Dear Parishioners!

I hope everyone enjoyed a joyous Thanksgiving Day in the company of family. This Sunday we begin the Season of Advent. People celebrate Advent in many ways. A long time practice of the Church to celebrate this season of Advent is the use of an Advent wreath. This wreath consists of four candles, three purple and one rose. Each week one candle is lit, so that by the time the 4th Sunday of Advent is celebrated, all four candles then are lit, indicating that Christmas is near.

During the season of Advent, it's customary to get also our houses in order. Many will be decorating for Christmas and cleaning their houses for the holidays. As Catholic Christians, this is an ideal time to also clean our spiritual houses by celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

As you have noticed, the Giving Tree Project began last weekend. This Christmas ministry tradition provides us the opportunity to brighten the holiday season of others. It is way of giving back a little of what we have so generously been given.

On Monday, December 12, we shall have our annual celebration of the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The Novena in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe begins on Saturday, December 3rd. For nine evenings our Latino community will gather alternately in our both churches for Rosary and Mass to deepen our devotion to the Patroness of the Americas. Although the prayer will take place in Spanish, please feel welcome to join us in church each night of the Novena. The full schedule of the Novena is printed elsewhere in this bulletin.

Drodzy Parafianie!

Mam nadzieję, że Święto Dziękczynienia było udane i spędziliście je w miłej atmosferze, w gronie najbliższych i znajomych. Dzisiejszą niedzielą rozpoczynamy Adwent. Obejmuje on cztery niedziele przed Bożym Narodzeniem i jest radosnym oczekiwaniem na przyjście Chrystusa. Ponieważ w tym roku Boże Narodzenie przypadnie w niedzielę, będziemy więc mieli najdłuższy Adwent jaki w ogóle jest możliwy. Adwent obchodzony jest na wiele sposobów: wierni uczestniczą w roratach, zapalają kolejne świece na adwentowym wieńcu, wspomagają innych w ramach akcji zwanej Drzewkiem Dobroci. W Adwencie przystępujemy także liczniej niż zwykle do spowiedzi, h świętych, na których zapala się kolejne świece na adwentowym wieńcu. W Adwencie też, liczniej niż zwykle, przystępujemy do spowiedzi, aby w ten sposób przygotować nasze serca na przyjście Zbawiciela.

Wspólnota Latynoska zaprasza wszystkich do udziału w Nowennie do Matki Bożej z Guadalupe, która będzie mieć miejsce w naszym kościele codziennie od soboty 3 grudnia przez 9 kolejnych dni, aż do święta Matki Boskiej z Guadalupe, które przypada dokładnie 12 grudnia,. Nowenna będzie na przemian w obu kościołach i będzie obejmowała Różaniec i Mszę św. Choć modlitwy będą po hiszpańsku, to jednak wszyscy są mile widziani. Dokładny plan Nowenny podany jest w dzisiejszym biuletynie.

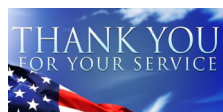

YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS

Have you ever come home to find your home or garage burglarized? That feeling of invasion is horrible! Nowadays, thieves can be brazen & aggressive or do their worst in secret. You can be pick-pocketed, purse snatched, car-jacked, even threatened with a weapon. There's also a different kind of robbery; illness can rob you of your health, happiness & sense of security too. In all situations, we must remain vigilant. We should not only be aware of our surroundings but also realize our lives can change in a moment like a thief in the night as our Lord has taught us. On this 1st Sunday of Advent, we hear from the gospel of Matthew, "For you do not know on which day your Lord will come. Be sure of this: if the master of the house had known the hour of night when the thief was coming he would have stayed awake & not let his house be broken into. So too, you also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come."

When I was a youngster, no one ever put their Christmas decorations up weeks ahead of time. Or took them down right after. In fact, part of our tradition was to decorate it just a few days before Jesus' birthday. We did have our Advent calendars hung, eagerly anticipating what was behind each little door. Some of us even had home Advent wreaths. Unfortunately, commercialism has hijacked the real reason we celebrate Christmas.

But what if Jesus came back to visit us for His second coming this year? Would your spiritual house be in order or would you beg Him to not come yet? I pray each day that we are. Unfortunately, I don't think there is much fear of the Lord these days. People walk around clueless that all actions have consequences both positive & negative. Many have lost their awe of the majesty of God. They believe that good things happen through their own efforts. I find that very sad! Their God is their cellphone or material possessions. They have to be surrounded by both to be able to be in control. But then there are others who are just grateful to be alive when some natural disaster occurs & they have lost everything like Job from the Old Testament. If you find yourself as one who needs his possessions, consider a dying person in hospice. They don't worry about the bills or spending more time at work, they don't worry about their homes or their belongings or even eating. Neither should we make it our priority. Instead, what we need is God's mercy. Prepare your spiritual house by making a good confession this year & receiving our Lord in the Holy Eucharist. Eucharist means "thanksgiving." Be thankful for each moment we have left in this world, so we can be happy with Him in the next. Don't allow the bargains of a black Friday become more important than the graces of a Good Friday 2000 years ago. That sacrificial gift of Jesus for us, supersedes any gift we can ever buy. Happy Advent. See you in church?
