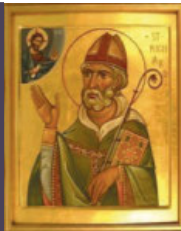

A few words from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners!

Today is the Third Sunday of Lent and we are now half way through our Lenten journey. As I pointed out at the very beginning, in Lent we are called to practices of prayer, fasting, and acts of charity. In addition to abstaining from meat on Fridays and fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, many of us also give up something we enjoy - certain foods or pleasurable activities as a sacrifice during the 40 days of Lent. How are your Lenten sacrifices going? Usually by this time we are beginning to feel the weight of them, or maybe have given up. All of us struggle with the good intentions of Ash Wednesday, and some (perhaps many) of us fail. The important thing is to get-up and try again. God loves our efforts and is ready to help us keep going or start anew when we fail. Look at the schedule of our Lenten devotions and confessions, find a convenient time to shed your sins and reconcile yourself to our Lord.

On a completely different note, this week, we welcome Bishop José María García-Maldonado to our parish and more precisely to St. Bruno church for the Confirmation Mass for the youth from Sts. Bruno & Richard School and Religious Education program. This Thursday, March 27th, at 6:00 p.m. 41 candidates will receive the outpouring of God's Holy Spirit during the Confirmation Mass. I ask you to pray for these candidates who over the past two years have been studying and preparing for the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Also, pray for Bishop García-Maldonado as he celebrates this important sacrament in the lives of these young men and women and in the life of our parish family. To the candidates, I pray that they all receive the grace this sacrament offers and the seven-fold gifts of the Holy Spirit: Wisdom, Understanding, Council (right judgment), Fortitude (courage), Knowledge, Piety (reverence) and Fear of the Lord (wonder & awe).

Your Deacon Daydreams

When make a major decision, what's a good rule of thumb? For me, I ask myself this: will this matter 100 years from now? What's important in your life? This Lent have you asked yourself if you are on the right road to salvation? Do you have a relationship with Jesus? Do you believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist or is it just a symbol? The church last year & in the past 3 yrs. prior, participated in a national Eucharistic revival. My prayer is that more hearts were converted to believe that the Eucharist is the source & summit of our Catholic faith. Unfortunately, that may not be true for some of us or even many of us, otherwise I would not bring this up today. If we truly believed in Jesus in the Eucharist, we would immediately consume the host/Holy Communion after receiving Him at mass. Years ago, when receiving Jesus on our tongue there was little issue of this but since receiving Him in our hands, it has become a problem for some who may not understand how vital & mandatory this is. Last week, a consecrated host was found under a pew by another parishioner. She brought it to our attention & it was immediately taken care of properly by your deacon. My wife & I did a prayer & litany of reparation due to this desecration as well. So I am asking all us, to be vigilant. If you see someone possibly not consuming the host properly after receiving Jesus, please advise our priests or deacons. Of course, if any shut-in is requesting communion @ home, please contact our parish office.

It's official! Spring has sprung! The snow shovel vs the barbecue discussion is happening all over town. Even our gospel from Luke this weekend is reaching out to farmers & gardeners alike specially when it comes to the work in the "field of souls," as in the parable of the orchard owner who told his gardener to cut down the fruitless fig tree. However, the gardener pleaded, "Sir, leave it for this year & I shall cultivate & fertilize the ground around lest it may bear fruit in the future. If not you can cut it down." It suggests that we too need to nurture our faith & commit ourselves to being helpful to the lives of others. Are we nurturing our faith & trying to love, so as to bear the kind of fruit God wants from us? Only you can answer that question. St. Francis of Assisi said, to preach often & when necessary use words. That means, by our actions we are known as Christians devoted to our Lord & Savior.

I know, I have been talking about some of my fav songs this Lent, perhaps you are already familiar with this one from the Brooklyn Tabernacle Choir, it is "Field of Souls." Here are just a part of the lyrics: We'll work the fields of souls, together you and I. Some fields are blooming now, other fields are dry. We are not the same but differences aside. We'll work the fields of souls together you & I. One is off to foreign soil to work a distant land, oh yeah. And another anchors close to home to hold a neighbor's hand. Tell me, who has served the Father most & who has labored best? Well, the life devoted to our God, that devotion will be blessed. Repent this Lent. See you in church?

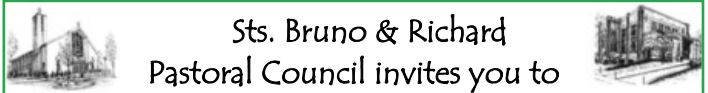

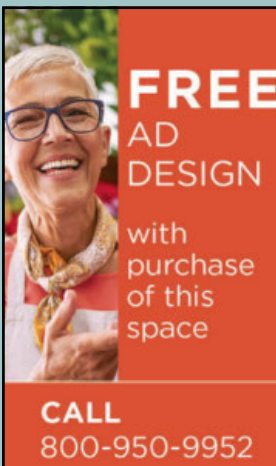
