerfully read

sacred scripture and learn more fully the teaching of the Church. All of these things point to a singular desire to know God deeply. The love we have for God is, after all, a reflection of the great love God has for each of us.

LOVE NEIGHBOR

Jesus' parable of the Good Samaritan points to the impact our love of God is to have in our lives. The priest and Levite

were more concerned with observing the letter of the law rather than living its essence. The Samaritan found himself unable to pass by without coming to the traveler's aid. Who are the travelers whom we meet? What is our response? Are we so filled with the love of God that we cannot ignore the suffering of hunger or homelessness, the needs of the lonely and sick?

Loving God necessitates loving our neighbor. We cannot have one without the other. Jesus shows us that the love we are to share is selfless, sacrificial. The Samaritan not only cared for the traveler's wounds, but took him to find shelter and paid for his care. He went the extra mile on the journey of faith. Who is your neighbor today? How will you love him or her?

A few words from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners.

I hope your summer is going well. Summer is a good time to remind you of some church etiquette. I realize the majority of you understand and practice these things, but it never hurts to be refreshed on what is proper for our Sunday worship. So first, cell phones. Please remember to turn off, or at the very least silence your cell phones when bringing them into church. Of course, the best practice would be simply leaving them at home or in the car. Surely we can devote one hour of our week to God alone without the need of being contacted. If inadvertently you bring the phone into church and it rings, quickly silence it. And of course, never talk or text on a cell phone during Mass.

Proper Dress – As the temperature heats up, we have a tendency to become very casual in our church attire. I appreciate the need to be comfortable, but always keep in mind that we are in God's house. We would never show up underdressed to an important event socially. Spiritually then, our outward appearance should reflect our proper understanding of public worship. In other words, when people see you on Sunday morning, they should know you are going to Church, not the beach or a park. Arriving on Time – It is important to arrive at Church in plenty of time to prepare yourself for the celebration of the Liturgy. It is necessary that we properly dispose ourselves to receive the Word of God and the Holy Eucharist. We should never arrive so late that we reduce Mass to a communion service. Therefore, I would suggest arriving at least 5 – 10 minutes prior to starting time. You should spend a few minutes properly preparing yourself for the great mystery of our salvation.

So, please keep in mind these simple teachings as you worship and praise God during these summer months. It goes without saying that these reminders apply during any time of the year.

Słowo ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie!

Mam nadzieję, że lato mija Wam dobrze i spokojnie. Skoro mowa o lecie, to z mojego proboszczowskiego obowiązku, chciałbym przypomnieć o kilku sprawach, które na pewno znacie, rozumiecie i praktykujecie, ale nigdy nie szkodzi o nich przypomnieć. Wszystkie one bezpośrednio łączą się ze sobą, ponieważ związane są z naszym uczestnictwem w niedzielnej Mszy świętej. Pierwsza sprawa – to telefony komórkowe. Nigdy nie zapomnijcie je wyłączyć lub przynajmniej wyciszyć, kiedy przekraczacie próg kościoła. Oczywiście, najlepiej byłoby je zostawić w domu albo w samochodzie. Można chyba poświęcić 1 godzinę w tygodniu Bogu, bez konieczności bycia jednocześnie podłączonym do wszystkich bliskich, krewnych i znajomych. A jeśli już przez nieuwagę wniesiesz swój telefon do kościoła i on niespodziewanie zadzwoni, po prostu szybko ucisz go, a nie gadaj przez telefon w kościele, ani nawet nie wysyłaj wiadomości.

Druga sprawa – to właściwy ubiór. Sami przyznacie, że różnie z tym bywa, szczególnie latem. Ja wiem, że na dworze jest ciepło, ale nie mylmy kościoła z plażą czy parkiem. Czasy, gdy w szafie trzymało się specjalne ubranie tylko do kościoła już dawno minęły, ale trochę powściągliwości i dobrego smaku byłoby mile widziane. Naszym niedzielnym strojem także okazujemy szacunek Panu Bogu.

I ostatnia sprawa – to punktualność. To naprawdę jest ważne, by być w kościele na czas, a nawet przed czasem, ażeby do Mszy się przygotować, wyciszyć, duchowo nastroić. Nie powinniśmy zredukować naszego udziału we Mszy św. do krótkiego pokazania się w kościele.

Pamiętajcie o tych trzech sprawach: o telefonach, o właściwym stroju i o punktualności. I nie tylko latem, bo są one aktualne przez cały rok.

Unas palabras del Párroco

Queridos feligreses.

Espero que estén disfrutando su verano. Aprovechemos la temporada de verano para recordar cual es el compartimiento que se espera de nosotros en la iglesia. La mayoría de ustedes entienden y practican estas cosas, pero no duele refrescar la mente. Comencemos con los celulares, por favor apáguenlos o por lo menos poner en silencio. Por supuesto, la mejor practica sería dejarlos en la casa o en el carro. Seguramente podemos dedicar una hora de nuestra semana a Dios sin necesidad de ser contactados. Si por alguna razón tu celular suena en la iglesia, por favor de poner en silencio inmediatamente. Recuerden, nunca hagan llamadas o manden mensajes de texto durante Misa.

Ropa apropiada – Con las temperaturas altas, usualmente sacamos nuestra ropa de verano y tendemos vestirnos muy casuales para ir a la iglesia. Aprecio la necesidad de estar cómodo, pero siempre tenga en cuenta que estamos en la casa de Dios. Nunca nos presentaríamos mal vestidos a un evento social importante. Entonces, espiritualmente, nuestra apariencia externa debe reflejar nuestra comprensión adecuada de la adoración pública. En otras palabras, cuando la gente te vea el domingo por la mañana o la tarde, debe saber que vas a la iglesia, no a la playa o al parque.

Llegar a tiempo – Es importante llegar a la iglesia con suficiente tiempo para prepararnos para la celebración Litúrgica. Es necesario que nos dispongamos debidamente a recibir la Palabra de Dios y la Sagrada Eucaristía. Deberías dedicar unos minutos a prepararte adecuadamente para el gran misterio de nuestra salvación. Nunca debemos llegar tan tarde que la Misa se reduzca a un servicio de comunión. Les sugiero llegar al menos 5 a 10 minutos antes de que comience la Misa.

Así que, tenga en cuenta estas sencillas enseñanzas mientras adoran y alaban a Dios durante estos meses de verano. No hace falta decir que estos recordatorios se aplican durante cualquier época del año.

On this 15th Sunday of Ordinary time, the 1st reading from Deuteronomy recalled the story of Moses, "Moses said to the people: "If only you would heed the voice of the LORD, your God & keep his commandments & statutes." It brought me back to thinking about the Ten Commandments movie starring Yul Brynner & Charleston Heston. A powerful depiction of the historical event." If you would only HEED my commandments." Those words were not just meant for the people of Moses' time but definitely speaks loudly to all of us right here, right now. Are we listening to God? Or do we only have "selective" hearing, listening to the part that agrees with us or with the culture of the world today? Hopefully, you have some kind of prayer life & it is part of your daily ritual. We can't hold a conversation if only one partner in the conversation is listening & God is always listening. He is ever faithful. As the saying goes, "It takes two to Tango" so does prayer. "Heed the voice of the Lord."

As I was preparing my article, breaking news of the tragedy unfolded on July 4th at the Independence Day parade. Once again our country has been wounded severely & many lives were stolen away by a violence that should have never occurred. Lake County, Highland Park is part of the Archdiocese of Chicago. One of the victims is the son of one of my fellow deacons. He is expected to survive but sadly too many did not. May eternal rest on their souls. Bring comfort to all those affected. Our Lady of Peace, heal this nation of its grievous ills on what should have been a joyous celebration of our nation's birth. 




