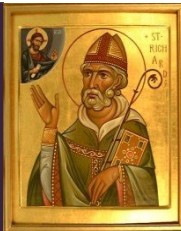

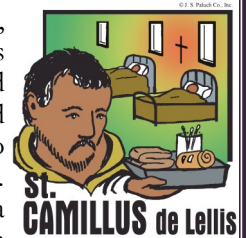

St. Camillus de Lellis was born at Bocchianico, Italy. He fought for the Venetians against the Turks, was addicted to gambling, and by 1574 was penniless in Naples. He became a Capuchin novice, but was unable to be professed because of a diseased leg he contracted while fighting the Turks. He devoted himself to caring for the sick, and became director of St. Giacomo Hospital in Rome. He received permission from his confessor (St. Philip Neri) to be ordained and decided, with two companions, to found his own congregation, the Ministers of the Sick (the Camellians), dedicated to the care of the sick. They ministered to the sick of Holy Ghost Hospital in Rome, enlarged their facilities in 1585, founded a new house in Naples in 1588, and attended the plague-stricken aboard ships in Rome's harbor and in Rome. In 1591, the Congregation was made into an order to serve the sick by Pope Gregory XIV, and in 1591 and 1605, Camillus sent members of his order to minister to wounded troops in Hungary and Croatia, the first field medical unit. Gravely ill for many years, he resigned as superior of the Order in 1607 and died in Rome on July 14, the year after he attended a General Chapter there. He was canonized in 1746, was declared patron of the sick, with St. John of God, by Pope Leo XIII, and patron of nurses and nursing groups by Pope Pius XI.

Dear Parishioners!

I hope that your summer is going well. Vacation time is holiday time and time for rest. Everyone knows that it is the time for physical and intellectual rest. However, it should never be a holiday from God and prayer. Even on vacation we need to make time for prayer and Sunday Mass.

We hear in the Gospel this weekend that Jesus came to the house of Martha and Mary. Martha got completely carried away by the details of hospitality, but Mary sat at the feet of Jesus and listened to him. It's not that what Martha does is unimportant. It is just that Mary has chosen something even more important. Mary's priority is to listen to the words of Jesus. The story of Martha and Mary can be seen as a parable in action. Whereas the parable of the Good Samaritan, which we heard last week, stressed the importance of practical love in the life of a disciple, this one stresses the importance of contemplation. Both of these are necessary and have to be integrated into our lives.

So when you travel or are on vacation don't forget to go to Mass. Sometimes in a new and unknown place it is difficult to find a Catholic Church, so I offer you this internet address www.masstimes.org and wherever you are you will be able to find a church and times when Mass is celebrated.
