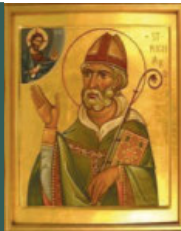

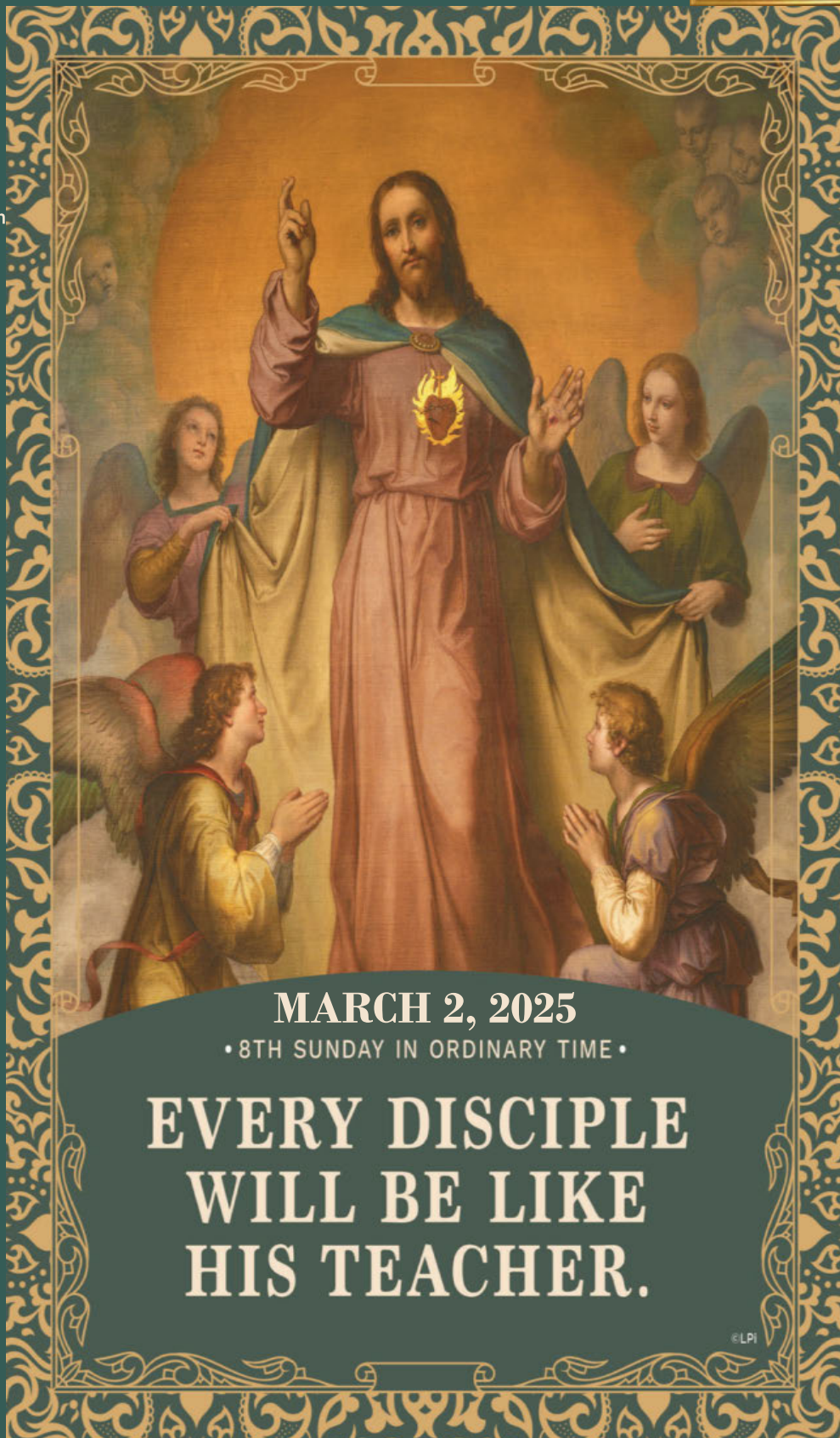

A few words from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners!

Thank you to everyone who made a pledge or gave a monetary gift to the 2025 Annual Catholic Appeal last weekend. Thanks to you we are off to a good start. We as a parish are called to support the work of the Cardinal Cupich and our Archdiocese. Our assessment this year is \$29,757. We can easily do this if we all do our part. If you have not yet participated, please consider doing so today. Appeal envelopes are available at the doors in the church for your use and can be sent directly to the Archdiocese of Chicago or placed in the offertory collection basket. It is important to mark on the envelope that you are a Sts. Bruno & Richard parishioner so that our parish gets credit for your donation. Once again thank you for your generosity and support.

This coming Wednesday, March 5, we begin the holy season of Lent as we celebrate Ash Wednesday. Lent is a time of spiritual renewal and a time when we devote ourselves more diligently to activities that promote our relationship with the Lord. The laws of Fast and Abstinence are the part of the Lenten observance. Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent are days when anyone who is 14 years of age or older abstain from eating meat. In addition, we have two days of fast, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On Fast Days, persons 18-59 years of age should restrict their eating to one full or two light meatless meals.

On Ash Wednesday we will have 7 Masses and one prayer service with distribution of ashes. Take a look at our schedule of liturgies for this day and be sure to attend one of them. The gesture of bowing our heads to the words: "Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel," is a sign of penance and of our faith. Take note in our bulletin of the times for Stations of the Cross throughout Lent. And don't forget to make plans to go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) during Lent. Why not schedule it as an actual appointment in your calendar? Don't wait until the last minute. During Lent also, come and enjoy a delicious fish fry dinner every Friday's after or before Stations of the Cross sponsored by different groups and organizations. Our Parish, once again, will participate in CRS Rice Bowl – Catholic Relief Services' Lenten program, as a way to encounter Jesus through others, especially through the most vulnerable in our world.

Słowo od ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie.

Bardzo dziękuję za wasze deklaracje i pierwsze ofiary pieniężne na Doroczną Kwestę Katolicką (*Annual Catholic Appeal 2025*) złożone w ubiegłą niedzielę. Cieszę się, że jesteście oddani nie tylko naszej parafii, ale rozumiecie też potrzeby całej Archidiecezji. W tym roku, Archidiecezja wyznaczyła naszej parafii zebranie \$29,779. Suma ta nie jest mała, ale wspólnymi siłami jesteśmy w stanie ją zebrać, a nawet przekroczyć. Jeśli kogoś nie było w kościele w ubiegłą niedzielę to nie jest jeszcze za późno, aby włączyć się w tę akcję. Stosowne koperty z formularzem, wyłożone są przy wyjściu z kościoła. Wypełnione deklaracje – z ofiarą lub bez – można wysłać bezpośrednio na adres Archidiecezji Chicago, albo też złożyć na tacę lub w kancelarii parafialnej. Ważne jest jednak, aby w deklaracji wyraźnie zaznaczyć, że jesteście z parafii Sts. Bruno & Richard w Chicago.

W najbliższą środę mamy już Popielec. Tego dnia, w obu naszych kościołach, będzie 7 Mszy św. i 1 nabożeństwo, oczywiście wszystkie one z obrzędem znaczenia nas popiołem. Szczegóły w innej części tego biuletynu. Środa Popielcowa rozpoczyna okres Wielkiego Postu, który ma nas przygotować do owocnego przeżycia największej tajemnicy naszej wiary, jaką jest Zmartwychwstanie Jezusa Chrystusa. Niech to będzie czas wewnętrznego wyciszenia, modlitwy, pełnienia uczynków miłosierdzia i korzystania z pełni łask, jaką daje sakrament Eucharystii i Pojednania. Pomocą w dobrym przeżyciu tego okresu niech będą tradycyjne wielkopostne nabożeństwa. I tak we wszystkie piątki Wielkiego Postu zapraszam na Drogi Krzyżową, a w niedzielę na Gorzkie Żale.

Przypominam, że w Środę Popielcową obowiązuje nas post ścisły, tak ilościowy jak i jakościowy. W czasie Wielkiego Postu nasz parafia będzie też uczestniczyć w „Operacji Miska Ryżu.” Już dziś zapraszam też wszystkich na piątkowe obiady postne, które przygotowywać będą różne grupy parafialne.

Nosotros como parroquia estamos llamados a apoyar el trabajo del Cardenal Cupich y nuestra arquidiócesis. Este miércoles, 5 de marzo, comenzamos el tiempo de Cuaresma con el Miércoles de Ceniza. Tendremos siete misas y un servicio de oración con distribución de cenizas. Pueden encontrar el horario en este boletín. El gesto de inclinar la cabeza ante las palabras: "Apártate del pecado y sé fiel al Evangelio", es un signo de penitencia y de nuestra fe. Cuaresma es un tiempo de renovación espiritual y un tiempo en el que nos dedicamos más diligentemente a las actividades que promueven nuestra relación con el Señor. Las leyes del ayuno y la abstinencia son parte de la observancia de cuaresma. El Miércoles de Ceniza y los viernes de cuaresma son días en los que cualquier persona de 14 años o más se abstiene de comer carne. El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son los días de ayuno, personas de 18 a 59 años deben restringir su alimentación a una comida completa o dos comidas ligeras sin carne. También, tomen nota de nuestros horarios de las Estaciones de la Cruz durante cuaresma. Y no olvides hacer planes para ir al sacramento de la reconciliación (confesión). Durante cuaresma, vengan a disfrutar de una deliciosa cena cuaresmal todos los viernes antes o después las estaciones de la cruz, patrocinada por diferentes grupos y organizaciones. Una vez más, participaremos en el programa de Plato de Arroz de CRS - Catholic Relief Services, como una forma de encontrar a Jesús a través de los demás, especialmente a través de los más vulnerables de nuestro mundo.

Your Deacon Daydreams

Have you noticed that occasionally when we turn a page from the book of life, sometimes the pages stick together? Do you ever wonder why it seems to occur especially when you are in the chapter of building a relationship with a future spouse, current spouse, friends, children & most importantly with our God? This Wednesday, we begin forty days of Lent. It is the time of year when our church in her wisdom sets aside for us who may be stuck in a rut or a pothole on our road to salvation. For the next six weeks, we have the opportunity to rewrite or unstick those pages that have been holding us back from living our baptismal promises in the way God hopes we will.

When the ashes are placed on our forehead, we hear the minister say, "Turn away from sin & return to the gospel." But we also hear it today in the good news from Luke. Jesus gave teachings that remind us to look at ourselves more than others. Once we do that & achieve good changes & free ourselves of evil ways, we will bear much fruit. Bearing good fruit begins with making ourselves good. This requires much self-reflection, self-examination, & a ton of humility. However, that is always the hardest part. We all have tendencies to look at everyone before we look at ourselves. It is the other person who must be wrong. We have eagle eyes for the mistakes of others while being blind & neglectful of ourselves. We give ourselves all the benefits of the doubt. Understanding, patience, & mercy are always available to self. Two weeks ago at Henry & Laura's adult faith class, we prayed the Litany of Humility, available online. Lent may be the perfect time for all of us to recite it regularly too. I do it all the time. It reminds me that I must "repent" & become humble to God's will, not my own. That's not easy without Him.

So my question is this, are you making a plan to make this Lent holy? I know some may have already started thinking of some sacrifice, like giving up smoking, dessert etc, All well & good but what else are you doing to return to the gospel? Have you considered spending more time with God at mass, even daily mass or adoration? Are you planning to fulfill your Easter duty to go to confession & receive the Eucharist worthily? Last Dec., the jubilee door to the Year of Hope was opened. Will you make a pilgrimage to a jubilee church (we have 24 designated in our diocese) to gain an opportunity for a plenary indulgence. Check the list out on the archchicago.org website. Attend a Stations of the Cross service as a community or open the missalette, page. 333 to do a private one. Watch our bulletin for the upcoming schedule of events. Many parishes are planning a Lenten mission. We also will be hosting devotions in both Polish & Spanish as well.

Most importantly for those of us who may be in the "penalty box", aka sin, Jesus is searching for His lost lambs. Know this, you are loved, warts & all but He wants you back. St. Augustine once said, "Our hearts are restless, until they rest in you, O Lord." Share with everyone this article too. Lent is a time for change, not only of the season & weather, but ourselves to become more focused on making ourselves holy & not seeing the errors in others. No one sees everything. We all have our blind side. Jesus taught us that humility is basic. Learning to humble ourselves opens ourselves to the concern of others. And, as the Gospel says, "A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good." By the way, if you are celebrating Mardi Gras, Fat Tuesday aka "Paczki day", enjoy! And when you say grace, ask God to remove all the calories & cholesterol too. See you in church?

CCW Meeting

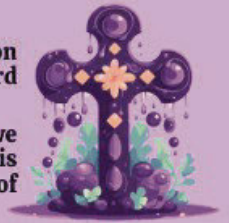
To all the Ladies of Sts. Bruno & Richard,
