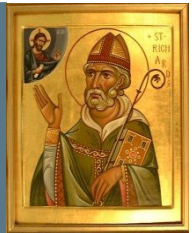

Drodzy Parafianie!

Miesiąc październik to miesiąc, kiedy to Katolicy biorą do ręki różaniec i za wstawiennictwem Maryi modlą się polecając Bogu intencje swojego serca. Jak Chrystus nauczył nas modlitwy Pańskiej „*Ojcze nasz*”, tak Maryja nauczyła nas modlić się słowami różańca. Niestety, ale modlitwa różańcowa, niegdyś tak powszechnie odmawiana, w dzisiejszych czasach nie znajduje już takiego zrozumienia. Tymczasem ci, którzy nadal ją odmawiają, mogą zaświadczyć, jak wiele łask doznali za jej pośrednictwem. Poglębia ona zrozumienie podstawowych tajemnic wiary przez rozważanie życia Chrystusa, uczy cierpliwości i wytrwałości w modlitwie i ułatwia nam skupienie się przed Bogiem, obejmując nasze myśli, nasze usta i nasze ręce. Dziękujemy Bogu i Maryi, że dali nam tak prosty i skuteczny środek pozwalający doświadczyć ich miłości.

YOUR DEACON DAYDREAMS

I read a quote years ago that stuck with me. "If the only prayer you ever say in your entire life is thank you, it will be enough." This weekend's good news from Luke is one that is also read on Thanksgiving. It is the story of ten Lepers who were cured but only one returned to thank Jesus for his healing miracle. Jesus replied, "Your faith has saved you." How do we say thank you to God for all He has bestowed on us? After all, all God things come to us from God. I know so many of us think it is owed to us or we did it through our own hard work, but the truth of the matter is, God has a hand in it all. Not just some of it, all of it. However, when was the last time you thanked Him? How do you feel when you have worked or sacrificed for your family & no one takes notice, just takes it for granted & keeps asking for more? Sometimes we get a bit grumpy or resentful. Thankfully, God is all merciful & doesn't get upset, but I guarantee you, He wants to hear from His children too.

It has been said that gratitude can be one of the most fruitful forms of prayer. When we specifically notice things to be grateful for, we become aware of & acknowledge God's constant presence in our lives. Practicing gratitude daily is a practice which can change your whole attitude & it doesn't have to take a lot of time. Pope Francis recently said: "Gratitude is a characteristic trait of the heart visited by the Holy Spirit; to obey God we must first remember his benefits."

So my suggestion this week, during the month of the rosary is to say a rosary but also prepare even if only mentally a gratitude prayer list each day before you start your rosary. Here's one way to do it. Find a comfortable & quiet place. Make the Sign of the Cross. Ask God to show you where He was present in your day. Think about some things from the past day which you are grateful for. It is good to have a minimum number of things to come up with each day – 3 or 5 or 10 for example. Try to be specific. Instead of being grateful for your family in general, think of a specific interaction with a family member. Spend a little time enjoying the memories of the things you are grateful for. Thank God for each of these & any special circumstances which made them possible. End with the Sign of the Cross.

Please add to your rosary, a prayer for the victims of Hurricane Ian. Our neighbors to the south need our prayers & support. Their lives have been changed forever. Also pray for those during the month of Domestic Violence Awareness, those struggling with emotional, physical, financial, sexual, elder abuse & neglect. If you know of someone, there is a confidential hot line number & lots of resources available. In Illinois, it is, 1-(815) 626-7277 or 1(877) 863-6338. In the city of Chicago, 1-(877).863.6339. It is vital for you or someone you know to get help, it's not hopeless despite how one may feel right now. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you the strength to seek assistance. See you in church?

All Archer Heights residents are welcome to come and hear the candidates.

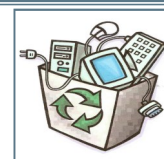
