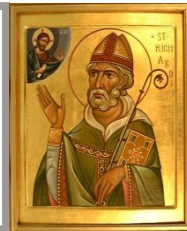

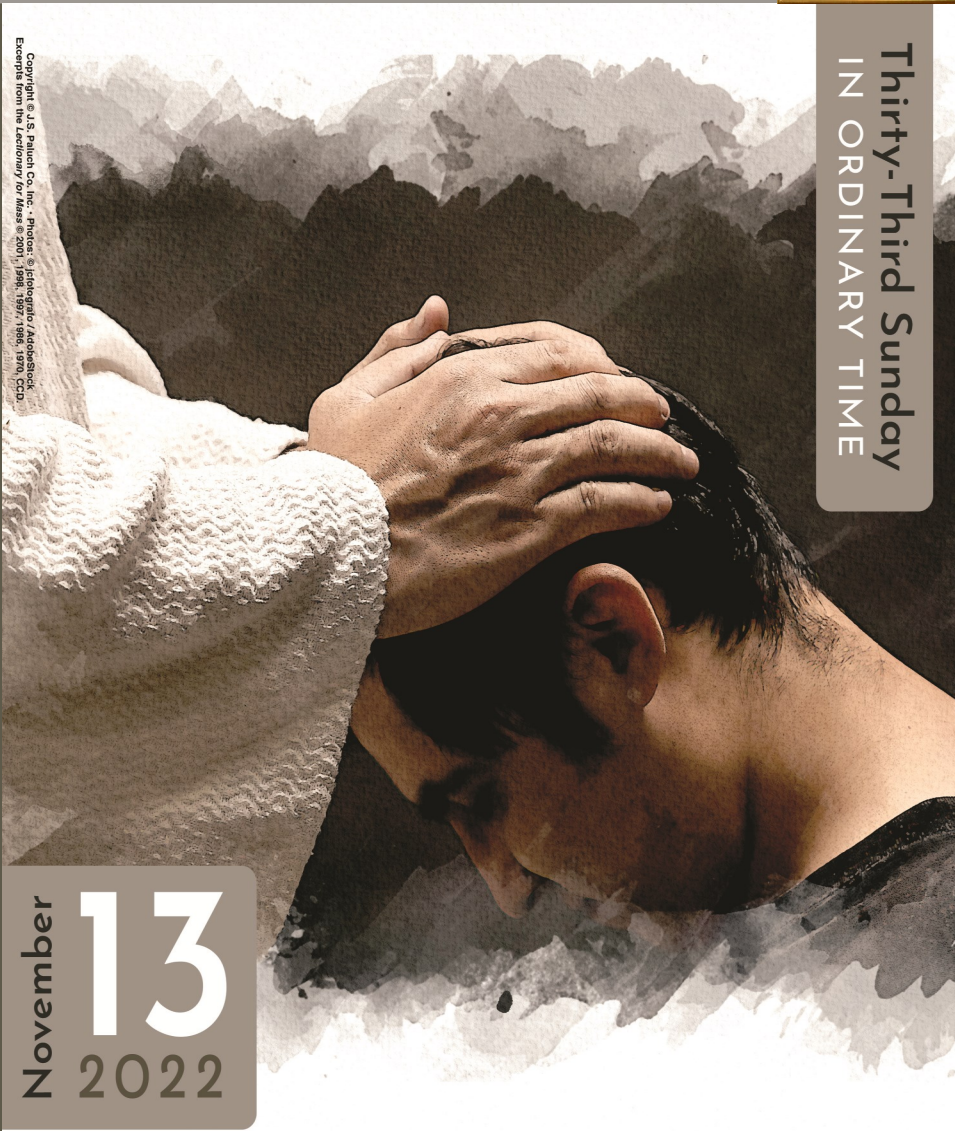

Słowo ks. Proboszcza

Drodzy Parafianie!

Powoli zbliżamy się do końca roku liturgicznego. Przyszła niedziela to Uroczystość Jezusa Chrystusa, Króla Wszechświata, a potem już Adwent. W listopadowe dni, kiedy szczególnie pamiętamy o zmarłych, wyraźniej staje przed nami prawda o czyścicu. Kościół poucza nas, że zanim człowiek stanie przed Bogiem twarzą w twarz w niebie, musi doznać wpieryw całkowitego oczyszczenia. To oczyszczenie dokonuje się właśnie w czyścicu. Niestety nic już tam nie może dla siebie zrobić. Z chwilą śmierci kończy się dla człowieka czas własnego zasługiwania na niebo. Pomóc w skróceniu mąk czyścicowych może przyjść tylko z zewnątrz – od nas. Nasza modlitwy, Msze św., ofiary, czy cierpienia niech będą takimi gestami wyciągniętej, pomocnej dłoni. Niech będą też wyrazem naszej wdzięczności za dobro, jakie od nich kiedyś nas spotkało.

Już niedługo będziemy obchodzić Thanksgiving Day. Święto Dzień Dziękczynienia to czas wdzięczności za wszystkie dary i łaski jakimi nas Bóg nieustannie obdarza, a także za plony ziemi i pracy rąk ludzkich.  **YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS** 

Years ago, I was walking past a church's message board. It read, "B.Y.O.B." I saw the priest outside & asked, does that mean your parish is having a party & one should, bring your own beverage? He looked confused & replied, No, it means, "bring your own bible." Wise words for sure. But in our 2nd reading today, we read how St. Paul says M.Y.O.B. "mind your own business." It's his good advice how all of us should imitate Paul himself, who used Christ as the model for how one should conduct himself. "Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ" (1 Corinthians 11:11). Jesus worked tirelessly in proclaiming the Kingdom of God. St. Paul & his coworkers did the same instructing others that we should peacefully be doing our own work without meddling in the affairs of others but rather working for the Lord. When we say our Morning Offering prayer, the first words are to offer up all our prayers, works, joys & sufferings of this day. Are you doing that? It takes just a few moments to say those words. It really makes a difference too, especially when you offer it up for the repentance of sin & for the poor souls in Purgatory. It's worth a try.

The Gospel of Luke comes from the final time that Jesus is teaching the people in the Temple before His Passion. Jesus describes terrible times to come of earthquakes, plagues, wars & destruction. Not unlike some of things that are already happening in this day & age. Yet, on this last Sunday of Ordinary time, it's a reminder that all things that are familiar to us may come to pass. And while the end time is uncertain, nonetheless it will happen. Last week, we gained an extra hour of sleep because we set our clocks back. The so-called "Doomsday clock" currently is set at 100 seconds before midnight due to the ongoing threat of nuclear turmoil in the world. We don't have any control over things of such magnitude, but we can set our sights on things that are everlasting, Jesus' promise of the Kingdom of Heaven. How do we do that? Prayer & working each day to be holy by doing good deeds & teaching our children the same. Receive the sacraments of reconciliation frequently, so we can be free of mortal sin & regularly receive the Holy Eucharist worthily. If you haven't started yet, consider doing just that.

By this time, the election results will be in. I hope you voted. I hope you voted for life in all forms from the womb to the tomb. If you thought that one vote wouldn't make a difference, In 1876, one electoral vote elected Pres Rutherford B. Hayes. In 1875, one vote changed France from a monarch to a republic. Fr. McGivney, the late founder of the Knights of Columbus once said, "Vote not as other men dictate, but rather like one with your country at heart. Vote according to the dictates of your well-formed consciences." The late Congressman Bruce Barton of NY said: "When I consider what tremendous consequences come from little things, I am tempted to think, there are no little things." May God bless America. Immaculate Conception, pray for us. See you in church?

Announcement from Cardinal Cupich

Dispensation from Mass obligation ending November 27 in Archdiocese of Chicago

Cardinal Cupich announced that all Catholics across the Archdiocese will be obligated to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation starting November 26/27. Cardinal said: *"With vaccinations and boosters, restrictions on public gatherings have eased up. Many people feel more comfortable returning to Church. Yet, we know there are some elderly and immuno-compromised persons who are still not ready to return. And they should not return. These vulnerable brothers and sisters have an excusing cause for being absent and for this reason I will continue the TV Mass on ABC for the present time. But for the rest of us, I have decided to lift the general dispensation from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass as we begin a new Church year on the First Sunday of Advent, November 26-27. My hope is that the First Sunday of Advent will provide us with a fresh start to take up again our life together as a community of faith that gathers to worship God."*

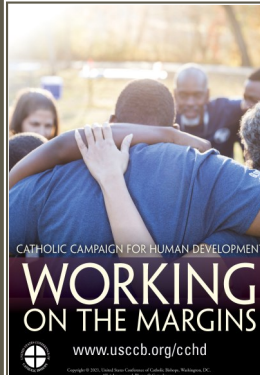

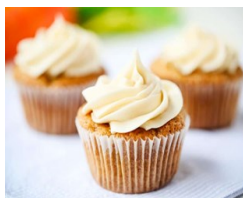

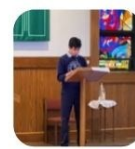
