

A FEW WORDS FROM FATHER ANDREW

Dear Parishioners.

Beginning with Palm Sunday, April 10, Saints Bruno and Richard Parish will celebrate its first Holy Week. Until now, we have been able to maintain the liturgical schedules at both St. Bruno and St. Richard, as they had been observed in previous years, with a few minor changes. But the rules for celebrating the liturgies of Holy Week do not allow us to simply repeat that which the former parishes have done in previous years. Our new reality, while building upon the traditions of our past, calls for a renewed approach to the age-old practices of the most sacred days of the liturgical year. In today's bulletin, you will find the proposed schedule of services for Holy Week, 2022. As the guidelines for the celebration of Holy Week demand that we as a parish host only one Mass on Holy Thursday and that the celebration be in the hours of the early evening, we will celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper in a trilingual liturgy in only one of our churches. These guidelines oblige us to do the same for the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night. We decided to offer the Holy Thursday Mass at St. Richard Church. The Easter Vigil Mass will be held in St. Bruno Church. The Good Friday Liturgy of the Lord's Passion will be celebrated in both churches. Morning Mass is not celebrated on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, or Holy Saturday. On Holy Saturday, Easter baskets will be blessed at St. Richard Church at 10:00 and 11:00 am. and at St. Bruno Church at 12:00 Noon and 1:00 pm. The solemn Resurrection Procession and Mass in Polish will be on Sunday, April 17, at 6:00 am. at St. Richard Church. May our first celebration as a united parish of the Lord's Passover from death to life strengthen our faith, confirm us in hope, and enable us all to better love one another, as Christ calls us.

Słowo ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie!

Już niedługo, 10 kwietnia, Niedziela Palmowa, która rozpoczyna obchody Wielkiego Tygodnia. Wielki Tydzień ma tak wysoką rangę w liturgii Kościoła, że nie dopuszcza nawet innych uroczystości. Gdyby zaś takie wypadły, odkłada się je na czas po Wielkanocy i po jej oktawie (np. Uroczystość Zwiastowania). W Wielki Czwartek wolno w parafii odprawić tylko jedną Mszę św. w godzinach wieczornych. Nazywamy ją "Mszą Wieczery Pańskiej". Podobnie jest też w Wielką Sobotę. Ponieważ w tym roku, po raz pierwszy będziemy obchodzić Wielki Tydzień razem, jako jedna połączona parafia, dlatego też z konieczności będzie musiał ulec zmianie plan Mszy i nabożeństw w tym okresie. W dzisiejszym biuletynie znajdziecie plan Mszy i nabożeństw w Wielkim Tygodniu w obu naszych kościołach. W wielki skrócie powiem tylko tyle, że w Wielki Czwartek tak zwana Msza św. Wieczery Pańskiej będzie odprawiona w kościele św. Ryszarda, a w Wielką Sobotę gromadzimy się na Liturgii Wigilii Paschalnej w kościele św. Brunona. Oba nabożeństwa, z konieczności, będą odprawione w 3 językach. Wielki Piątek dopuszcza rozważanie Męki Pańskiej w ojczystych językach. Święcenie pokarmów wielkanocnych odbędzie się w obu kościołach. Ponieważ ostatnia Pasterka była w kościele św. Brunona, dlatego też Rezurekcja, dla odmiany, będzie w tym roku w kościele św. Ryszarda.

Pewno nie wszyscy będą zadowoleni z tego planu, ale myślę, że już najwyższy czas, by wreszcie zaakceptować prawdę, że jesteśmy jedną parafią z dwoma kościołami i w obu jesteśmy u siebie. Niech wspólne świętowanie największych tajemnic naszej wiary umocni nas w wierze, nadziei i pozwoli nam wszystkim lepiej miłować się nawzajem, do czego wzywa nas sam Chrystus.

Comenzando con el Domingo de Ramos, 10 de abril, la Parroquia de los Santos Bruno y Ricardo estará celebrando su primera Semana Santa. Hasta ahora se ha podido mantener los mismos horarios litúrgicos en San Bruno y San Ricardo como se ha hecho en el pasado solo con algunos ajustes. Pero, las pautas para celebrar las liturgias de Semana Santa nos impiden mantener eso horarios que se usaron año tras año. Las pautas demandan que como parroquia celebremos solo una Misa el Jueves Santo y que se celebre por la tarde. Así que, la Misa de la Cena del Señor será en una de nuestras iglesias en 3 idiomas. Se siguen las mismas pautas para el Sábado de Gloria. En el boletín de hoy pueden encontrar el horario para Semana Santa. Y como podrán ver, la Misa del Jueves Santo será en San Ricardo y la Vigilia Pascual del Sábado de Gloria será en San Bruno. El Viernes Santo tendremos la liturgia de la Pasión del Señor en ambas iglesias. No habrá Misa por la mañana el Jueves Santo, Viernes Santo y Sábado Santo. El Sábado Santo, las canastas de Pascua serán bendecidas en San Ricardo a las 10am y a las 11am y en San Bruno a las 12pm y a la 1pm. La solemne procesión y Misa de la Resurrección en polaco será el domingo 17 de abril a las 6am en San Ricardo. Que nuestra primera celebración de la Pascua del Señor de la muerte a la vida como una parroquia unificada fortalezca nuestra fe, nos confirme en la esperanza y nos permita a todos mejor amarnos unos a otros, como Cristo nos llama.

YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS | MARZENIA DIAKONA EN SUS SUEÑOS DIACONALES



Can you believe that winter is over & spring has sprung? I overheard my snow shovel talking to my barbecue saying, "See you next year!" The days are getting longer & the nights shorter. It feels so good to occasionally be able to open the windows for some fresh air too. It's a good remedy to cure cabin fever too. This weekend's readings from the letter to the Corinthians & the gospel of Luke have the theme of reconciliation & forgiveness. It is our cue to open the windows & doors of our hearts to those who have hurt us. Try focusing instead on the gospel message of the parable of the prodigal son & how his father who had been deeply hurt ran to forgive him & celebrated with a great feast. Who is the prodigal one in your life? A grown child? A sibling? Your spouse? A neighbor? Maybe they have chosen a lifestyle that has led them away from God, believing that their great successes in life were only due to their achievement alone. So why should they live a life of thanksgiving to God? I am sure we all know someone who maybe has chosen instead to live in the fast lane rather than a life of humility & gratitude. It might even be us. And why should we forgive them if in the process it has hurt us? Why, because Our Lord taught us His prayer, "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." God is merciful. "All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself & gave us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, & entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. So we are ambassadors for Christ." So during this 4th week of Lent, think seriously how we are praying the Lord's prayer. Don't just rattle it off, dwell on its meaning in our own life. See you in church?

Trudno w to uwierzyć, ale nadeszła wiosna, a po zimie pozostało już tylko wspomnienie. Dni są coraz dłuższe, a noce krótsze. Dobrze jest czasem otworzyć okna, by przewietrzyć mieszkanie i zaczerpnąć świeżego powietrza. Dzisiejsze czytania mszalne poruszają temat pojednania i przebaczenia. Może to jakiś znak, by otworzyć też okna i drzwi naszych serc dla tych, którzy nas skrzywdzili. A może lepiej od razu skupić się na ewangelicznym przesłaniu przypowieści o synu marnotrawnym i zobaczyć jak postąpił jego ojciec. Kto jest tym synem marnotrawnym w twoim życiu? Jedno z twoich dzieci? Ktoś z rodzeństwa? Małżonek? Sąsiad? Czy potrafisz postąpić tak jak ten miłosierny ojciec? Przyjąć, przebaczyć, cieszyć się jego powrotem, wystawić ucztę? A dlaczego miałbym przebaczyć skoro to ja zostałem skrzywdzony? Ano dlatego, bo Jezus tak nas uczy: „Przebacz nam nasze winy, jako i my odpuszczamy naszym winowajcom”. Bóg jest miłosierny. „Wszystko to pochodzi od Boga, który pojednał nas z sobą przez Chrystusa i zlecił nam posługę pojednania. Albowiem w Chrystusie Bóg jednał z sobą świat, nie poczytując ludziom ich grzechów, nam zaś przekazując słowo pojednania. Tak więc w imieniu Chrystusa spełniamy jakby posłannictwo jakby Boga samego”. Tak więc w tym 4-ym tygodniu Wielkiego Postu pomyślmy, jak odmawiamy tę Modlitwę Pańską. Nie odklepujmy jej, ale zastanówmy się czasem nad jej znaczeniem w naszym własnym życiu.

Estoy seguro que todos por lo menos conocemos a alguien así. A lo mejor esos somos nosotros. Y si en el proceso nos han lastimado, ¿por qué debemos perdonarlos? Porque nuestro Señor nos lo ha enseñado en Su oración, "perdona nuestras ofensas, como también nosotros perdonamos a los que nos ofenden." Dios es misericordioso. "Todo esto proviene de Dios, que nos reconcilió consigo por medio de Cristo y que nos confirió el ministerio de la reconciliación. Porque, efectivamente, en Cristo, Dios reconcilió al mundo consigo y renunció a tomar en cuenta los pecados de los hombres, y a nosotros nos confió el mensaje de la reconciliación. Por eso, nosotros somos embajadores de Cristo." Así que, en esta cuarta semana de Cuaresma, piensa muy bien en cómo estamos rezando la oración del Señor. No la digas solo por decir, toma un momento y piensa sobre su significado en tu vida. ¿Nos vemos en la iglesia?



