Dear Parishioners!

We have made it through half of our season of Lent as we come to this 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent which is also known as "Laetare Sunday". Laetare means "rejoice" which comes from the entrance antiphon of the Mass for this Sunday, "Rejoice, O Jerusalem..." This beautiful theme of rejoicing is seen in the liturgy with the rose vestments and in the readings. As we are midway through our Lenten practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving, may this Laetare Sunday give us pause to rejoice that we are approaching the end of this penitential season where we will celebrate our Lord's resurrection. If we have not been faithful to our Lenten penances, this Laetare Sunday can be the encouragement for us to get back to our Lenten efforts to move away from our sinful ways and grow closer to God. If you have not come to the Stations of the Cross on Friday, perhaps come at least one of these remaining Fridays of Lent in order to show Jesus your appreciation for all that He suffered for us.

One of the best ways to prepare for Easter is with the Sacrament of Reconciliation. I encourage and invite everyone to take advantage of one of the opportunities for Confession we have in our parish this Lent: at St. Richard church - all Fridays, from 4:00 pm., and at St. Bruno church - all Thursdays at 5:00 pm., and Saturdays, from 4:00 pm. If you are homebound and would like to arrange for a home visit for Confession, Communion or Anointing of the Sick - please, contact our parish office.

Źródłem radości może też być dobrze przeżyta spowiedź. Dlatego zachęcam i zapraszam do skorzystania z niej jeszcze przed świętami: w kościele św. Ryszarda - w piątki e czasie i po Drodze Krzyżowej o 5:00, i w kościele św. Brunona - w czwartki od 5:00 i w soboty od 4:00 po południu. Gdyby ktoś chciałby zaprosić księdza do domu, aby tam wyspowiadać czy udzielić komunii chorym czy starszym - to proszę to zgłosić w kancelarii albo u jednego z księży.

Si no hemos sido fieles a nuestras prácticas cuaresmales, que este domingo de Laetare pueda ser un estímulo para retomar nuestros esfuerzos cuaresmales por alejarnos de nuestros pecados y acercarnos a Dios. Si aún no han asistido a los viacrucis los viernes, animense a venir al menos uno de estos viernes restantes de Cuaresma para demostrarle a Jesús su agradecimiento por todo lo que sufrió por nosotros.

Una de las mejores maneras de prepararse para la Pascua es con el sacramento de la Reconciliación. Los animo e invito a todos a aprovechar las oportunidades de confesión que tenemos en nuestra parroquia esta Cuaresma; en la iglesia de San Ricardo - todos los viernes a las 4:00pm, y en la iglesia de San Bruno - todos los jueves a las 5:00pm y los sábados a las 4:00pm. Si estas confinado en tu hogar y deseas que un sacerdote te visite para confesión, comunión o unción de los enfermos, comuníquese a nuestra oficina parroquial para programar una visita.

## *Your Deacon Daydreams*

As a deacon, I do many funerals. Whenever I am preaching at a committal in the cemetery, funeral home or in church, I realize that people always are curious about our eternal pension. They like to hear about heaven, the resurrection of the body, no more sickness or pain, no calories or cholesterol to be concerned about. No worries, time, or schedules to keep, just complete joy & happiness with the Lord. Then when I have everyone on a roll, I have to remind them of this fact. Heaven is there but, there is a condition that determines whether we will gain or lose our inheritance. It's called our God-given free will. The choice we make whether to follow Jesus or deny Him is probably the most important we will ever make. The good news is that while we still have life in us, God's mercy is available to us. But no one knows when our time on earth is up.

Lent is half over. Today, we hear on this 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday the gospel of Luke, the parable of the prodigal son. "A man had two sons, & the younger son said to his father, 'Father give me the share of your estate that should come to me.' So the father divided the property between them. After a few days, the younger son collected all his belongings & set off to a distant country where he squandered his inheritance on a life of dissipation." Sometime later, when he was starving & in dire straits, he went back to seek his father's help. While he was still a long way off, his father caught sight of him, & was filled with compassion. He ran to his son, embraced him & kissed him. His son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven & against you; I no longer deserve to be called your son.' And the joyful father, called his servants to set a feast to welcome him back. Saying, his son once was lost but now is found. Does that phrase sound familiar to you? It is from one of the most frequent sung Christian hymns. Amazing Grace. It may have been written in 1777 by a naval slave trader who repented & became a minister & abolitionist, but the words are still true today.

On the other hand, there is the faithful son who never left his dad's side working loyally, who was angry with his brother & the royal treatment his father gave him when he returned. The father in the parable is Our Father who art in heaven, whose mercy is endless as long as we repent for our sins. The choices we make to serve & to love God like the faithful son means everything is ours but God is always open to us who have squandered our choices too. Hopefully, you are able to join us in person this Tuesday to pray the way of the cross for loved ones who have left the faith to return like the prodigal child. On another note, if anyone has any questions that I cannot answer due to lack of time after mass, please do not hesitate to call the rectory & leave me a message. I will gladly respond to your phone calls, & even emails about our faith, especially when it comes to issues about receiving the sacraments.

Finally, God promises to never give up on us. All the scriptures from the Old & New testaments not only today's parable prove that God never, ever gives up on us, starting from Adam & Eve, King David, Moses, Jewish people becoming exiled, Peter denying Jesus three times, the disciples all but John running away at His crucifixion until this very day. Repent this Lent! See you in church?

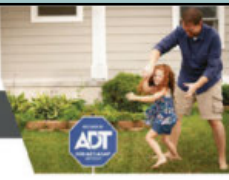
