

#### The Stained Glass Windows of St. Richard Church - #7

As we draw closer to the September 11, 2022 date for the Dedication & Blessing Ceremony for the Front Entryway Stained Glass Doors and Panels, we look at the images and symbolism of the second East side window entitled <u>"Christ Has Risen"</u>.



<u>Upper Panels</u> In sharp contrast to the somber colors of the "<u>Christ Has Died</u>" window, we now see Jesus depicted in Resurrection robes of dazzling white, light grays and pale blues. Red pieces of glass on His hands and feet mark where Jesus was nailed to the cross.

Two Angels accompany Jesus, one on either side of Him. To the right of Jesus stands the Paschal Candle, symbol of the "Light of Christ" jutting out from the open green rock tomb where the grey burial shroud lays. "The Paschal candle is one of the most sacred and enduring elements in Christianity. Made of beeswax to represent the purity of Christ, the candle's wick signifies Christ's humanity and the flame His Divine Nature. It is adorned with one or more Christian symbols" (1).

To the right of the open tomb, an upright unlit torch, symbolizes life, truth, and the regenerative power of flame - eternal life; while above and below the left angel, parts of two smaller downward pointing torches symbolize death. The upright torch thus symbolizes the triumph of eternal life over death. To the lower left of Jesus a dove, symbol of the Holy Spirit.

<u>Main Panels</u> The use of joyful, vibrant colors, shades of pale yellows, gold's, oranges and, dazzling reds, convey a sense of exhilaration at the Ascension. The use of dark to light colored glass pulls the viewer into the central theme of this window.

Central figures of the Twelve Apostles, and Mary, Mother of our Savior. Immediately above the Twelve and Mary, a band of seven doves symbolizing the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit flying up toward Jesus. Divine completion and perfection: Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.

In the forefront of the seven Apostles in the left panel, seated on a small throne, sits St. Peter, the first Pope, holding the keys to the Kingdom of Heaven.

Jesus said to Simon Peter, "And so I say to you, you are "Rock", and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. Mt. 16:18.

In the right side panel are Mary and the other five Apostles. Within in each of their halos Mary and all Twelve Apostles have "red tongues of flame" over their heads symbolizing the enlightening, or "Descent of the Holy Spirit". All the Apostles and Mary are ecstatically gazing upwards in pure joy and amazement during the Ascension.

At the foot of Mary and five of the Apostles, a church having three domes, with the main dome topped by a cross. The church symbolizes Jesus transferring the earthly church to St. Peter and the Apostles.


