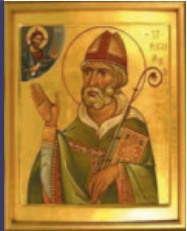

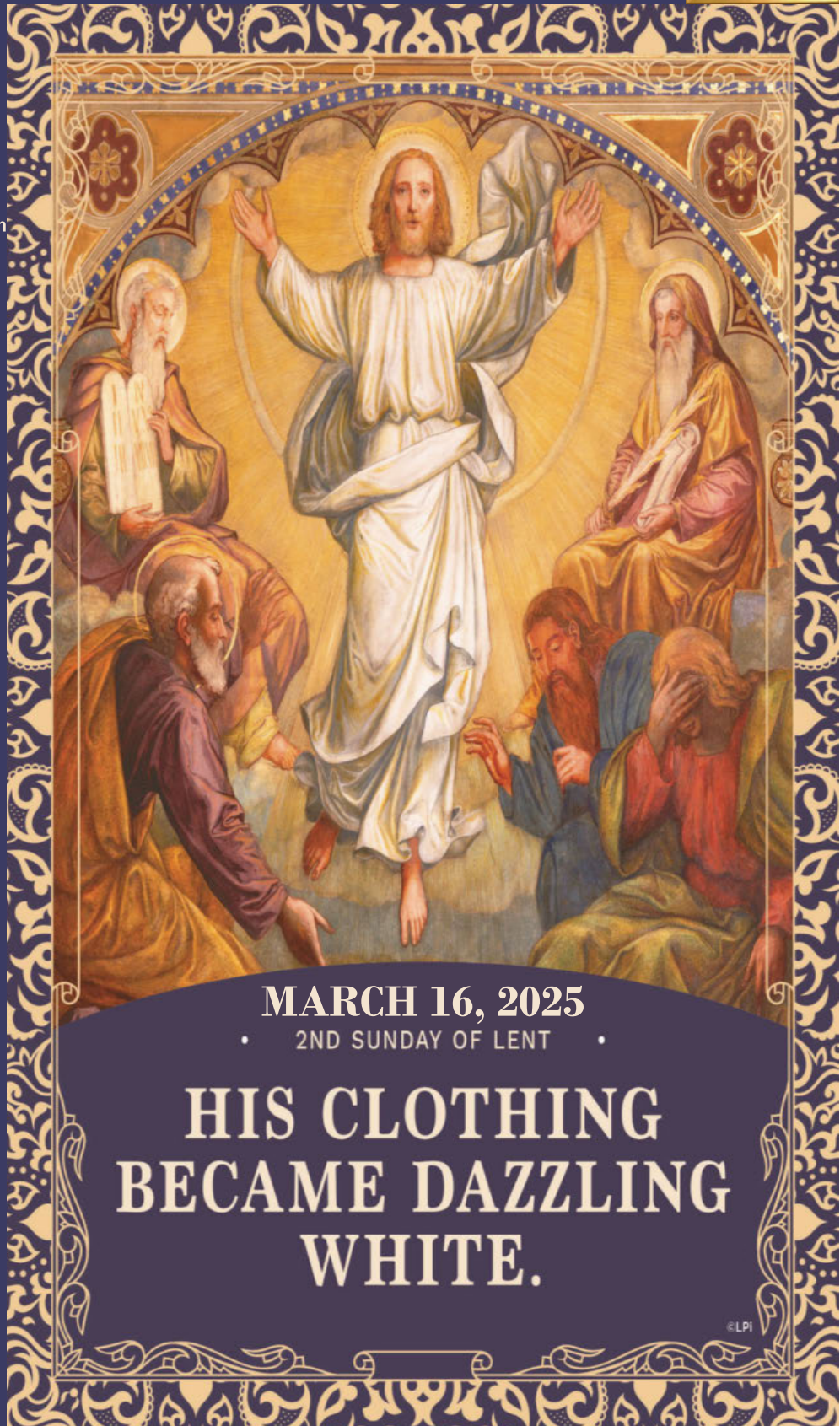

Dear Parishioners!

Today we mark the Second Sunday of Lent. The scriptures readings and Mass prayers of these early weeks of the season invite us to seriously respond to the call to conversion of heart that we have heard on Ash Wednesday and to continue in our efforts to enter into the season as best as we can. We are called to turn away from our sinfulness and turn toward God. The traditional Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are held up before us as excellent ways of living the season. We have many spiritual opportunities available here at St. Bruno and St. Richard to go deeper in our personal faith in Jesus during the 40 days of Lent. Our parish bulletin gives a listing of those opportunities, and I strongly encourage all to take advantage of the spiritual practices. Since Lent involves alms giving, I encourage also your participation in the Rice Bowl collection to help hungry, especially the children. There are still some rice bowls at the exit of the church. Fill them with your spare change and return them on the last Sunday of Lent. Since all Fridays of Lent we must abstain from eating meat, I invite you for the Lenten Dinners. Every Friday we have a different menu. You can take it to go or eat in the St. Richard church hall.

We still continue with the Archdiocese of Chicago Annual Catholic Appeal 2025. Some of you already completed pledge forms received from the Archdiocese in the mail. Thank you very much for your financial support and the gift of constant prayers in the intention of the Annual Catholic Appeal. I trust that just like in the past, we will meet our designated goal and perhaps go over. For parishioners and guests who didn't get a chance to submit their commitment, extra pledge envelopes are available at the exit of the church. Please know, we need you not only in good times but also in the times of need. Do not remain anonymous in your faith, hope, love, trust, and sacrifice! Please, try to identify yourself with our small but beautiful and vibrant parish! Take courage!

Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie.

To już Druga Niedziela Wielkiego Postu. Dzisiejsza Ewangelia mówi nam o Przemienieniu Pana Jezusa na Górze Tabor. Przyjmijmy to wydarzenie jak zaproszenie do przemiany naszego życia przez dobre przeżycie Wielkiego Postu. Kościół na różne sposoby pragnie nam pomóc, abyśmy ten szczególny czas przeżyli z jak największym pożytkiem dla naszego życia doczesnego i wiecznego. Czyni to zwłaszcza przez głoszenie słowa Bożego, sprawowanie sakramentu pokuty i organizowanie specjalnych nabożeństw, takich jak Droga Krzyżowa czy Gorzkie Żale. Jako że we wszystkie piątki Wielkiego Postu zobowiązani jesteśmy do powstrzymania się od jedzenia mięsa, dlatego zapraszam wszystkich do sali pod kościołem św. Ryszarda na postne posiłki (tak zwane *Lenten Dinner*). Co w dany piątek będzie można zjeść podane jest w innym miejscu tego biuletynu. W czasie Wielkiego Postu uczestniczymy też w akcji „Miska Ryżu”, której celem jest pomoc głodującym dzieciom na świecie. Przy wyjściu z kościoła są wyłożone specjalne papierowe skarbonki, które wystarczy wypełnić drobnymi centami (mogą być i większe nominały) i przynieść do końca Wielkiego Postu.

I już na koniec przypominam, że jesteśmy w trakcie trwania Dorocznej Kwesty Katolickiej (*Annual Catholic Appeal 2025*). Wielu z Was złożyło już swoje finansowe zobowiązanie. Niech Bóg Wam za to wynagrodzi. Ufam, że podobnie jak w latach poprzednich tak i w tym roku, nie tylko osiągniemy wyznaczony cel, ale go przekroczymy. Pod warunkiem oczywiście, że wszyscy zaangażują się w tę akcję. Także ci, którzy choć nie są zapisani do naszej parafii, ale korzystają z naszej posługi duszpasterskiej. Nie bądźcie anonimowi w swojej wierze i ofiarności. Spróbujcie choć raz utożsamić się z naszą niedużą w prawdzie, ale jeszcze żywą parafią. Odwagi!

Your Deacon Daydreams

When was the last time you went on a field trip? Maybe it was decades ago in grade or high school? Maybe it was a sporting event or senior citizen's casino trip? If the bus ride was boring, occasionally someone would break out into a song like 99 bottles of beer on the wall or the Wheels on the bus. The lyrics that comes to my mind on this 2nd week of Lent's gospel is from the Serendipity singers "Beans in my Ears." You know the one that sings "You'll have to speak up I got beans in my ears. Beans in my ears, beans in my ears. You'll have to speak up I got beans in my ears, Beans in my ears." Here's why.

Today in the good news we hear about Jesus' apostles, Peter, James & John who were invited to climb the mountain to pray with Him. "While Jesus was praying his face changed in appearance & His clothing became dazzling white. And behold, two men were conversing with Him, Moses & Elijah, who appeared in glory & spoke of His exodus that He was going to accomplish in Jerusalem." However, Peter was more concerned about building tents instead of what the three were saying about what was to happen to Jesus in the near future. You could say, Peter had "beans in his ears." His attention was focused elsewhere, not until a cloud cast a shadow, frightening them. Then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my chosen Son; listen to him." After the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone."

Unfortunately, I don't think "beans in my ears," is only Peter's problem these days. More than often, we don't listen to the voice of God either! Those "beans in our ears" are blocking our need to accept His love, grace & mercy. Addiction, sin, the culture, distractions, ignorance, denial that God is real seem to be the "beans." The list goes on & on. It saddens me when I ask even the school children, "How many of you attended Sunday mass?" Only a 1/3 raise their hands. That frightens me, but there is great hope, if we decide to make this Lent different. What kind of an example are we setting when we don't take our kids to church with us?

The way to turn off the noise of the world includes: works of charity, devotion, & prayer, both spontaneous & structured. Turn on EWTN TV or Relevant radio & participate in the rosary, chaplet of Divine Mercy, Mass or the prayerful discussions. The hardest one is to sit before the Blessed Sacrament or alone in a room & be silent so the Lord can speak to you. As a tool, I frequently will follow the advice of author Bob Beaudine in his book "Two Chairs." The rule is to set up two chairs facing each other. One for you, one for God. And ask Jesus how His day went & tell Him about yours. Then silently listen. Don't just tell Him what you wish He would do for you. Instead listen to the voice from heaven, "Listen to my Beloved Son." Repent this Lent. See you in church?

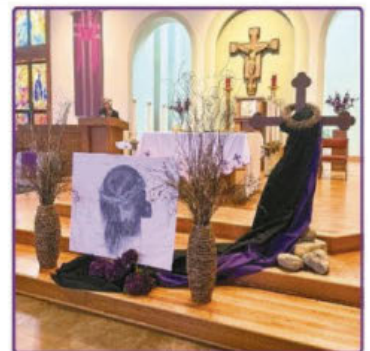


Ash Wednesday
